## India's Active Caseload further declines to 24,95,591

At 2.08 Lakh Cases, declining trend in new cases is maintained

A decrease of 91,191 in Active Cases in last 24 hours

2,43,50,816 total Recoveries across the country so far. Nearly 3 lakh patients recovered during last 24 hours.

Daily Recoveries continue to outnumber Daily New Cases for 13th consecutive day

Recovery Rate further increases to 89.66%

Highest ever 22.17 lakh Tests conducted in a single day

Weekly Positivity Rate currently at 11.45%

Daily Positivity Rate currently at 9.42%; less than 10% for 2 consecutive days

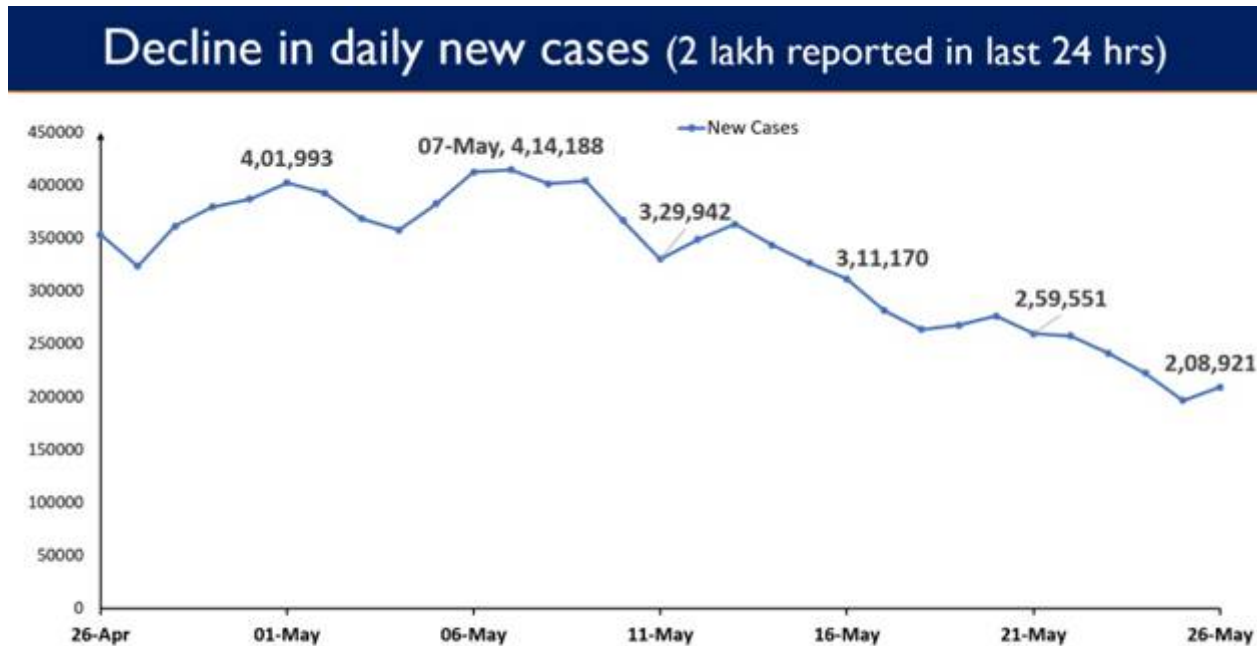
Nationwide Cumulative Vaccination Coverage crosses landmark of 20 Crore

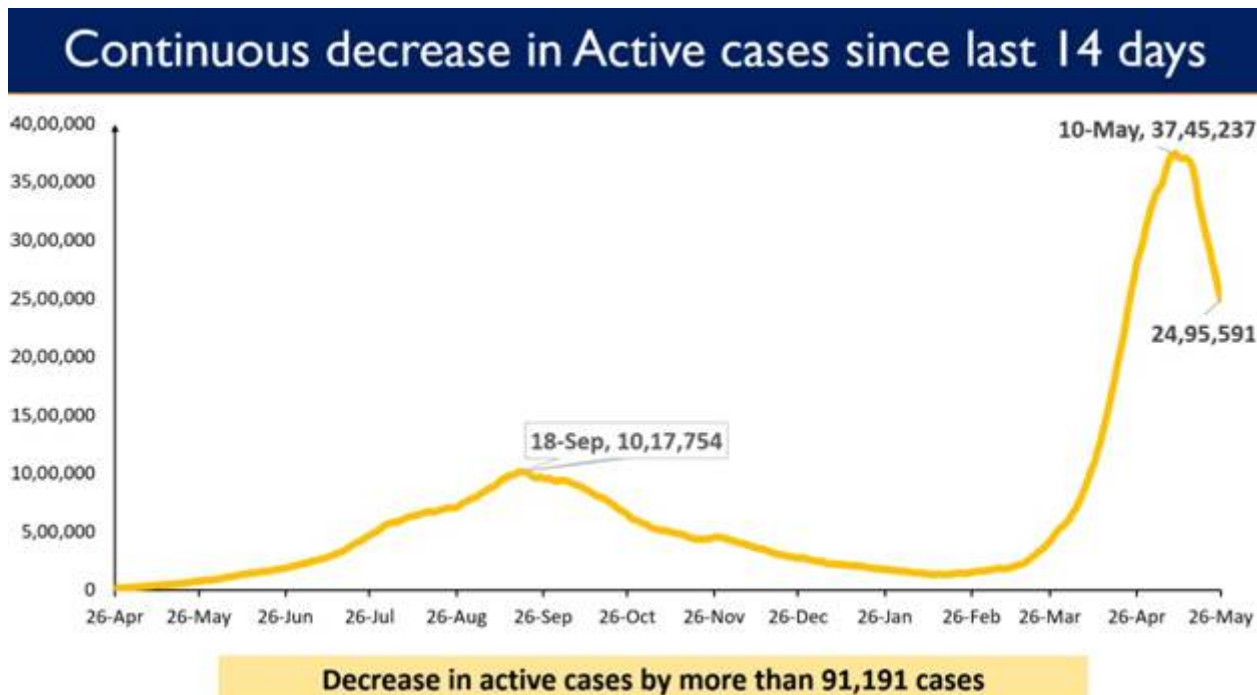
India has recorded **less than 3 lakh Daily New Cases** for ten consecutive days now.

**2,08,921** Daily New Cases were registered in the last 24 hours.



Cumulatively, the Active Caseload has also now reduced to 24,95,591. Active Cases **have decreased** since its last peak on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

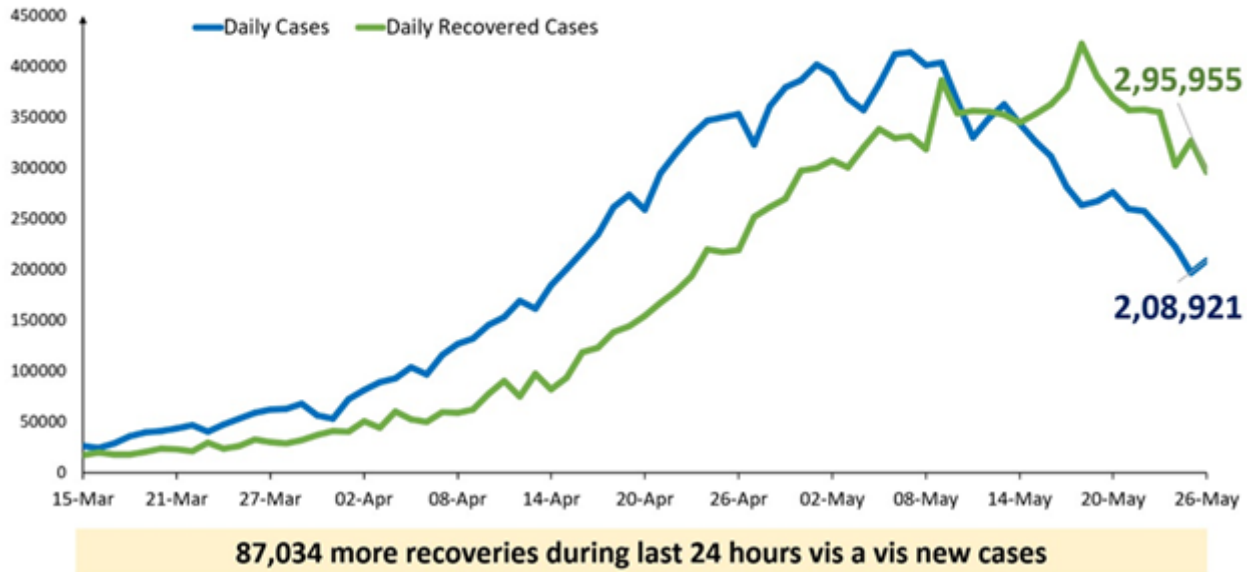
A net decline of **91,191** is witnessed in the last 24 hours. It now comprises **9.19%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



India's Daily Recoveries continue to outnumber the Daily New Cases for the 13th consecutive day. **2,95,955** recoveries were registered in the last 24 hours. 87,034 more recoveries during the last 24 hours as compared to the daily new cases.

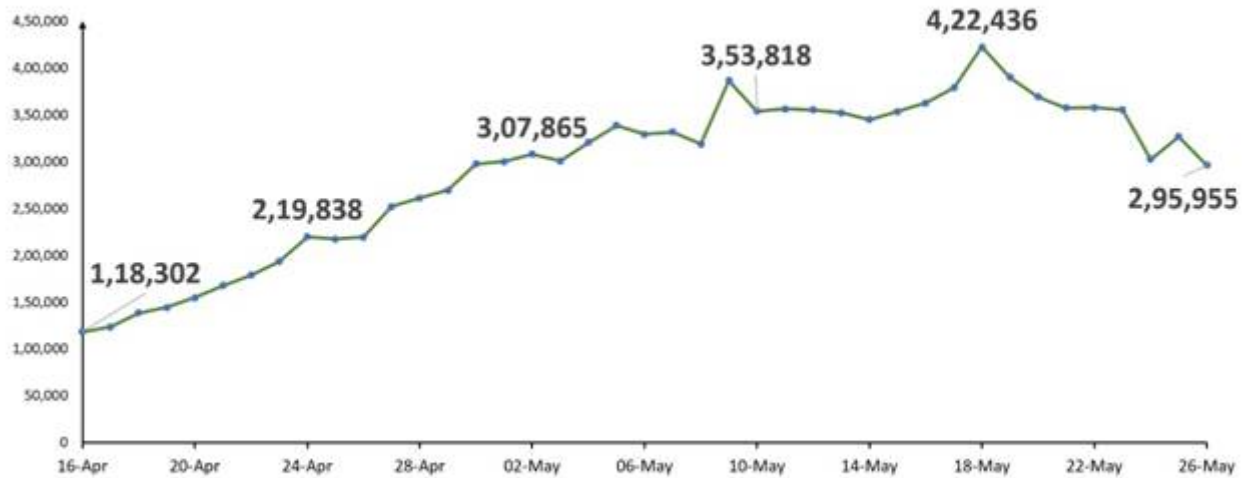


## Recoveries exceeding the Daily cases reported



India's cumulative recoveries have reached **2,43,50,816** today with the **2,95,955** patients who have recovered in the last 24 hours.. The National Recovery Rate has grown further to touch **89.66%**.

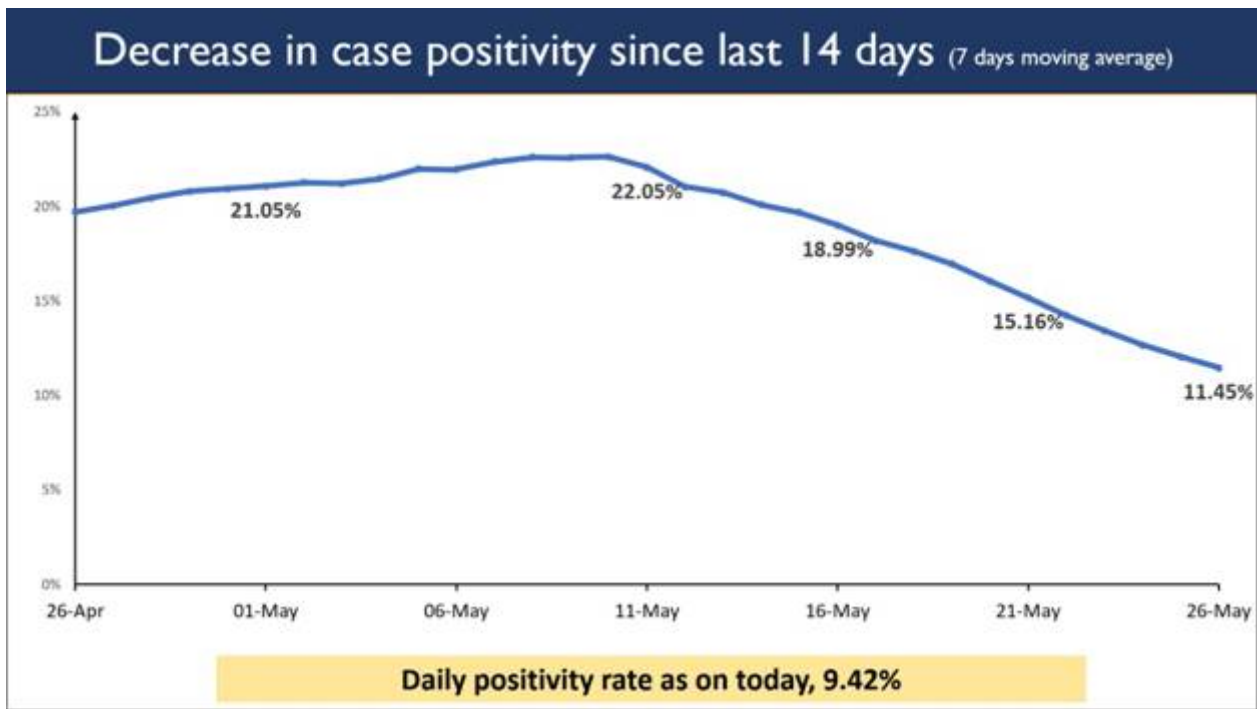
## Daily Recovered Cases



On another front, the **highest ever single day tests 22,17,320** were conducted in the last 24 hours in the country and cumulatively 33,48,11,496 tests have been done so far.

The **Weekly Positivity Rate is currently at 11.45%** while the **Daily Positivity rate has reduced and now stands at 9.42%** today. It has remained less than 10% for 2 consecutive days now.





India has achieved a new milestone in its vaccination drive as the cumulative number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country has exceeded **20 Cr** today under the Phase-3 of the Nationwide Vaccination Drive.

A total of **20,06,62,456** vaccine doses have been administered through 28,70,378 sessions, as per the provisional report till 7 am today. These include **97,96,058** HCWs who have taken the 1<sup>st</sup> dose and **67,29,213** HCWs who have taken the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, **1,51,71,950** FLWs (1<sup>st</sup> dose), **83,84,001** FLWs (2<sup>nd</sup> dose), **1,29,57,009** beneficiaries under 18-44 age group (1<sup>st</sup> dose), **6,20,88,772** (1<sup>st</sup> dose) and **1,00,30,729** (2<sup>nd</sup> dose) beneficiaries aged 45 to 60 years. **5,71,35,804** 1<sup>st</sup> dose beneficiaries and **1,83,68,920** 2<sup>nd</sup> dose beneficiaries of more than 60 years old.
