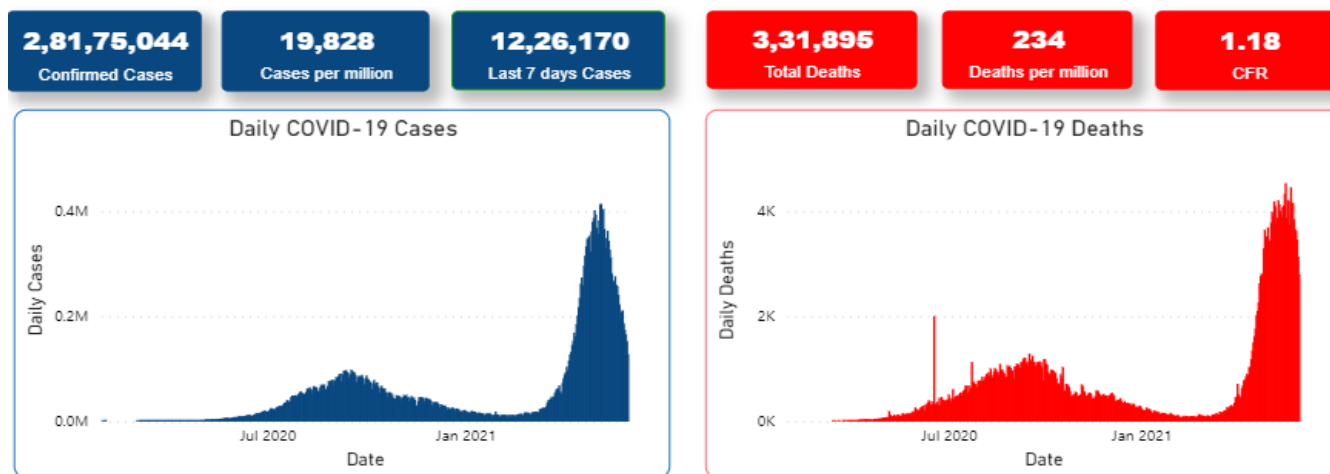

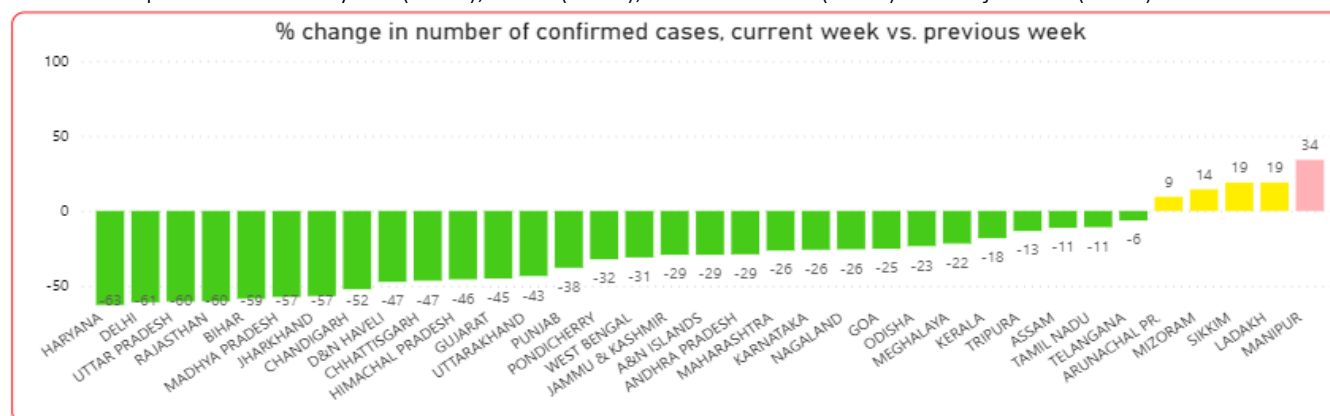
INDIA SITUATION

- There is a decline of 69% in daily cases during last 25 days after reporting the highest number of cases (4,14,188) on 7th May 2021.



COVID-19: STATUS ACROSS STATES

- In the past week, as compared to previous week, 30 states/UTs have shown a decrease in cases. Higher decline has been reported from Haryana (-63%), Delhi (-61%), Uttar Pradesh (-60%) and Rajasthan (-60%).

- In **Punjab**, District authorities have been directed to allow issue of oxygen cylinders to patients who require oxygen assistance after being discharged from the hospital
- In **Telangana**, Mucormycosis was declared a notifiable disease under epidemic act 1897 and all Government and private hospitals have been directed to report all suspected and confirmed cases on daily basis to the IDSP
- In **Andhra Pradesh**, instructions regarding prevention and management of COVID-19 - containing and controlling infection in peri-urban, rural, and tribal areas, have been issued by the Chief Secretary
- In **Kerala**, going forward, the state will adopt the education of children orphaned during COVID-19 and will support them financially
- In **Maharashtra**, State COVID taskforce and pediatric taskforce have jointly appealed to the state government to inoculate children younger than 5 years with the influenza vaccine

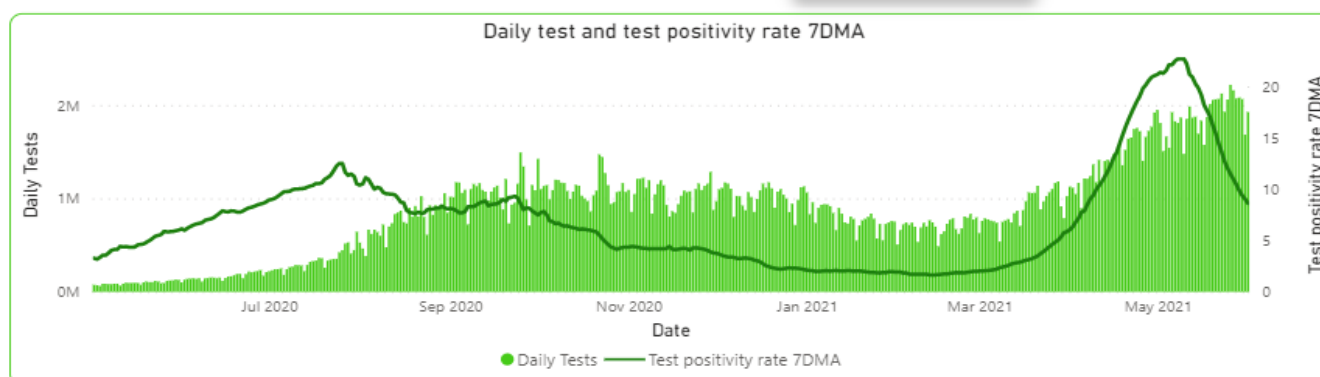

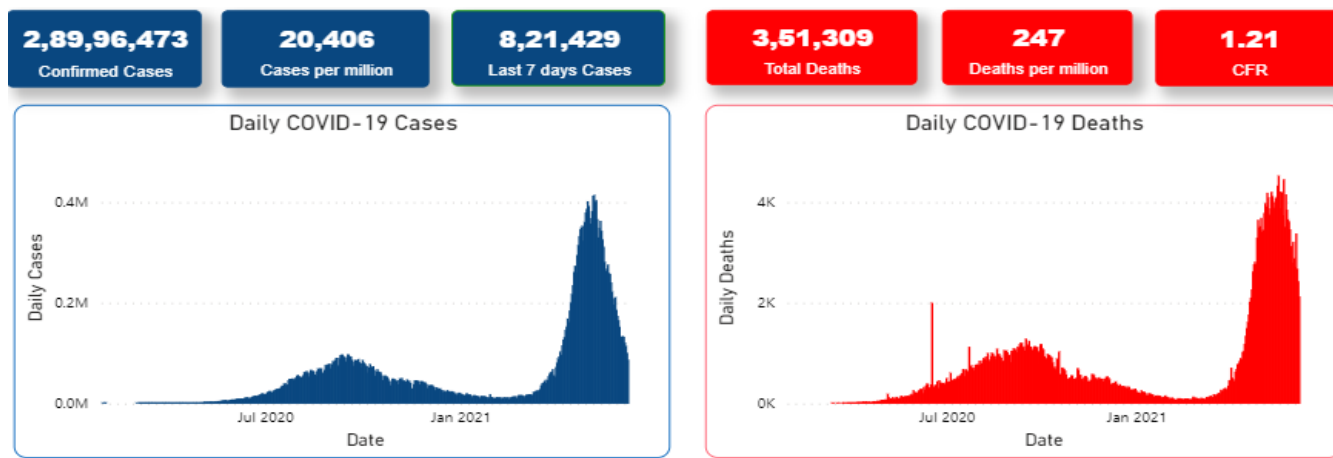

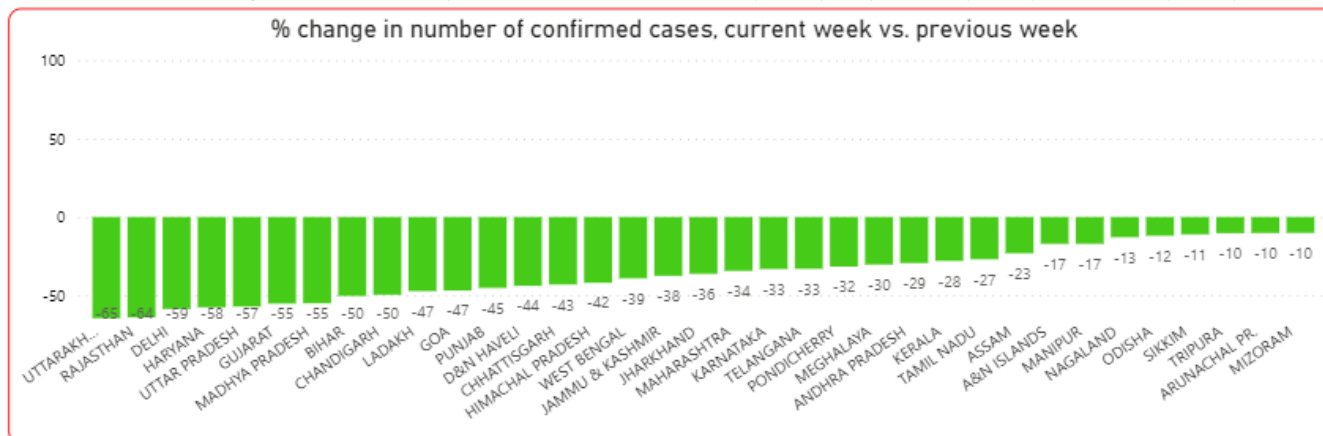
INDIA SITUATION

- There is a decline in number of cases since last week though India accounts for 28% of new cases reported in the world.



COVID-19: STATUS ACROSS STATES

- In the past week (2-8 June), as compared to previous week (26 May – 1 June), all states/UTs have shown a decrease in cases. Higher decrease reported from Uttarakhand (-65%), Rajasthan (-64%) and Delhi (-60%).

- In **Punjab**, Chief Minister virtually inaugurated a 50-bed pediatric COVID care ward, in CMC Hospital, Ludhiana in preparation for the third wave of the pandemic
- In **Maharashtra**, the government has put a cap on cost of treatment for mucormycosis in private hospitals
- In **Tamil Nadu**, a technical committee to review and monitor the rising incidence of Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (MIS-C) has been established

- Around 70 tents for setting up auxiliary health facility has been received by **Maharashtra, Assam, Odisha, Jharkhand and Bihar**. States are setting up the tents with guidance from WCO.
- WCO continues to provide technical support to MoHFW, NCDC, ICMR and NDMA at the national level and through task force/control rooms at the state and district level in **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and Puducherry**

COVID-19 vaccination

- WCO is supporting monitoring of vaccination sessions across the country and continues to provide surge support for training, microplanning and monitoring
- Supported training of vaccinators in **Chhattisgarh** regarding proper filling of vaccine utilization reports to better reconcile vaccine wastage
- Assisting **Gujarat** with review of COVID-19 vaccination data and field visits to assess gaps in coverage; 5 districts have been visited so far and observations and recommendations have been shared with the state
- Supporting district level workshops in **Karnataka** on COVID vaccination and AEFI, basis guidelines shared by state on vaccinating those between 18-44 years of age

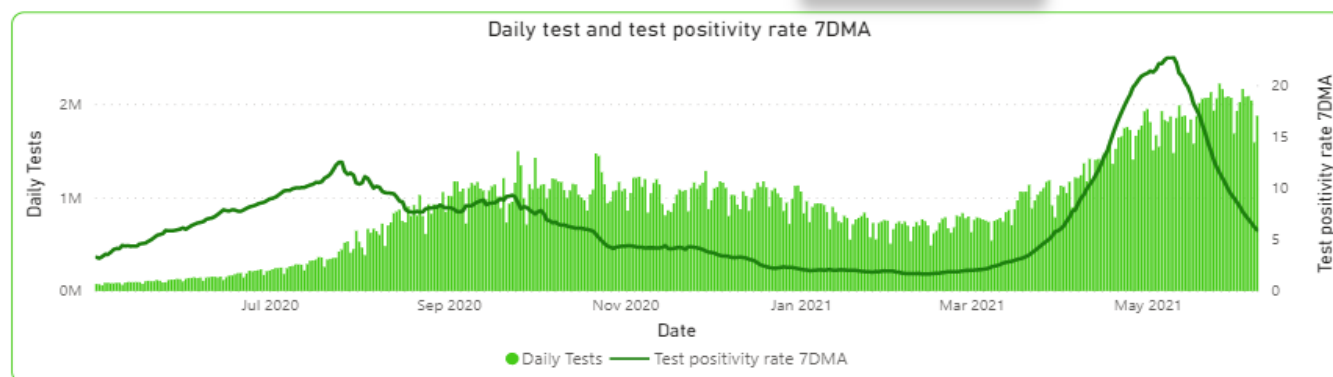

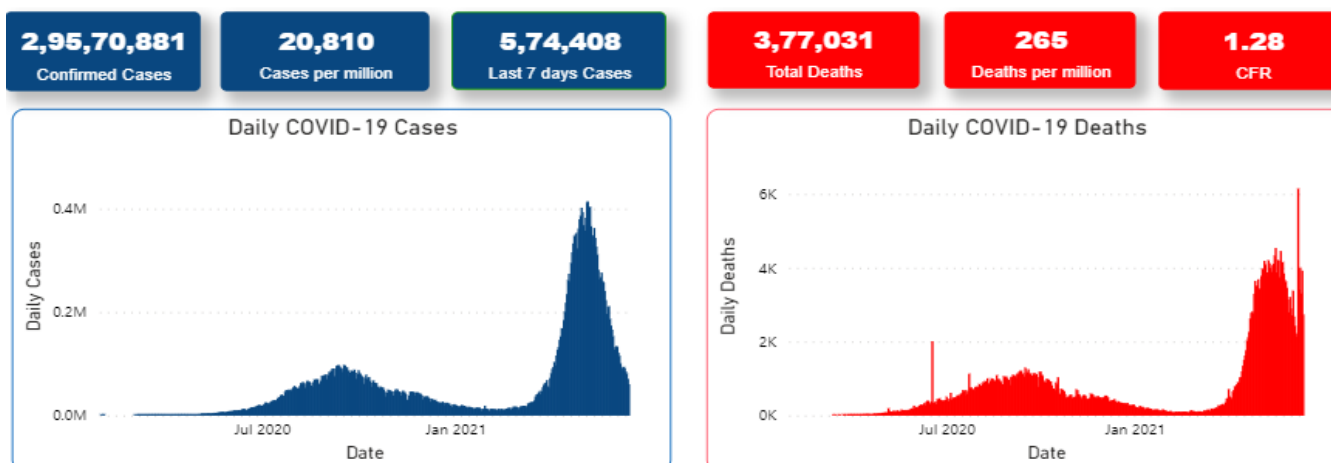

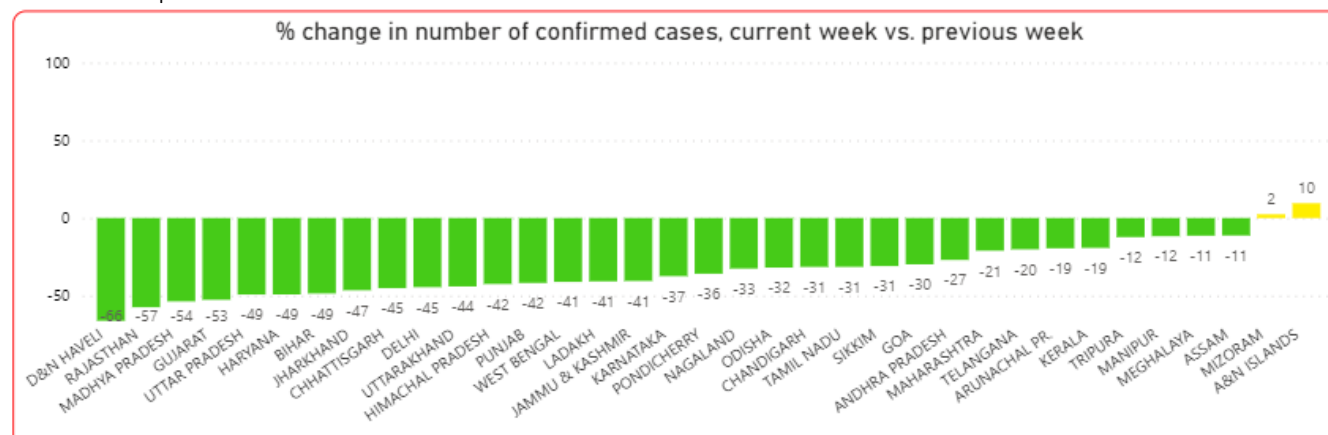
INDIA SITUATION

- In **Kerala**, plans have been made to upgrade infrastructure of medical colleges, district hospitals, and block/taluka hospitals to facilitate effective pediatric case management
- In **Tamil Nadu**, task force committee has been constituted for supporting surge capacity in case of a third wave
- In **Himachal Pradesh**, directives have been issued to administer second dose of Covishield between 28-84 days of first dose to facilitate smooth foreign travel for the purpose of education, employment, sports events, etc.
- In **Punjab**, the Chief Minister has asserted that a group of specialist pediatrics will develop treatment protocol for the possible third wave of COVID-19

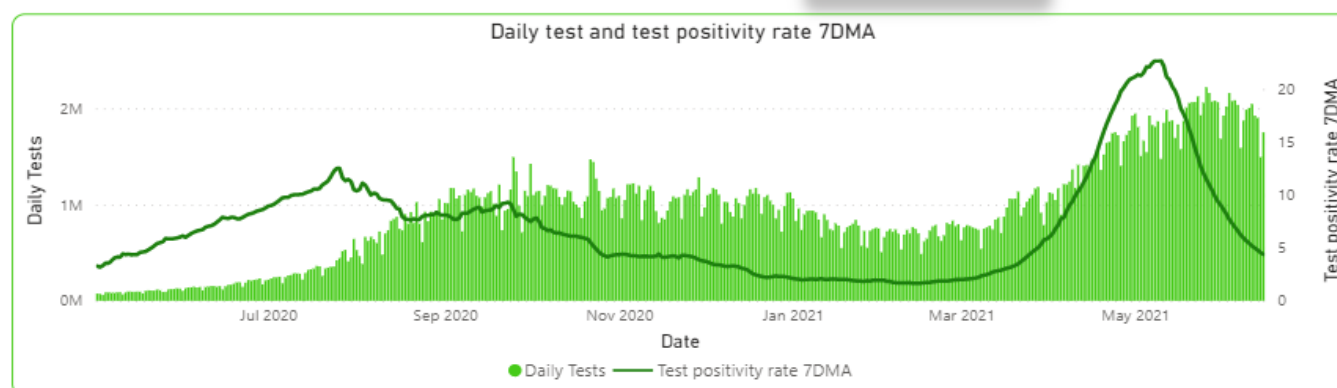

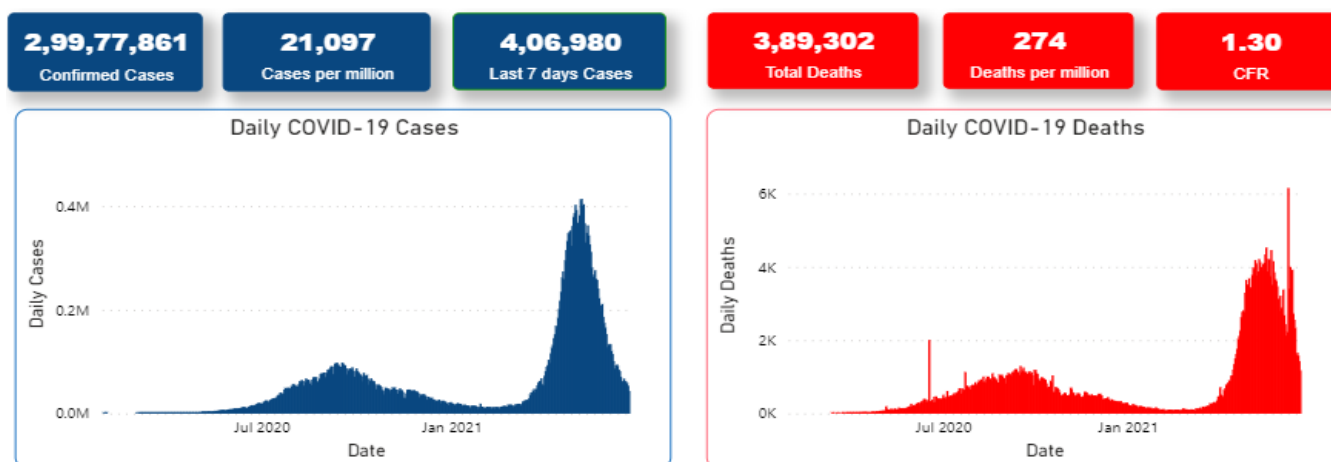

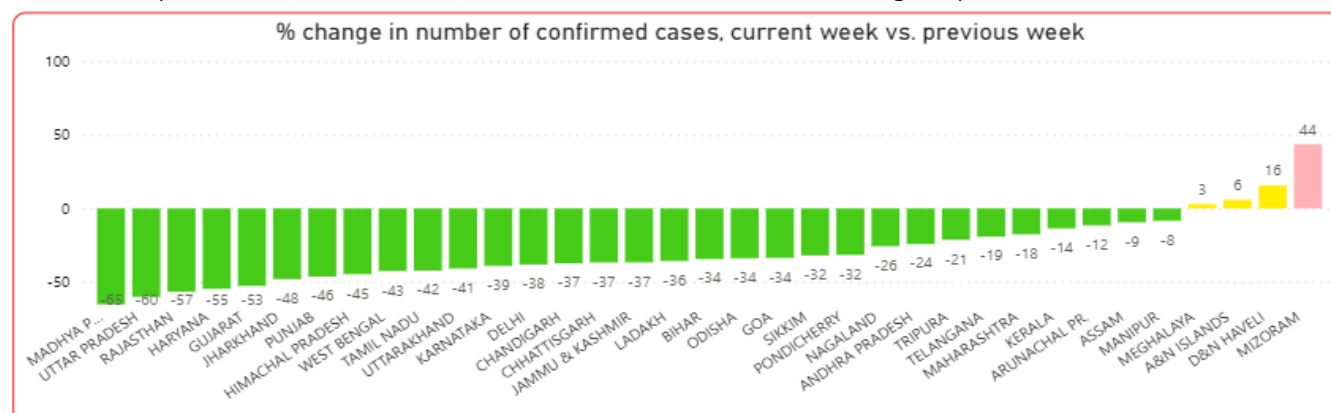
INDIA SITUATION

- In India, highest number of cases in a day were 4,14,188; reported on 7th May 2021. Since then there is continuous decline in daily cases. India accounts for 16% of daily cases reported globally with 21,097 cases per million.

- High level oversight during vaccination is provided by WHO teams at district and state levels.
- WCO is supporting monitoring of vaccination sessions across the country and continues to provide surge support for training, microplanning and monitoring.

- Country office continues to provide technical support for COVID-19 containment activities in **Uttar Pradesh**; and supportive supervision to monitor contact tracing; identify containment zones and sharing regular feedback with government health officials on regular basis.

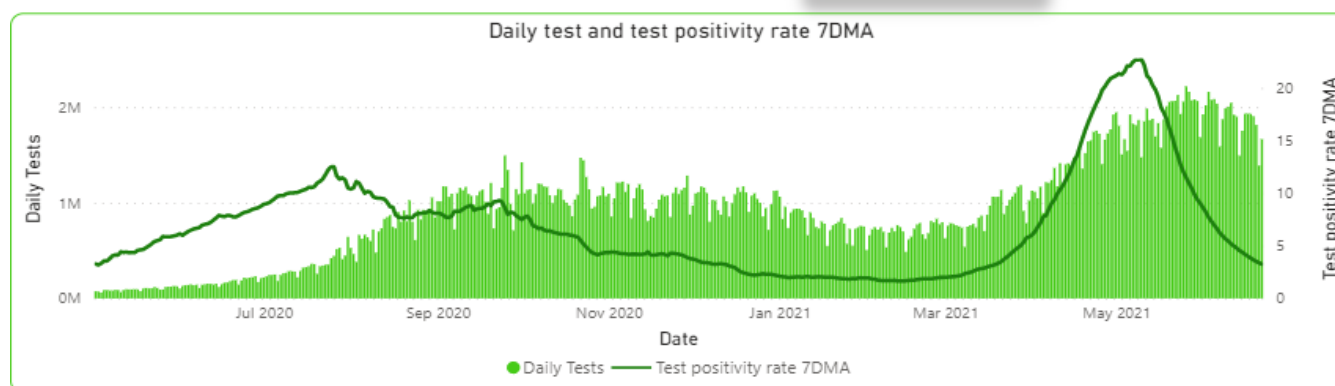

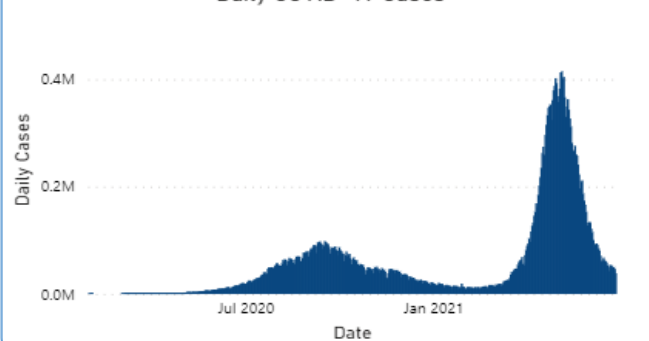

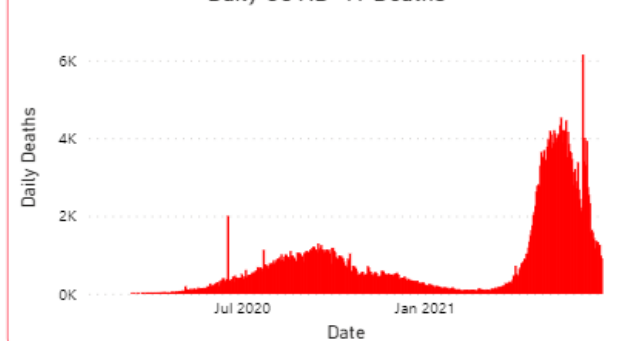

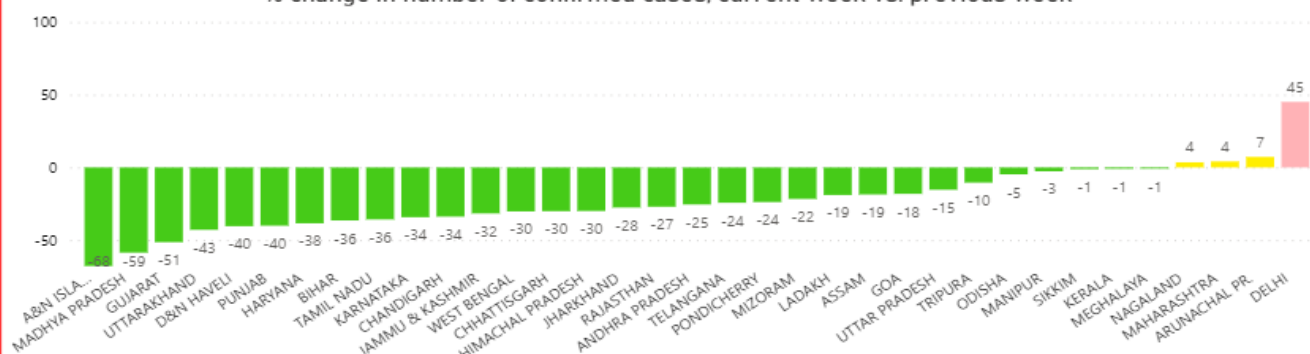
