More than 20 lakh Vaccine doses administered today till 7 pm

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed **207.68 Crore (2,07,68,05,074)** today. More than **20 lakh (20,13,564)** Vaccine Doses have been administered till 7 pm today. The daily vaccination tally is expected to increase with the compilation of the final reports for the day by late tonight.
