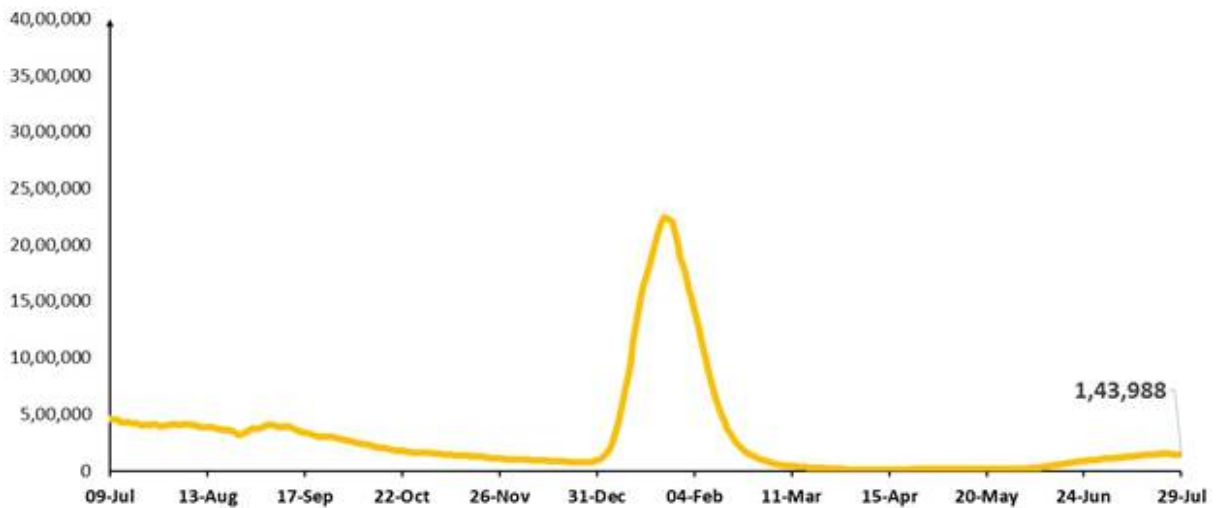

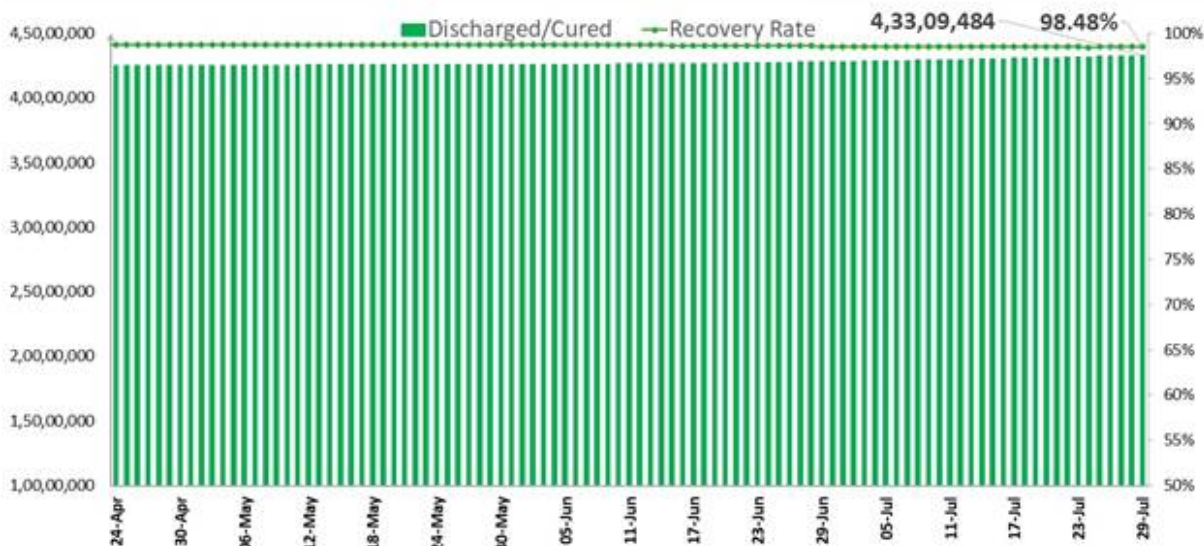
India's Active Cases Trajectory

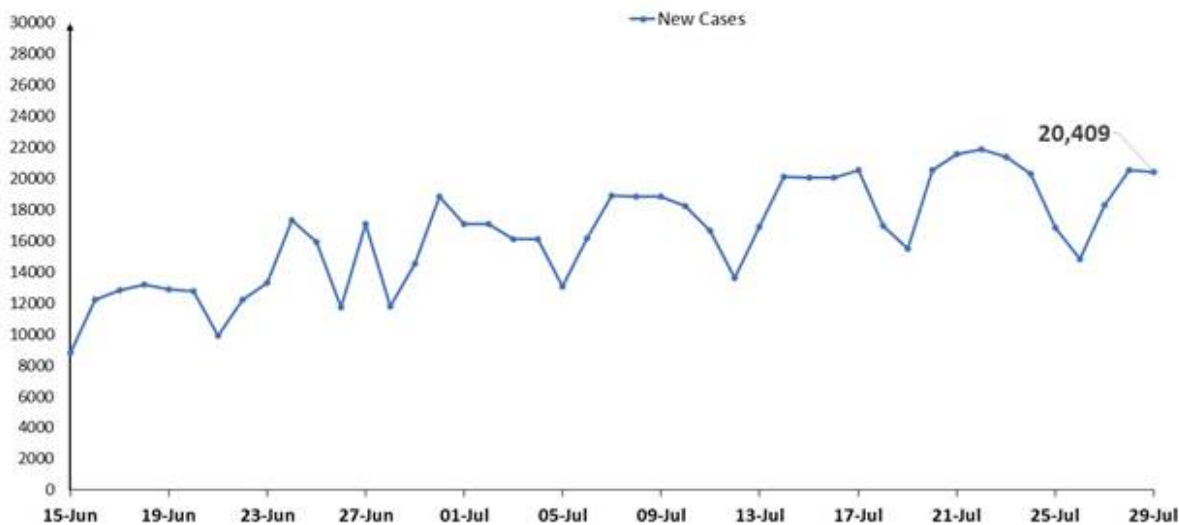


Recovered cases over 4.33 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.48%

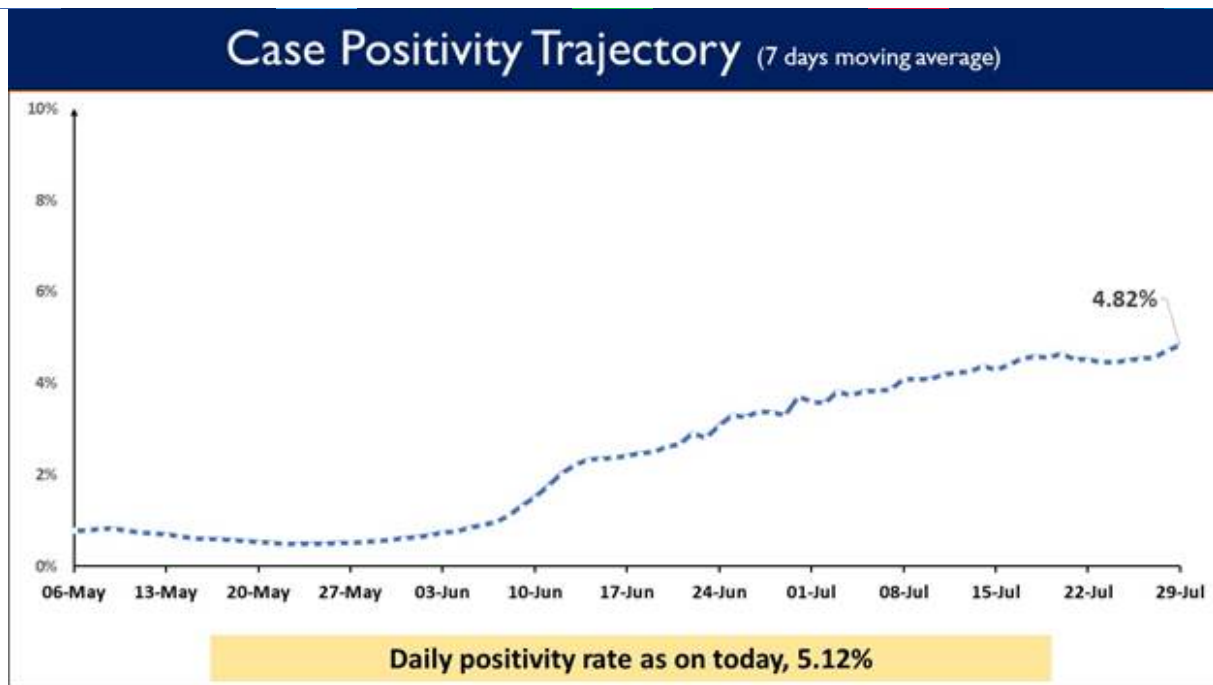

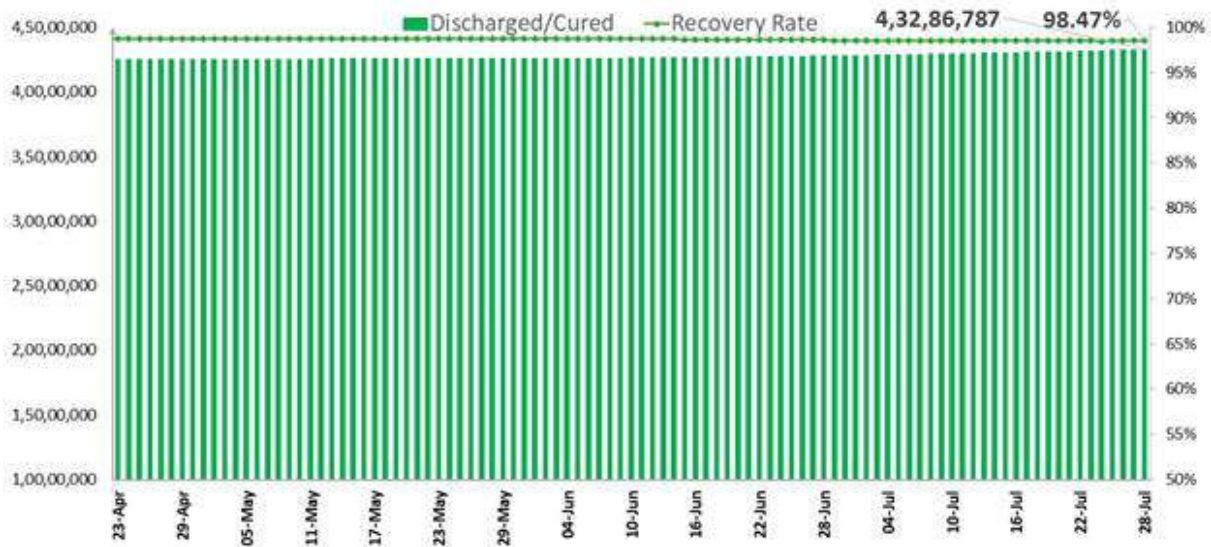

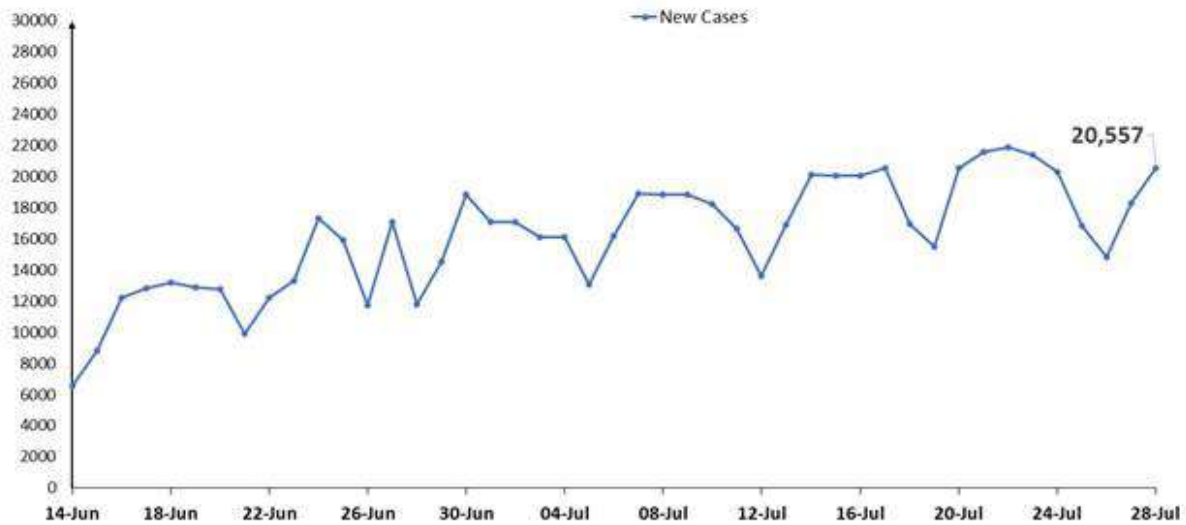


Recovered cases over 4.32 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.47%

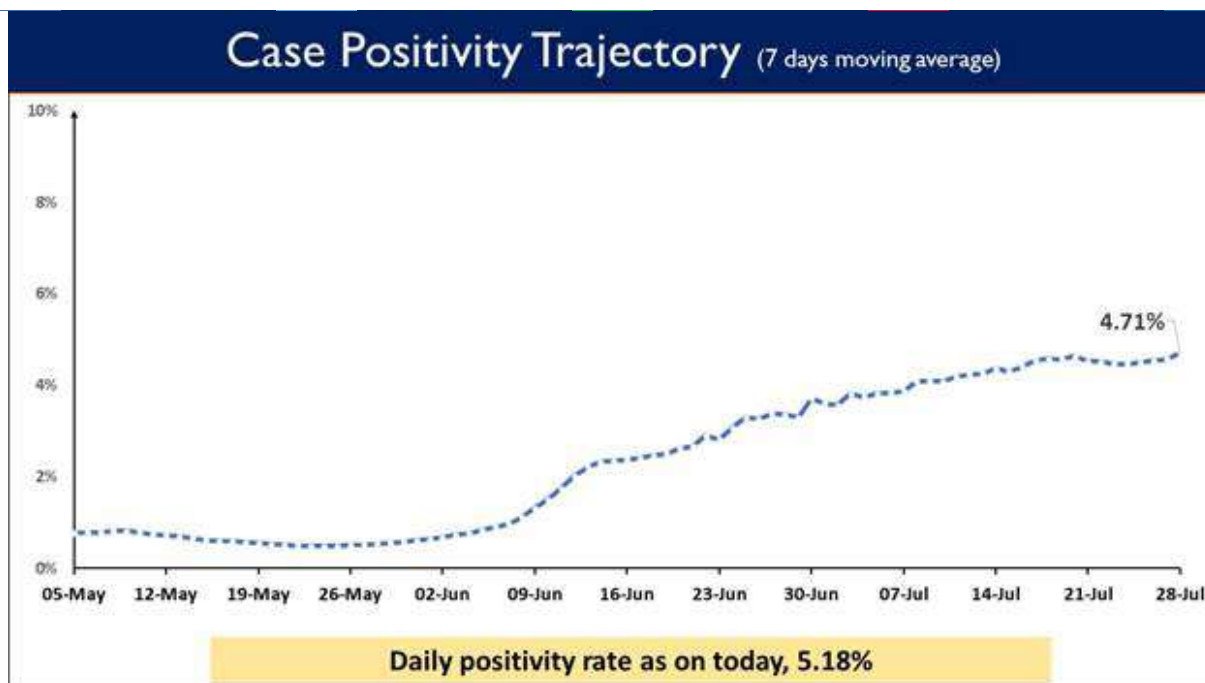

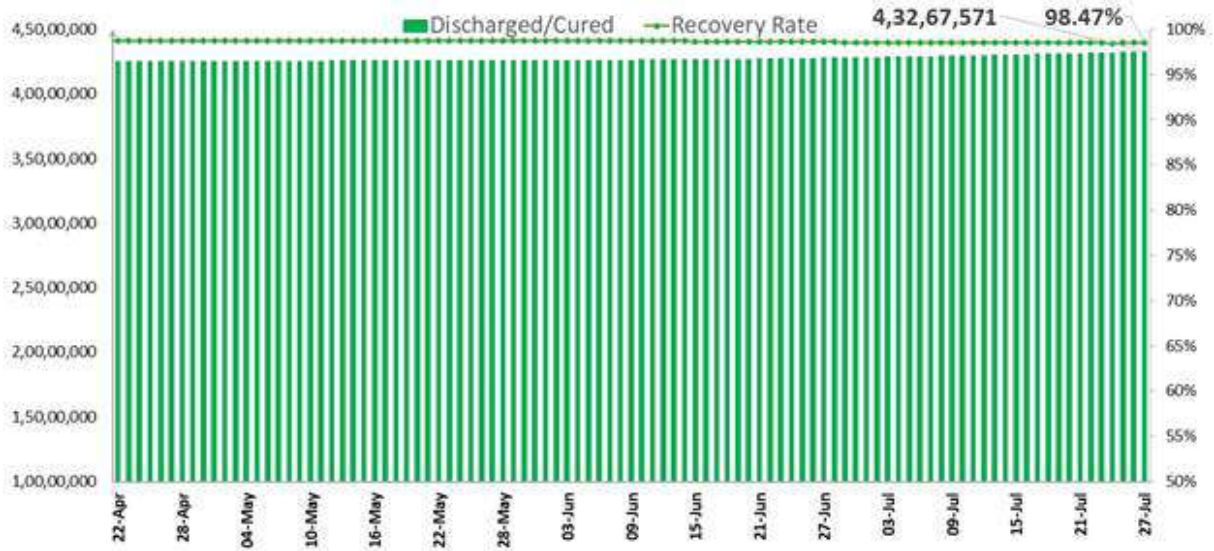
India’s Active Cases Trajectory

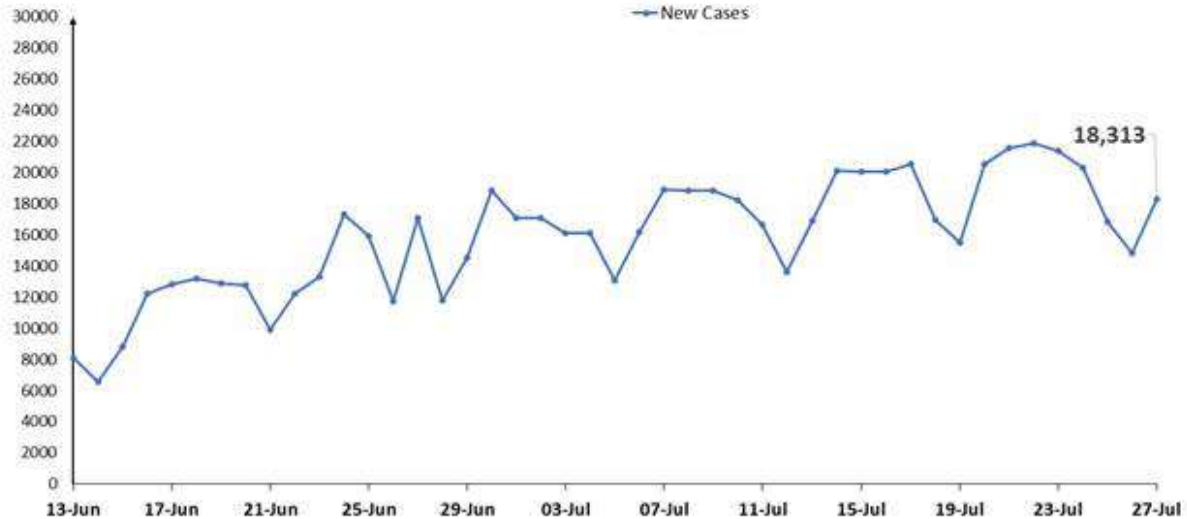


Recovered cases over 4.32 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.47%

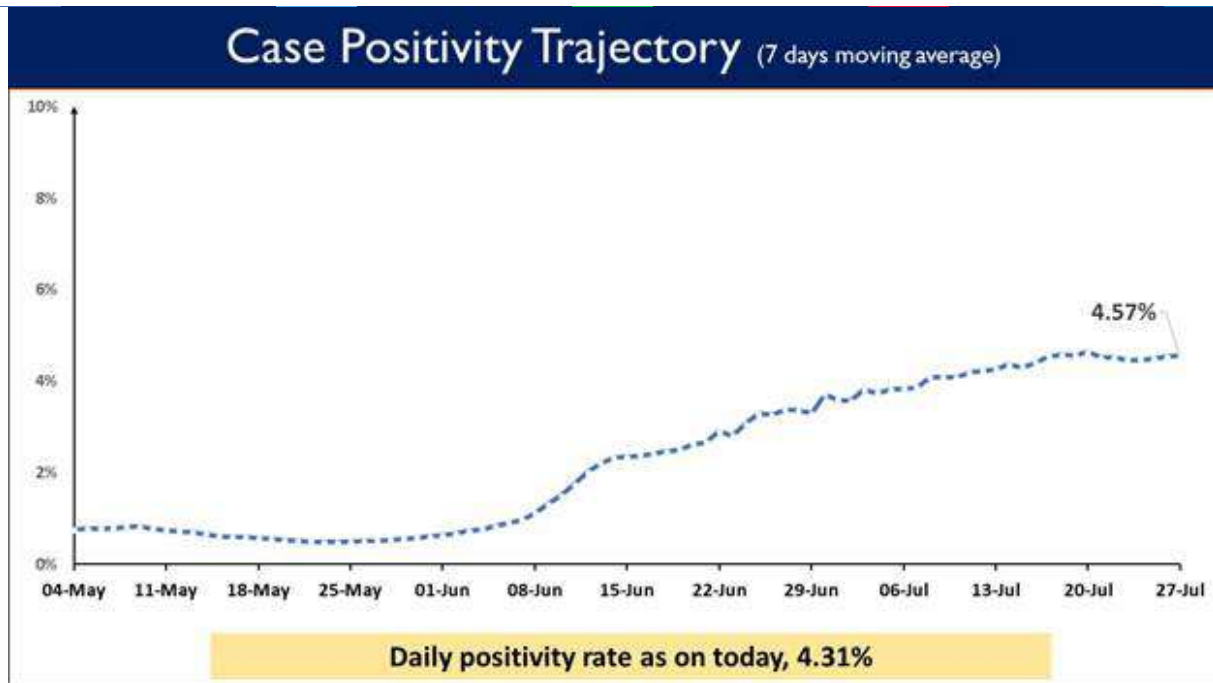

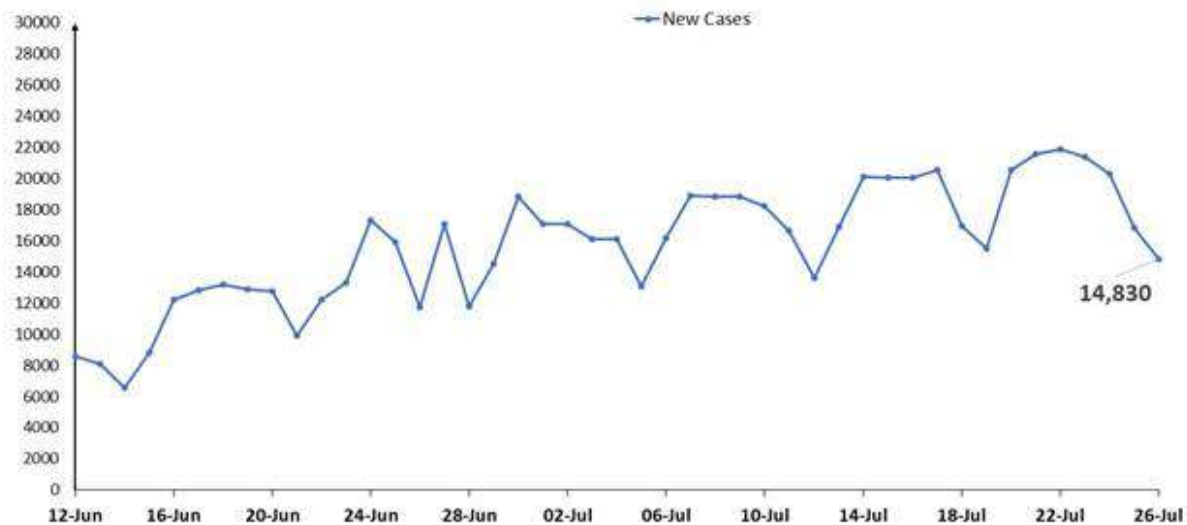


Recovered cases over 4.32 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.47%

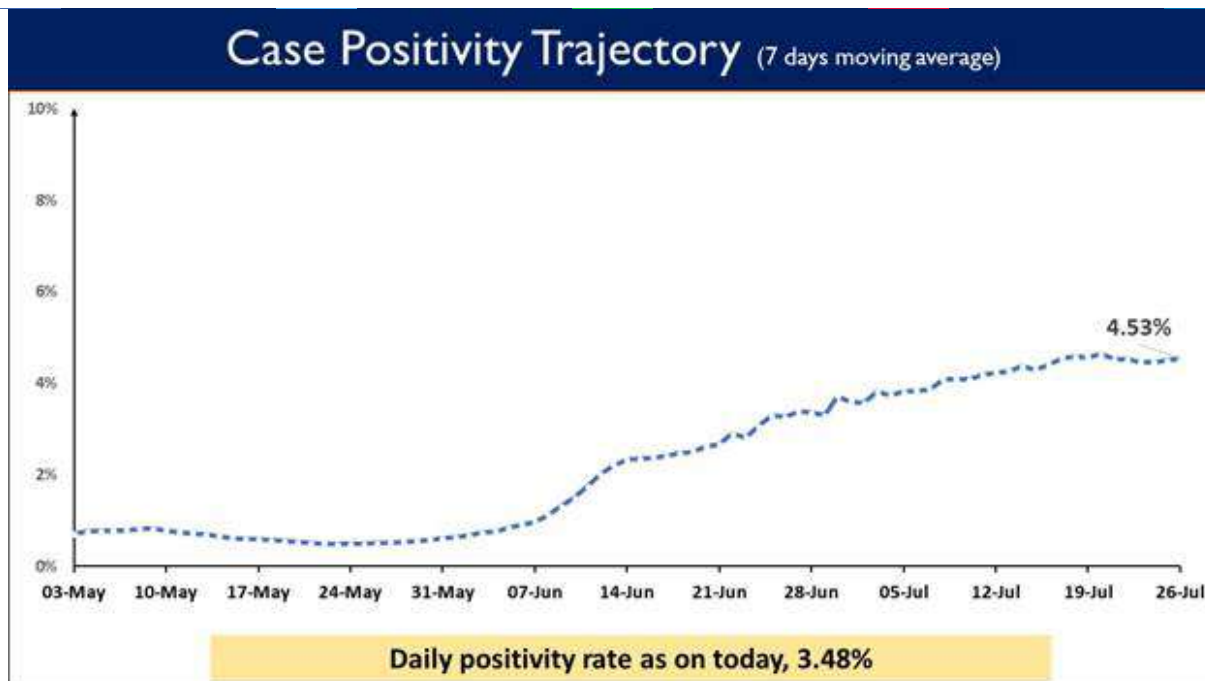

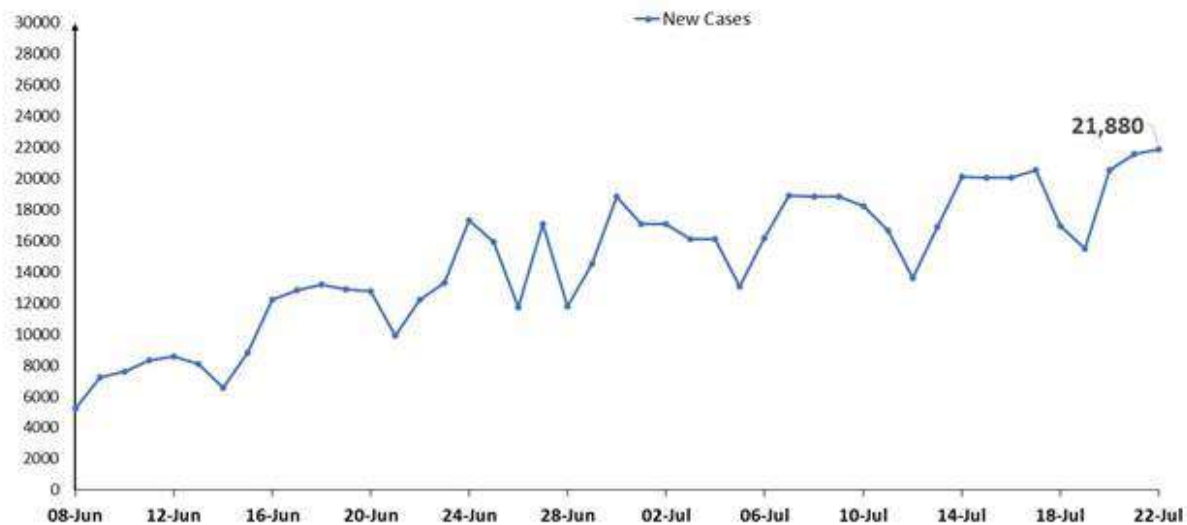


Recovered cases over 4.31 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.46%

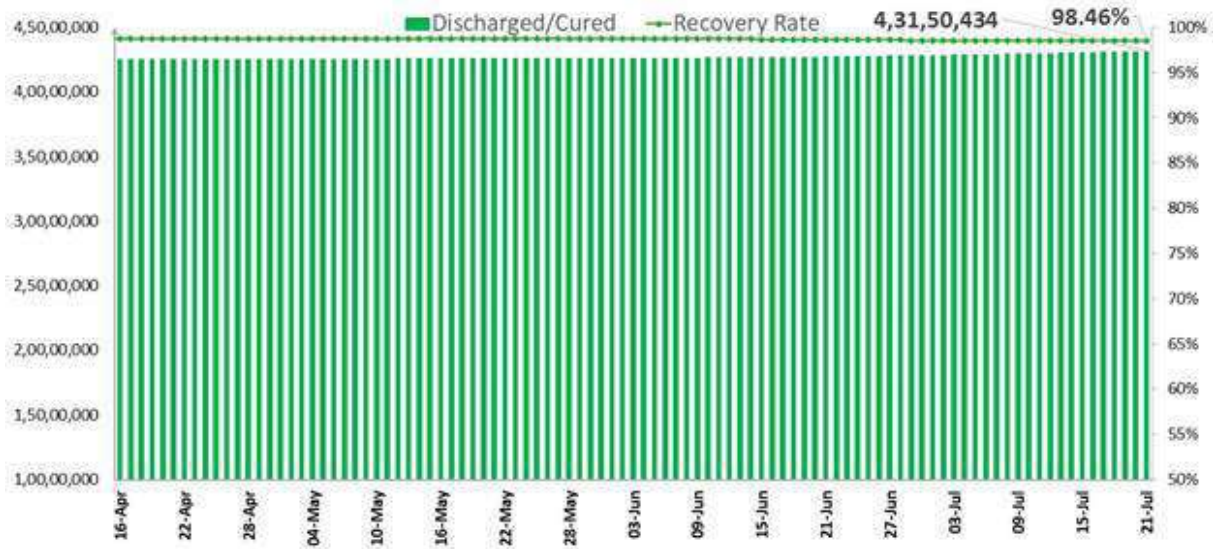
India's Active Cases Trajectory

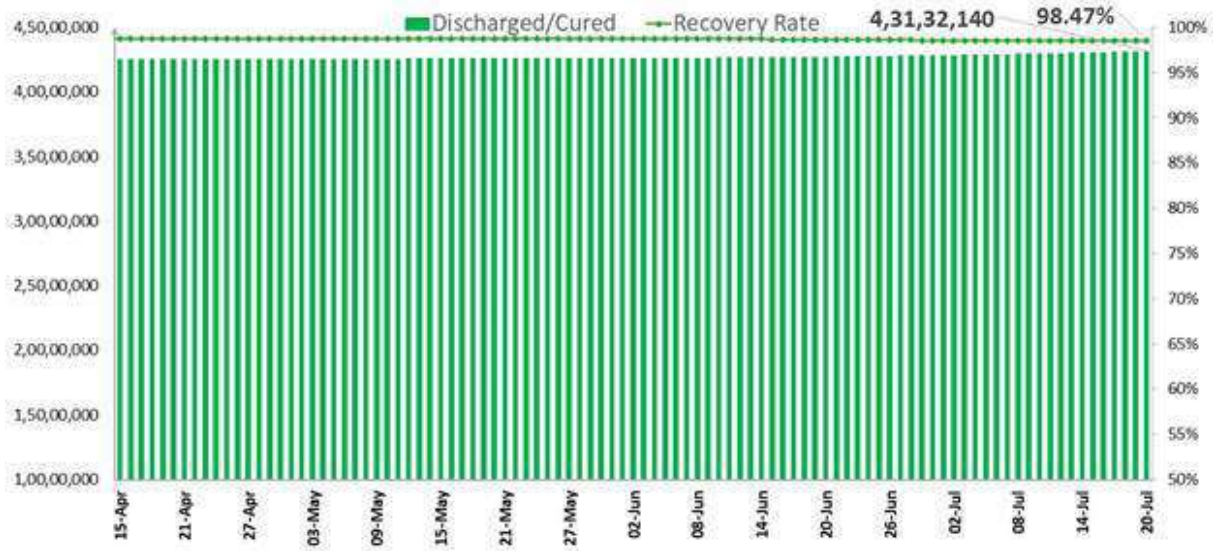

Centre Reviews COVID-19 Situation in 115 districts of 9 States showing an Upsurge in COVID Cases and Positivity; Flags Concerns regarding low levels of testing and vaccination

States to report & monitor district-wise SARI and ILI cases on a daily basis

Shri Rajesh Bhushan, Union Health Secretary chaired a high-level meeting today to review the COVID-19 situation in 9 states of Kerala, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh. These States are either reporting a surge in new daily COVID cases or a rise in positivity. The public health measures for surveillance, containment and management of COVID19 were also reviewed. Dr Vinod Paul, Member (Health), NITI Aayog was also present.

Expressing concern regarding the surge in cases in these states in the past one month, Dr V. K. Paul reiterated, “We need to be mindful that COVID has not gone. Looking at the global scenario, we need to be at high alert. There is poor surveillance, poor testing and below average vaccination in many states undergoing the present surge”, he pointed out. He urged states to improve the testing in areas with high positivity, increase surveillance as per the revised surveillance strategy and speed up COVID vaccination.

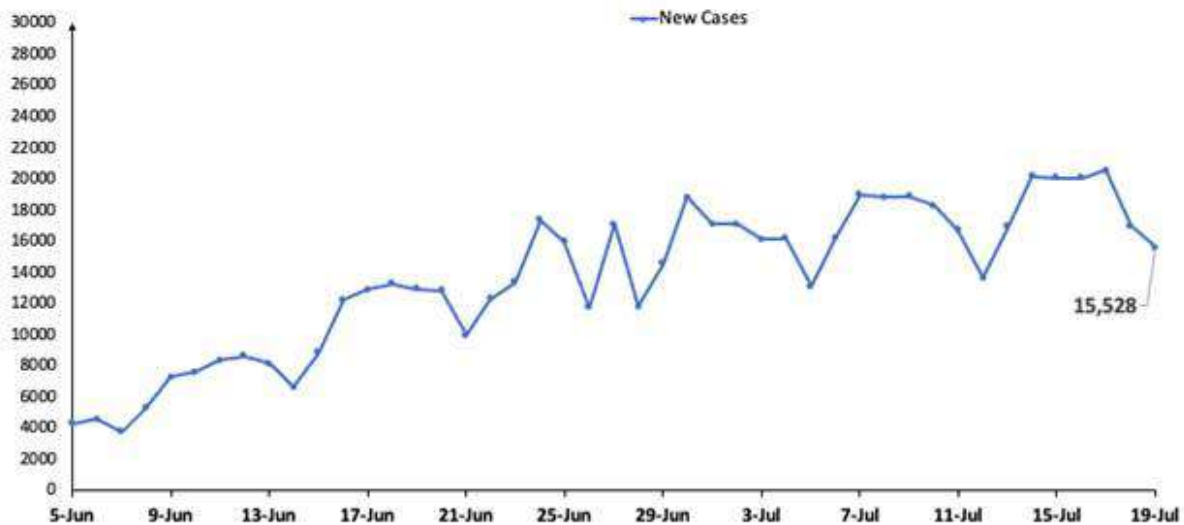

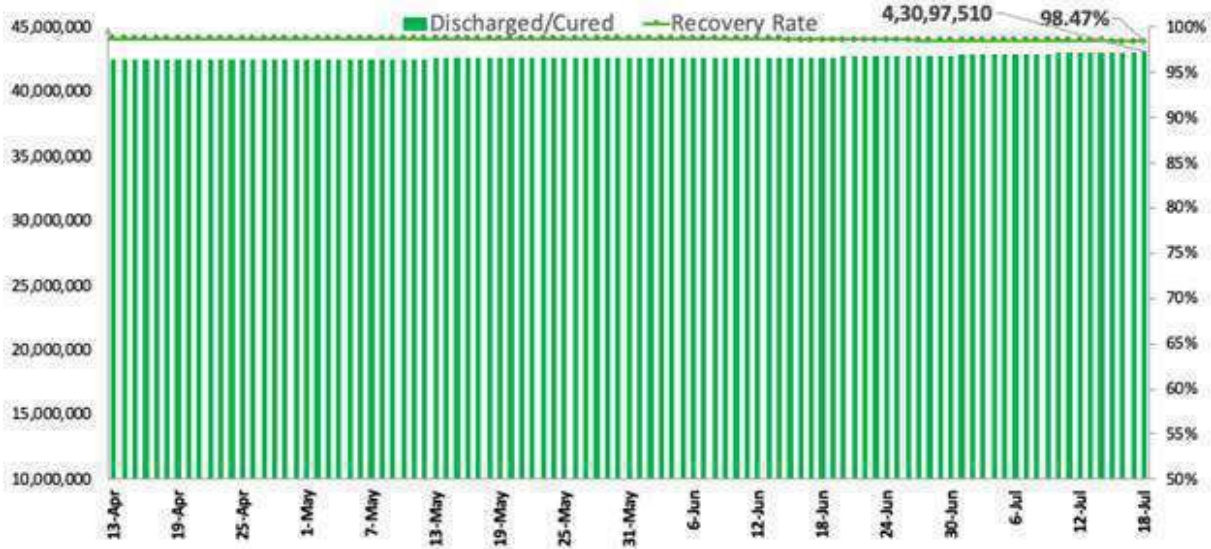
India’s Active Cases Trajectory

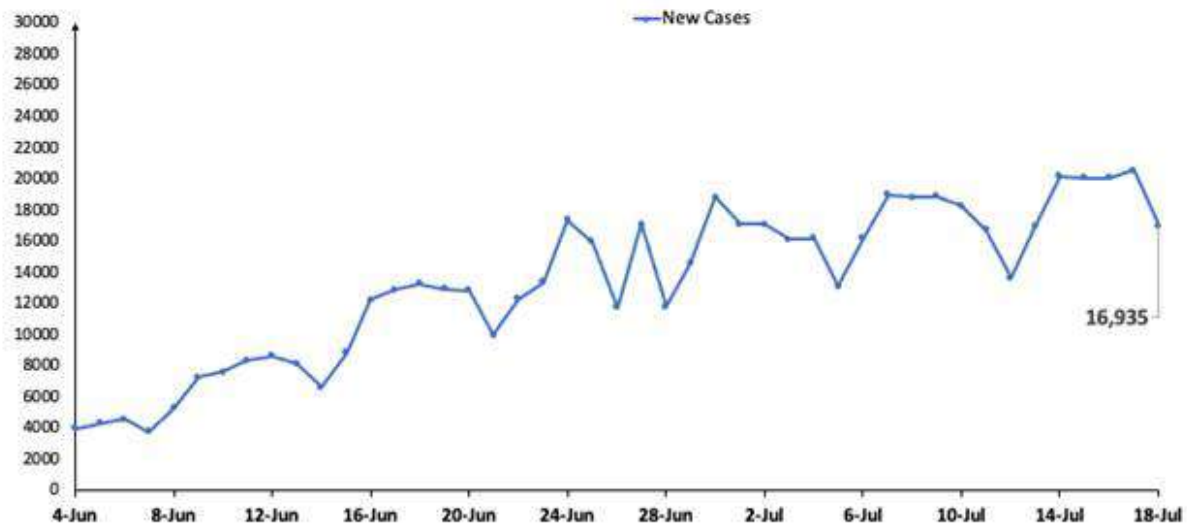


Recovered cases over 4.30 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.47%



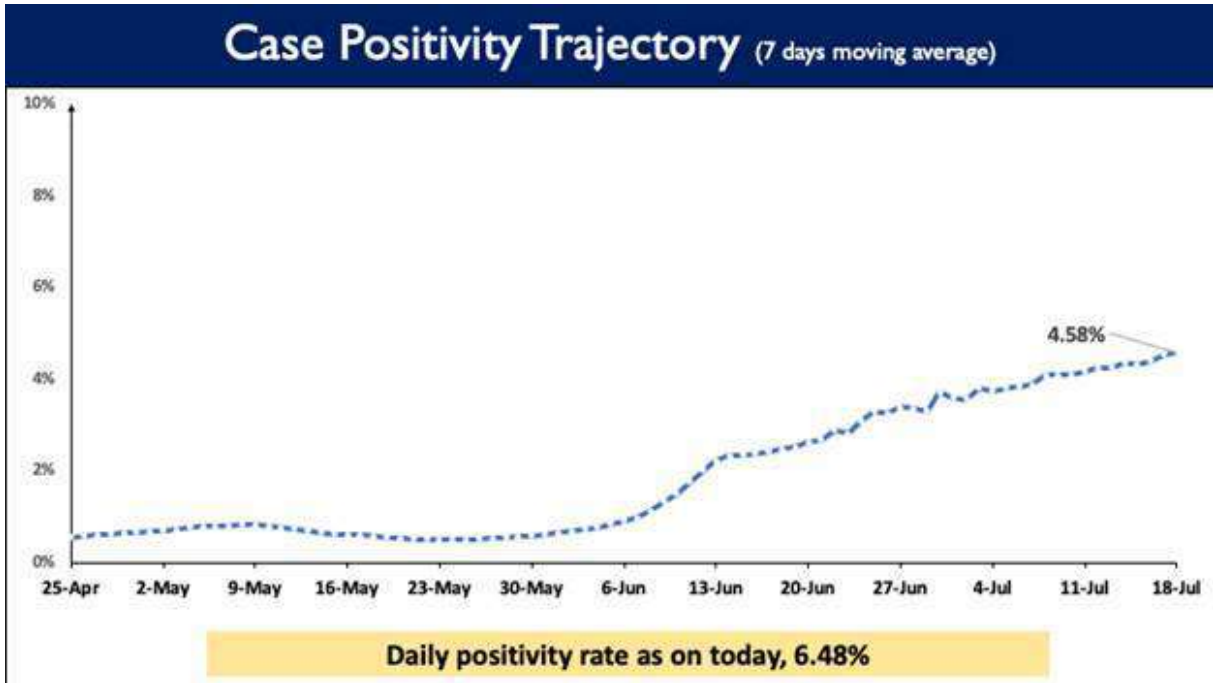

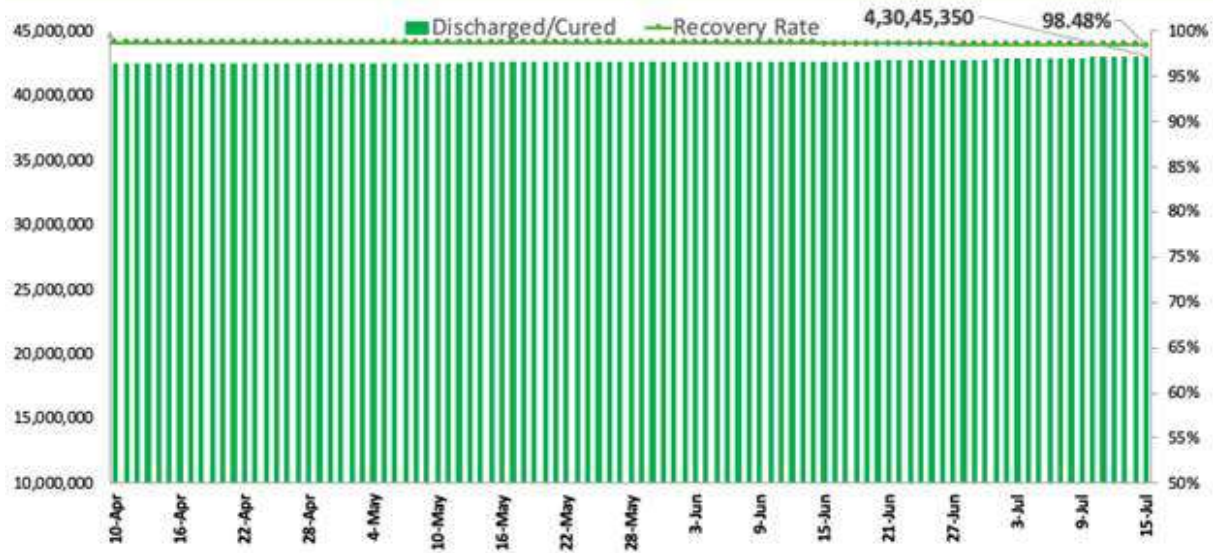
India's Active Cases Trajectory

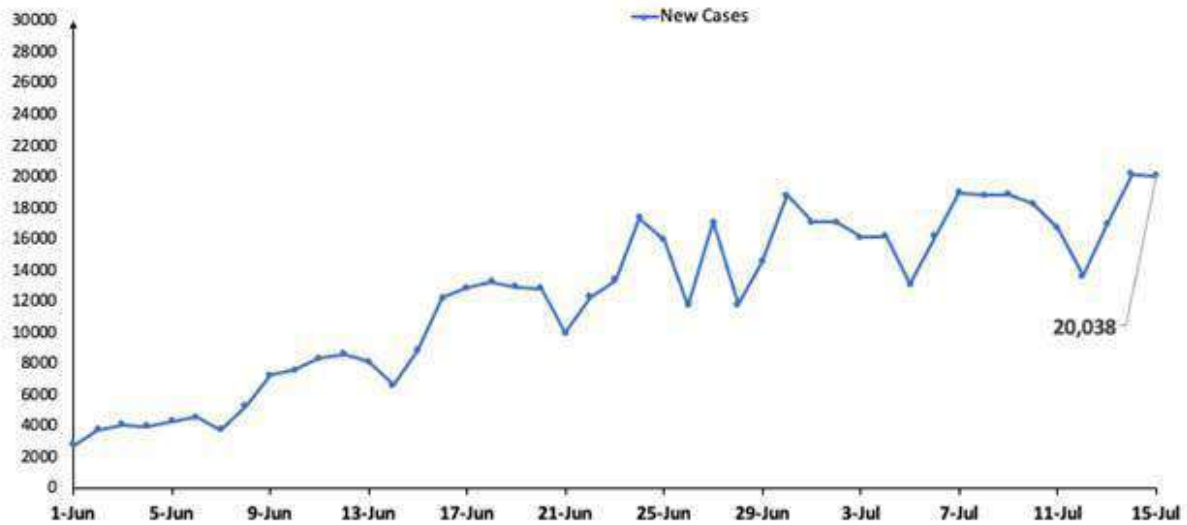

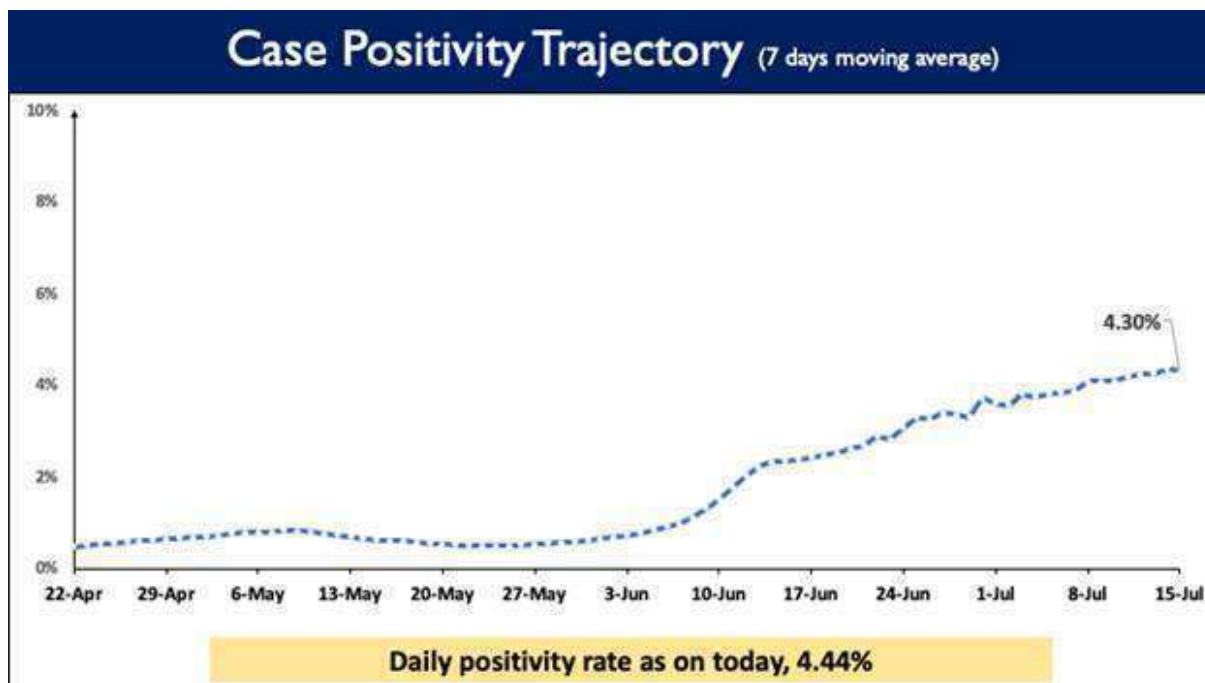

Covaxin can help in controlling the virus load of SARS-CoV-2 & its variants, reducing disease severity: Study

Scientists have found that Covaxin, which is an inactivated whole-virion vaccine, induces robust immune memory to SARS-CoV-2 and variants of concern that persist for at least 6 months after vaccination and induces memory T cells that can respond robustly against the variants. This may help in controlling the virus load and thus, reduce the disease severity.

BBV152/Covaxin vaccine is based on an Asp614Gly variant and formulated with a toll-like receptor (TLR) 7/8 agonist molecule (imidazoquinolin) adsorbed to alum. It was the first alum-imidazoquinolin adjuvanted vaccine produced in India and received emergency use authorization from WHO for use in a large population.

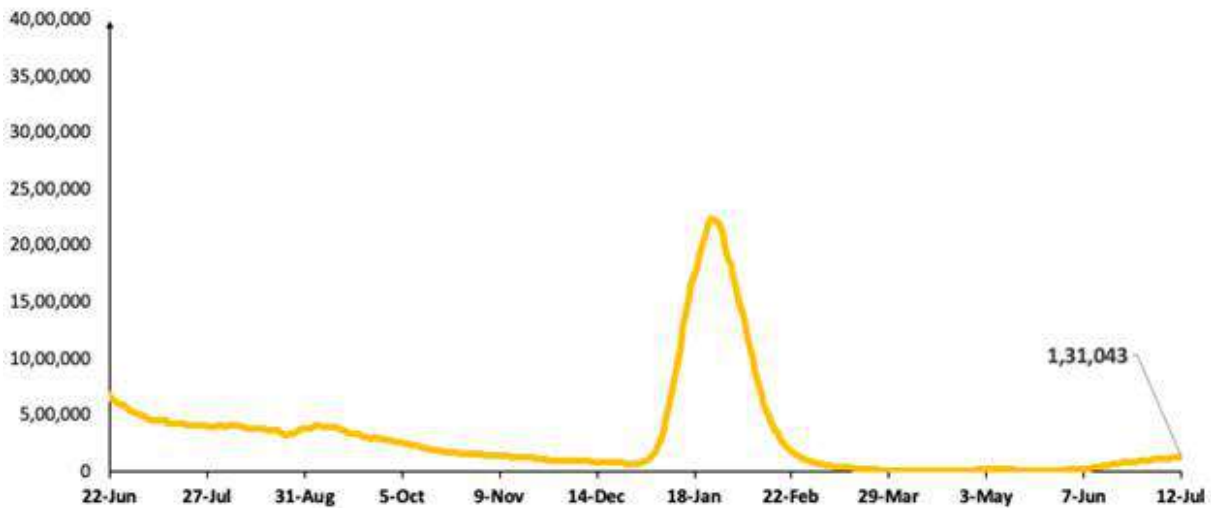

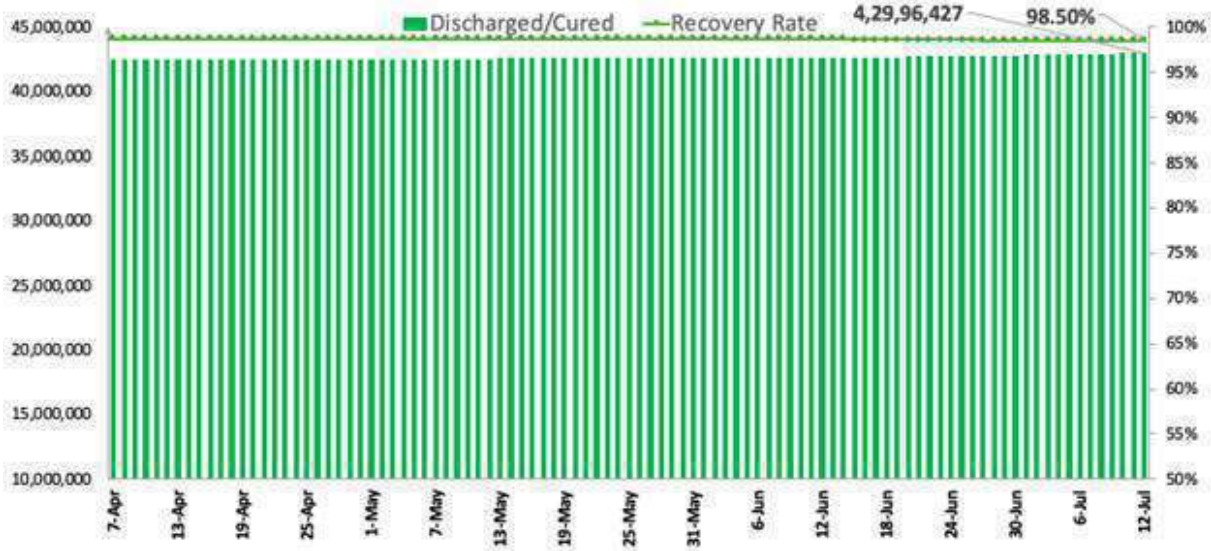
India's Active Cases Trajectory

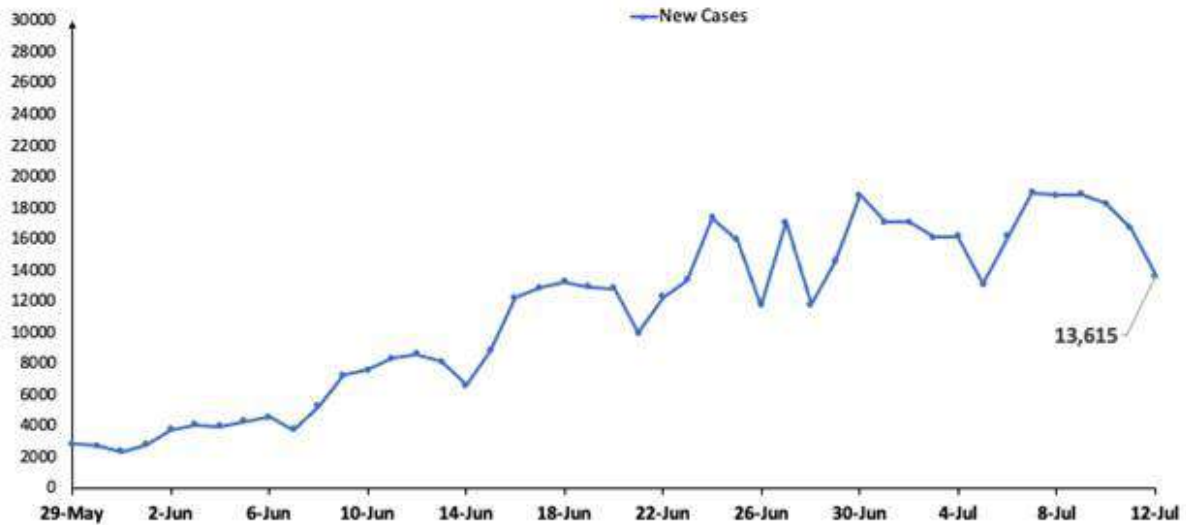

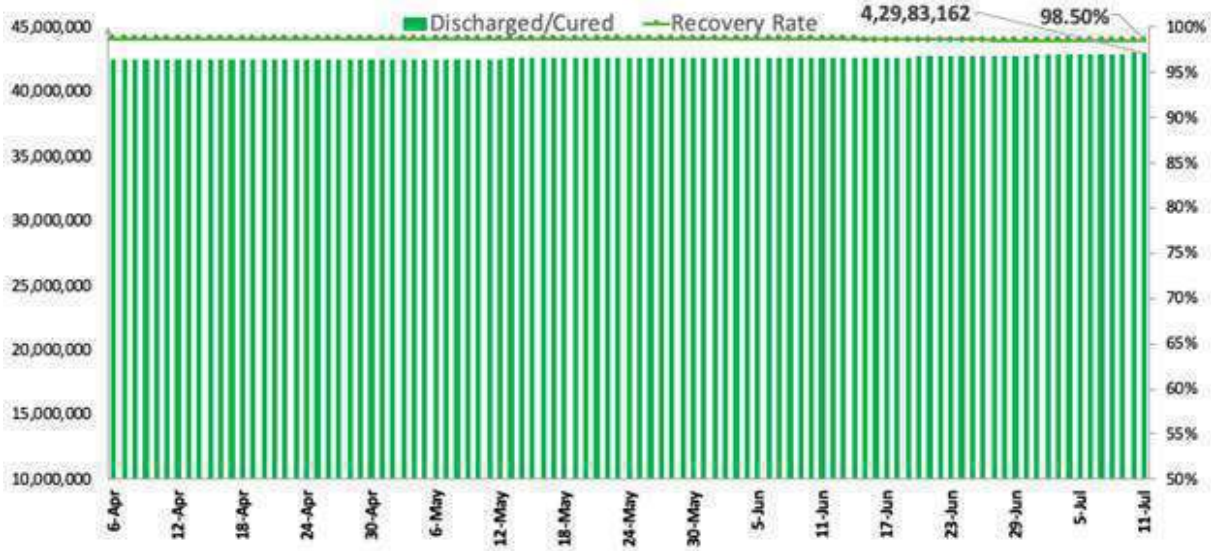
India’s Active Cases Trajectory

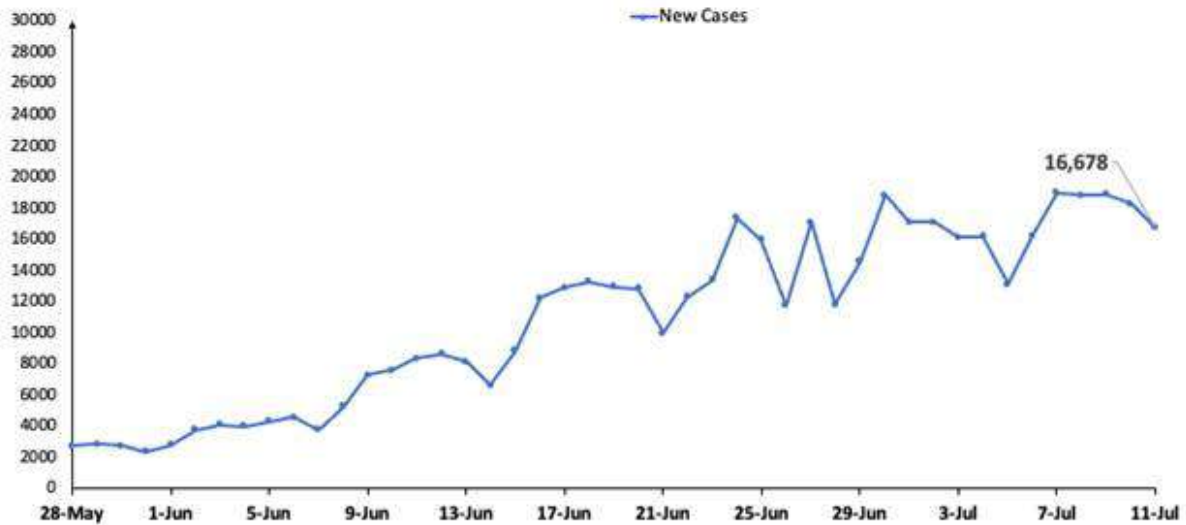

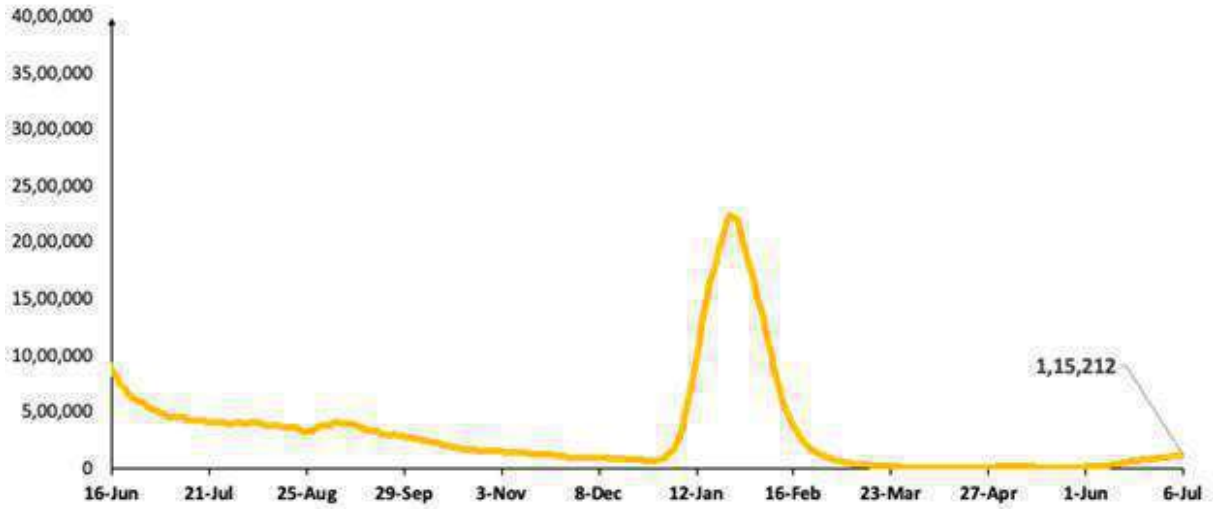

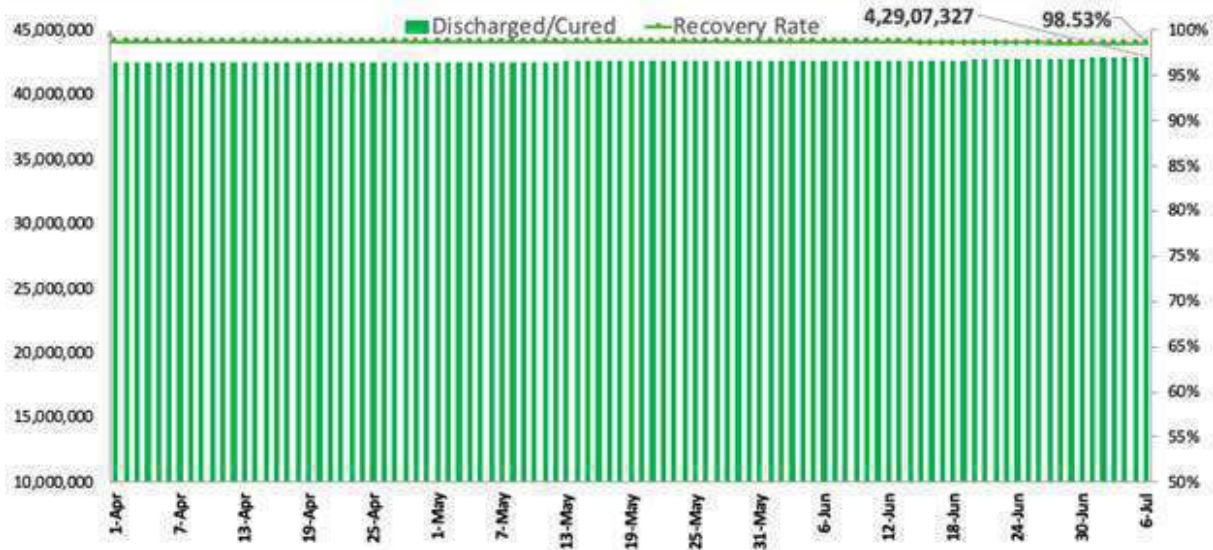


India's Active Cases Trajectory

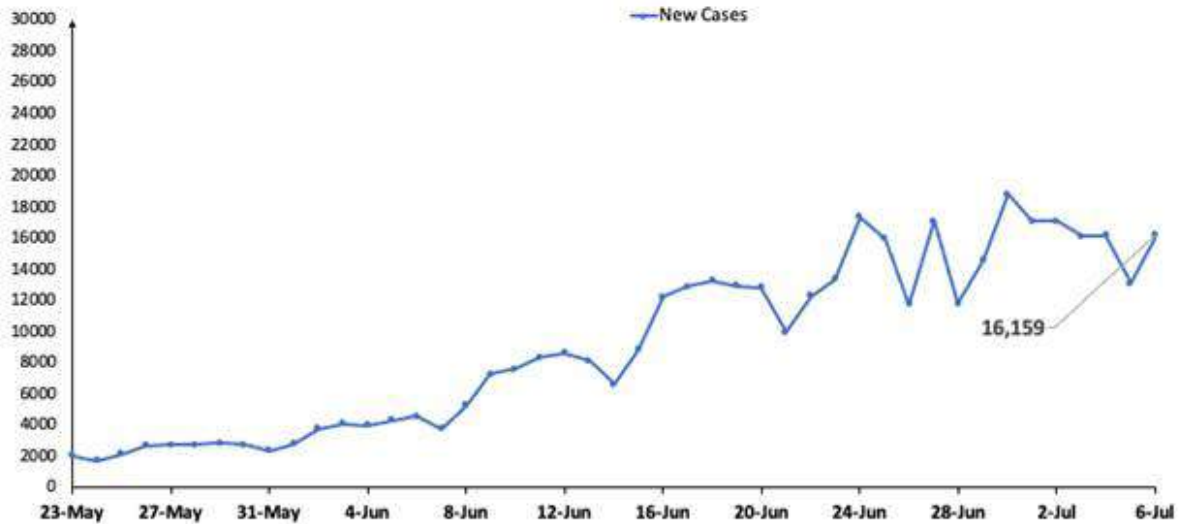

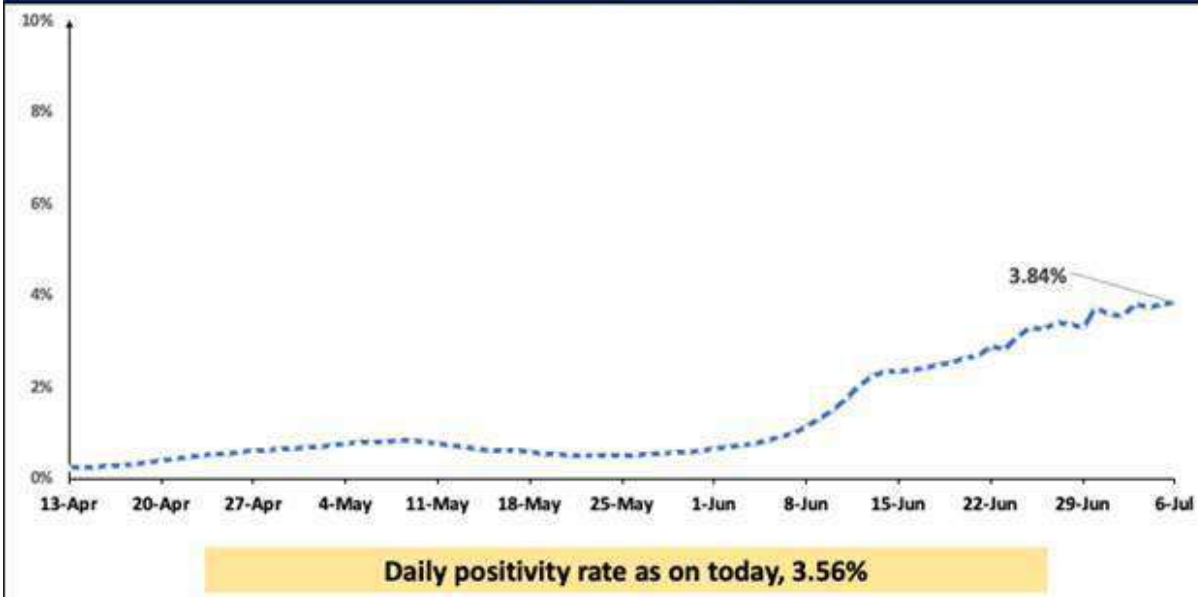

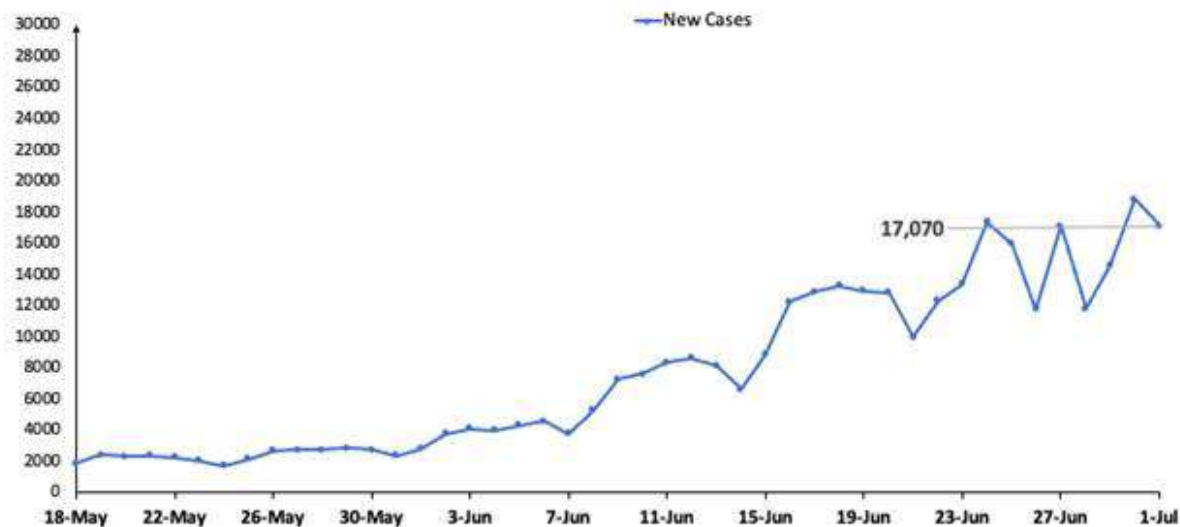


Recovered cases over 4.28 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.55%



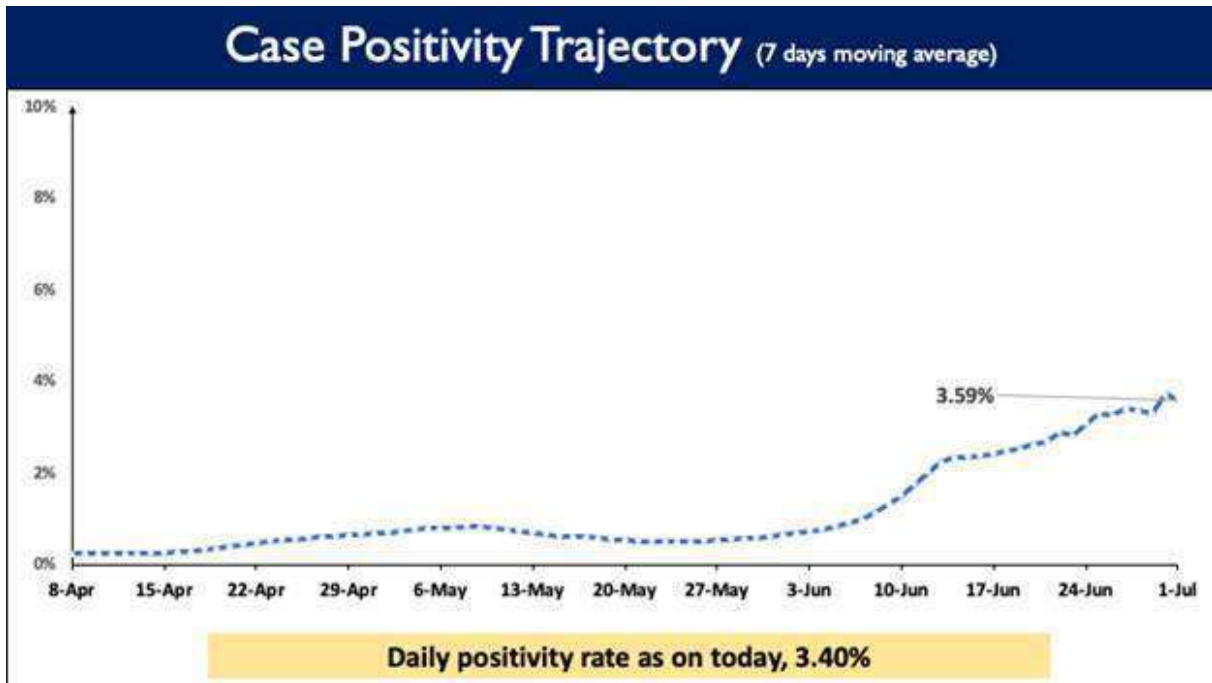

The last 24 hours saw a total of **5,02,150** COVID-19 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **86.28 Cr (86,28,77,639)** cumulative tests.

Weekly Positivity Rate in the country currently **stands at 3.59%** and the **Daily Positivity rate is reported to be 3.40%**.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

More than 193.53 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs

More than 11.36 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The nationwide COVID 19 vaccination started on 16th January 2021. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21st June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.
