# India records a milestone in COVID19 vaccination with administration of over 4.2 cr vaccine doses

## More than 2.7 million vaccine doses given in the last 24 hours

### Maharashtra, Punjab, Karnataka, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh report a spike in Daily New Cases

India has scaled a significant peak in its battle against COVID 19 pandemic. The total vaccination coverage has surpassed **4 crores**.

**4,20,63,392** vaccine doses have been administered through **6,86,469** sessions, as per the provisional report till 7 am today.

These include **77,06,839** HCWs (1st dose), **48,04,285** HCWs (2nd dose), **79,57,606** FLWs (1<sup>st</sup> dose) and **24,17,077** FLWs (2<sup>nd</sup> Dose), **32,23,612** beneficiaries aged more than 45 years with specific co-morbidities (1<sup>st</sup> Dose) and **1,59,53,973** beneficiaries aged more than 60 years.

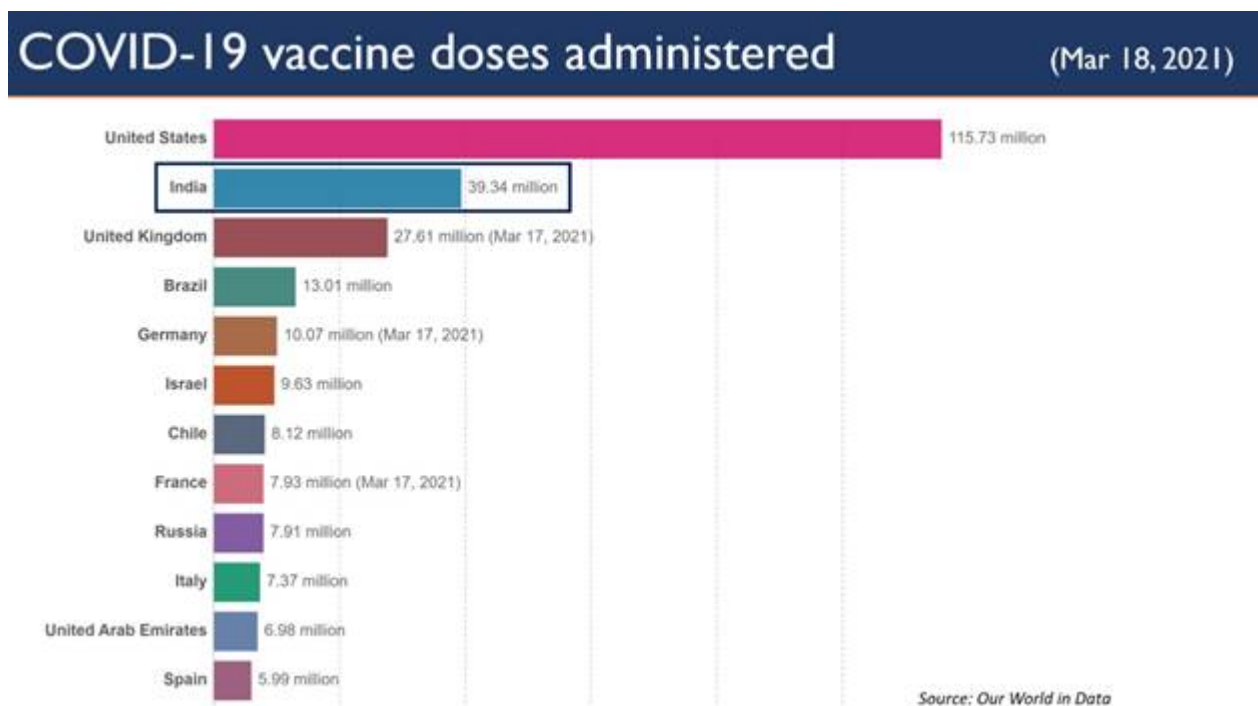
As on Day-63 of the vaccination drive (19<sup>th</sup> March, 2021), **27,23,575** vaccine doses were given.

Of the total, 24,15,800 beneficiaries were vaccinated across 38,989 sessions for 1<sup>st</sup> dose (HCWs and FLWs) and 3,07,775 HCWs and FLWs received 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of vaccine.

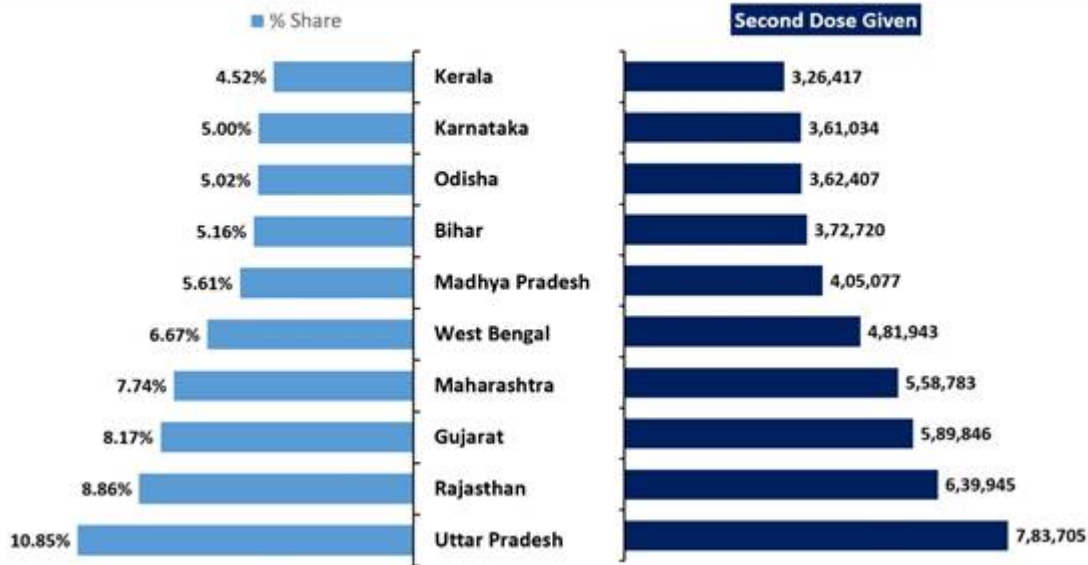
As on 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, the total number of vaccine doses administered all over the country were 39.34 million. This positions India at the second place (after the US) in terms of the number of vaccine doses administered by any country.



Eight States, as outlined, account for 60% of the cumulative vaccine doses given so far.

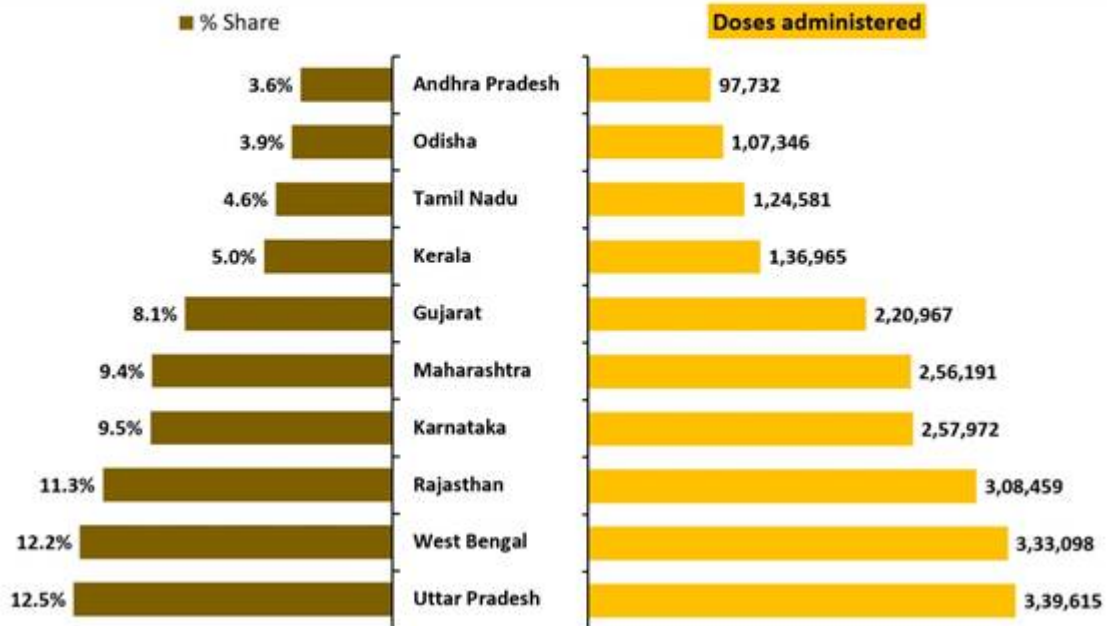


## 68% of second doses given are in 10 States

On the status of COVID19, five States of Maharashtra, Punjab, Karnataka, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh have reported a surge in the COVID daily new cases.

Six states cumulatively account for **83.7% of the new cases reported in the past 24 hours.**

**40,953** new cases were registered in the last 24 hours.

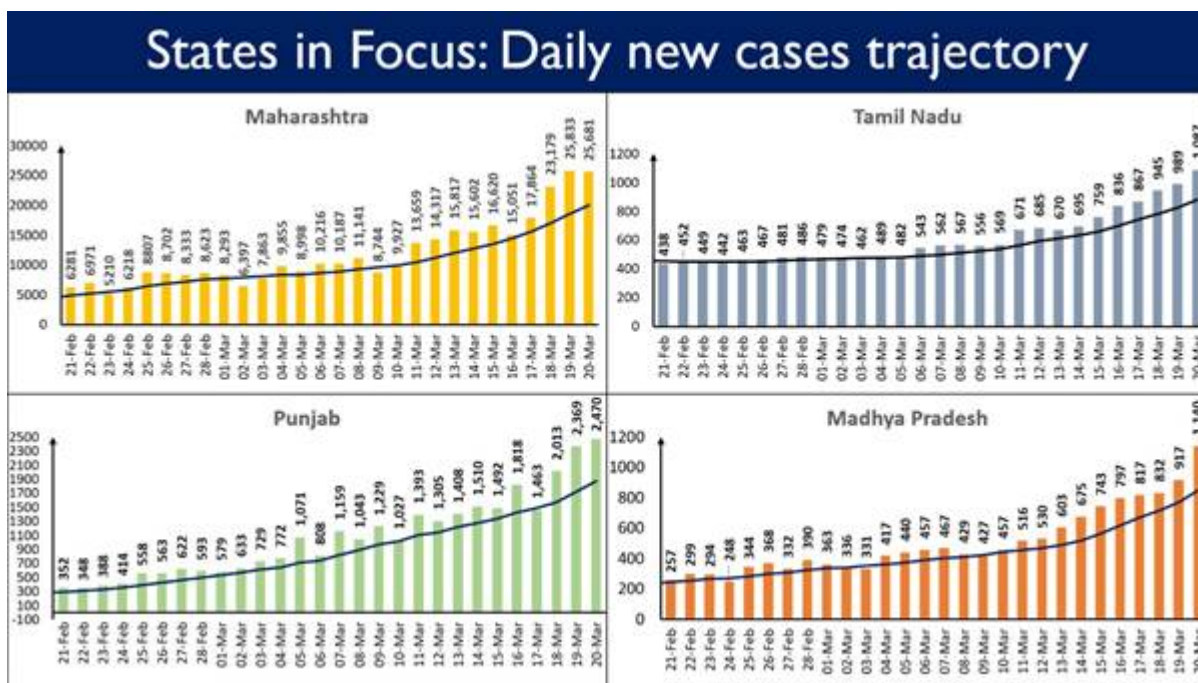
Maharashtra has reported the highest daily new cases at 25,681. It is followed by Punjab with 2,470 while Kerala reported 1,984 new cases.

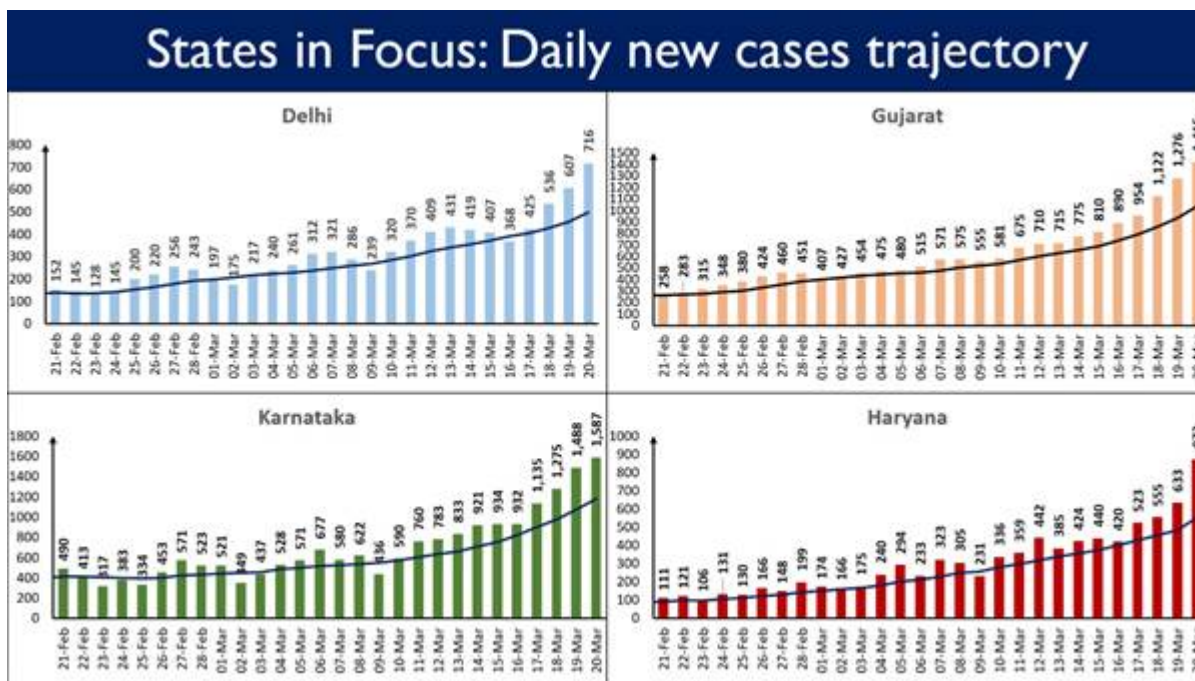




A rising trajectory of daily new cases is visible in eight states. These are Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, Madhya Pradesh, Delhi, Gujarat, Karnataka and Haryana.

Kerala is showing a consistently declining trend.

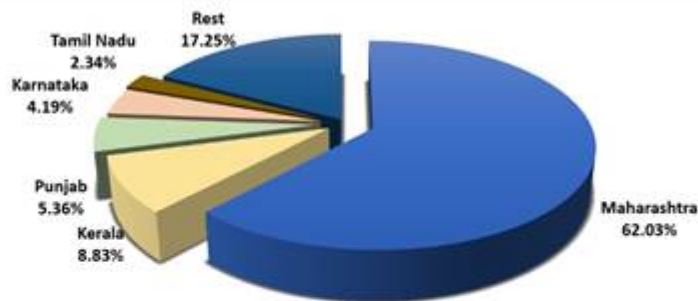




India’s total Active Caseload has reached **2,88,394 today**, comprising **2.50%** of the total Positive Cases. A net incline of 17,112 cases recorded from the total active caseload in the last 24 hours.

Maharashtra, Kerala and Punjab cumulatively account for 76.22% of India’s total active caseload.

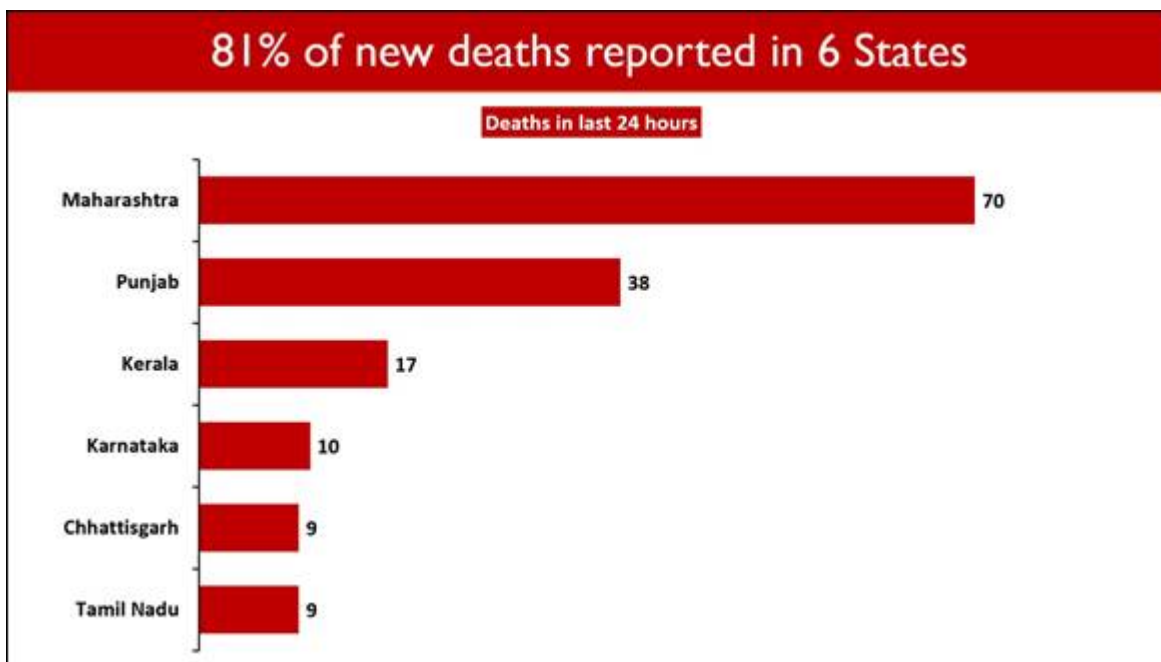

India’s cumulative recoveries stand at **1,11,07,332 today**. The national Recovery Rate is **96.12%**. **23,653** recoveries were registered in the last 24 hours.

**188** deaths were reported in the last 24 hours.

Five States account for **81.38%** of the new deaths. Maharashtra saw the maximum casualties (70). Punjab follows with 38 daily deaths and Kerala reported 17 deaths in the last 24 hours.





**Fifteen States/UTs have not reported any COVID19 deaths in the last 24 hours.** These are Assam, Uttarakhand, Odisha, Puducherry, Lakshadweep, Sikkim, Ladakh (UT), Manipur, D&N & D&N, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura, A&N Islands and Arunachal Pradesh.
