## BJP trying to settle scores: Somnath Bharti on Tomar's arrest

KOCHI: A democratically defeated BJP is using administration to settle political scores, said Aam Aadmi Party MLA Somnath Bharti about Delhi's law minister Jitendra Singh Tomar's arrest on Tuesday for presenting fake law degree in his election affidavits. Somnath Bharti told reporters in Kochi.



"Police is being misused to settle political scores" alleged Somnath Bharti.

He added that the Delhi police did not wait for the High Court's decision on the cases initiated against Tomar. "Police is being misused to settle political scores" alleged Somnath Bharti.

"Democratic defeats should be accepted with humility" he added.

I think Modi should tackle their own problems first, he said, referring to controversies about HRD Minister Smriti Irani's qualifications.

"Smriti Irani had claimed she is a graduate but it turned out that she had not completed the course, then we heard she had only enrolled for a correspondence course. This itself is such a mockery" alleged Bharti.

Talking about the leadership in Kerala, he said that the people of Kerala are in need of a government that caters even to the last man's needs, and not formed by the traditional, alternatively picked up parties.

"Following the Delhi success, we see an acceptance here in Kerala for new things, the acceptability for Aam Aadmi Party is visible" said Somnath Bharti who is given the independent charge of the state.
