India's cumulative vaccination coverage crosses 199.96 Crore

More than 23 lakh Vaccine doses administered today till 7 pm

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed **199.96 Crore (199,96,72,322)** today. More than **23 lakh (23,60,137)** Vaccine Doses have been administered till 7 pm today. The daily vaccination tally is expected to increase with the compilation of the final reports for the day by late tonight.
