

India's Active Cases Trajectory






India's Active Cases Trajectory




Recovered cases over 4.40 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.72%






Recovered cases over 4.40 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.72%






Recovered cases over 4.39 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.71%






India's Active Cases Trajectory










Recovered cases over 4.39 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.71%




India's Active Cases Trajectory












Recovered cases over 4.39 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.71%






Recovered cases over 4.39 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.70%




India's Active Cases Trajectory


Recovered cases over 4.38 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.70%





India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has exceeded **212.39 Cr (2,12,39,92,816)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today.

COVID-19 vaccination for the age group 12-14 years was started on 16 March, 2022. So far, more than 4.03 Cr (**4,03,22,642**) adolescents have been administered with the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine. Similarly, the COVID-19 precaution dose administration for age group 18-59 years also started from 10th April, 2022 onwards.




India's Active Caseload currently stands at **59,210**. Active cases now constitute **13%** of the country's total Positive Cases.


Recovered cases over 4.38 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.68%




More than 6K New Cases reported in last 24 hrs

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The nationwide COVID 19 vaccination started on 16th January 2021. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21st June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.
