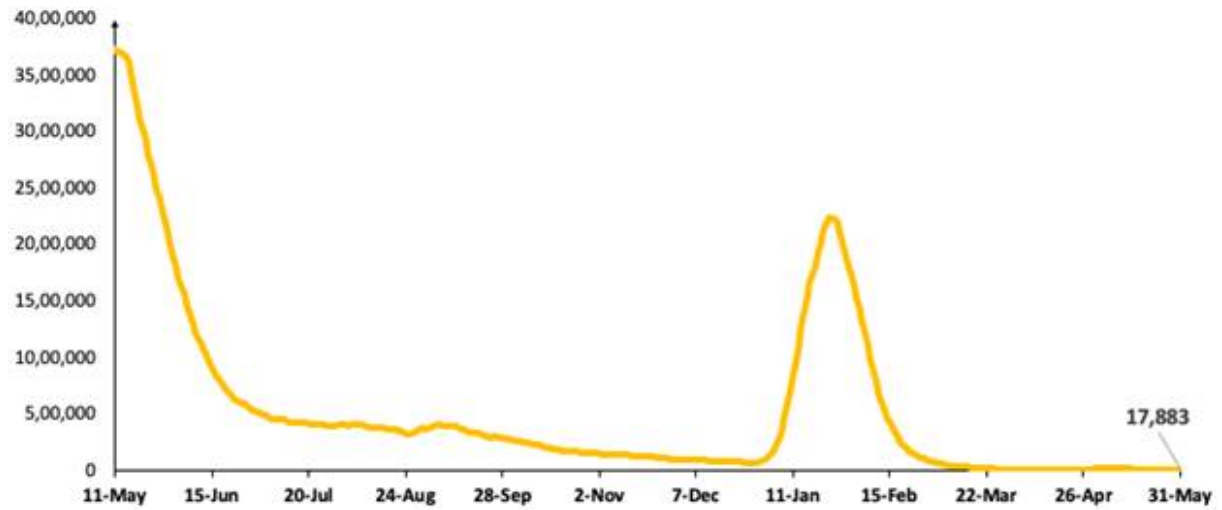

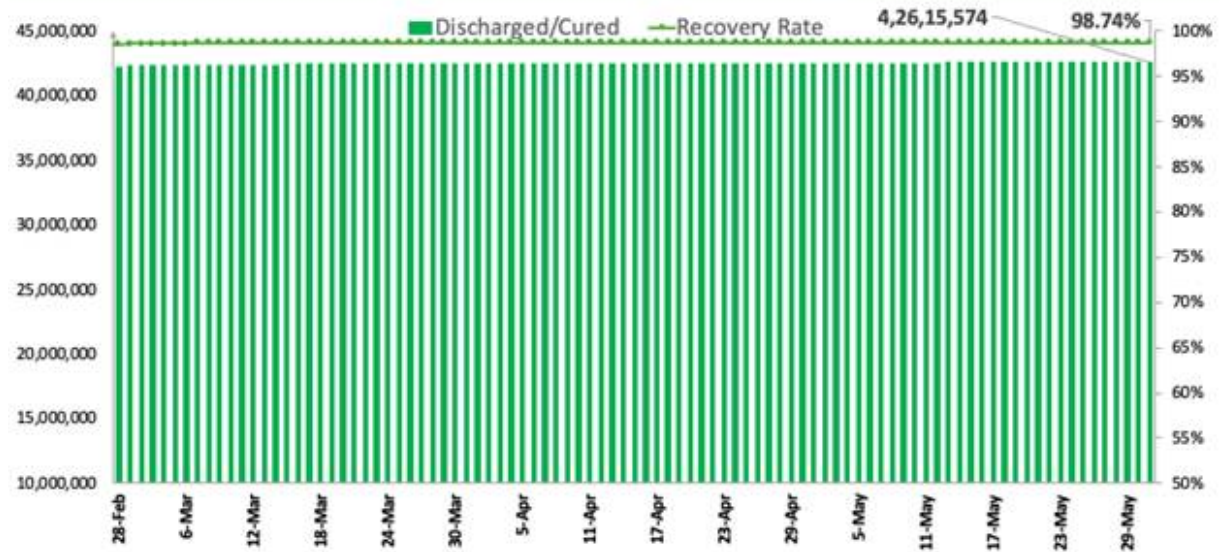


India's Active Cases Trajectory

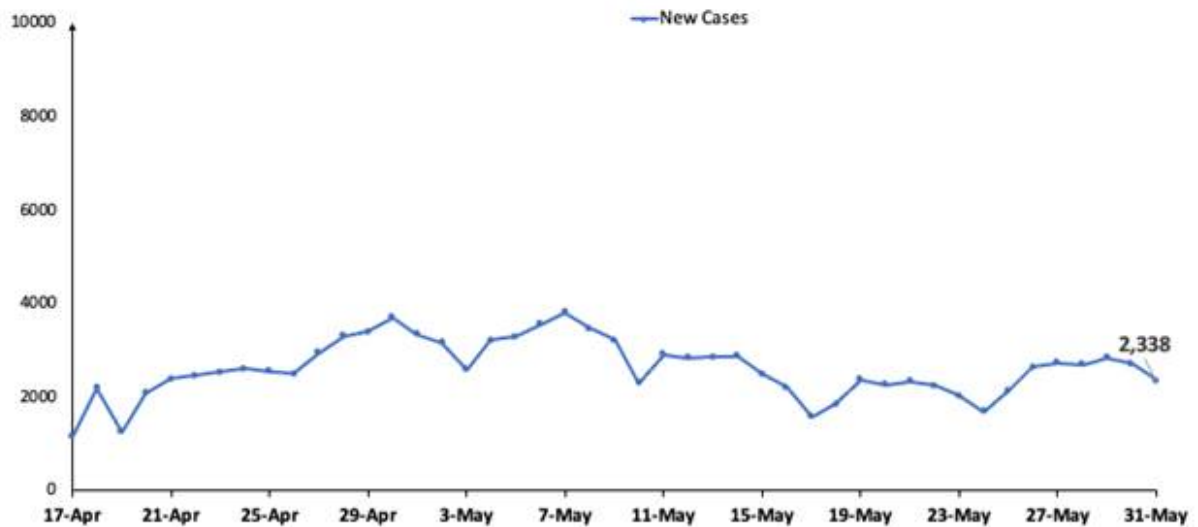
Recovered cases over 4.26 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%

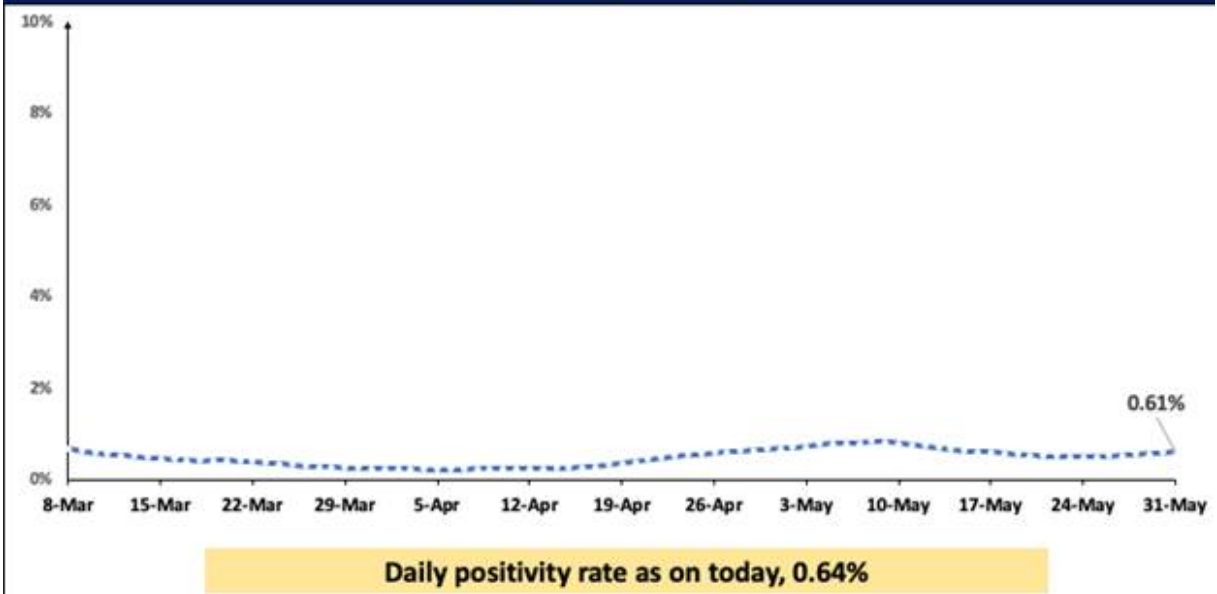

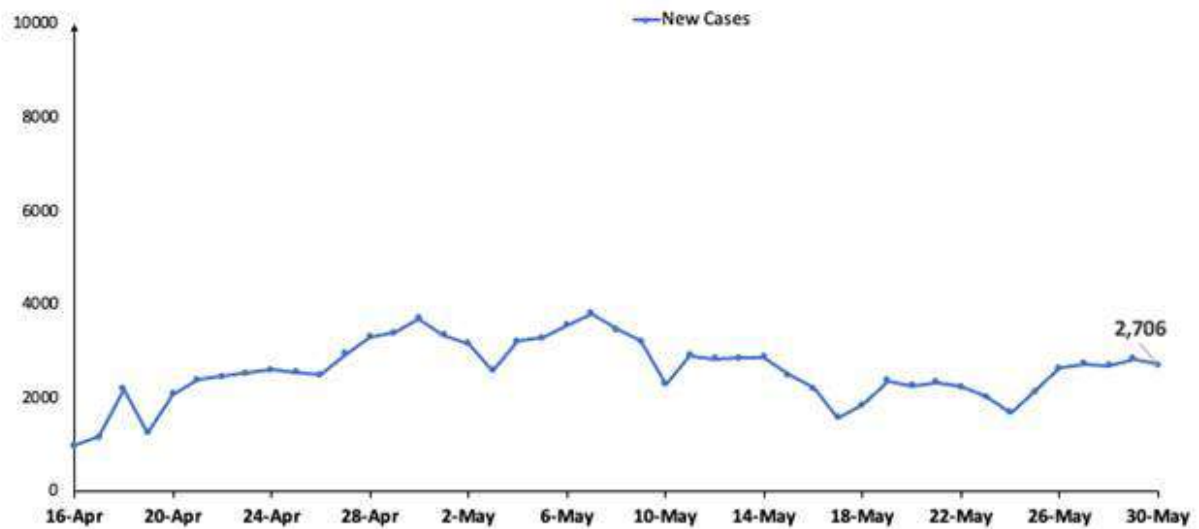


Recovered cases over 4.26 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%

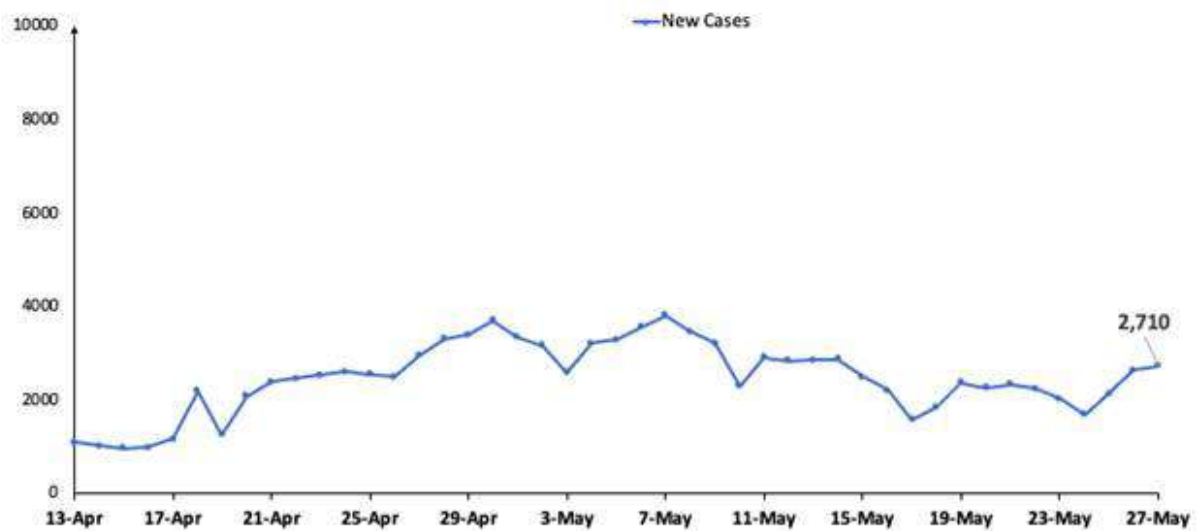


Recovered cases over 4.26 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.75%

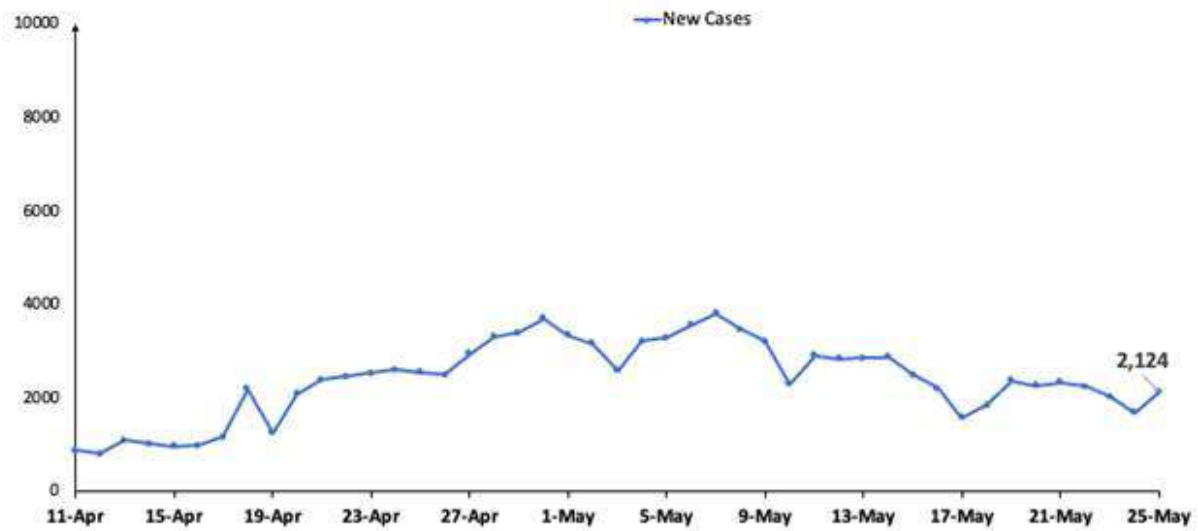

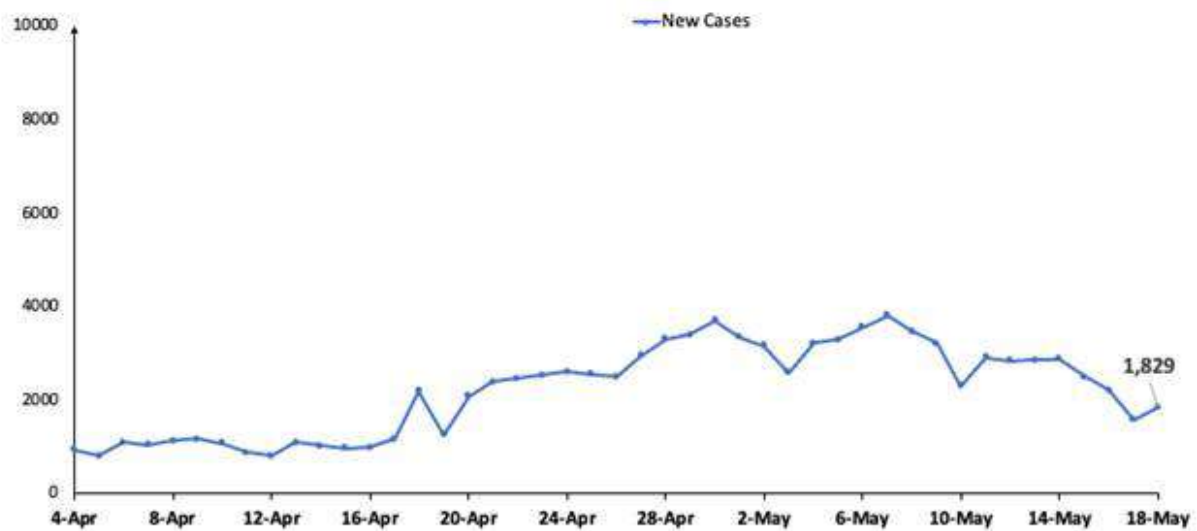


Recovered cases over 4.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.75%

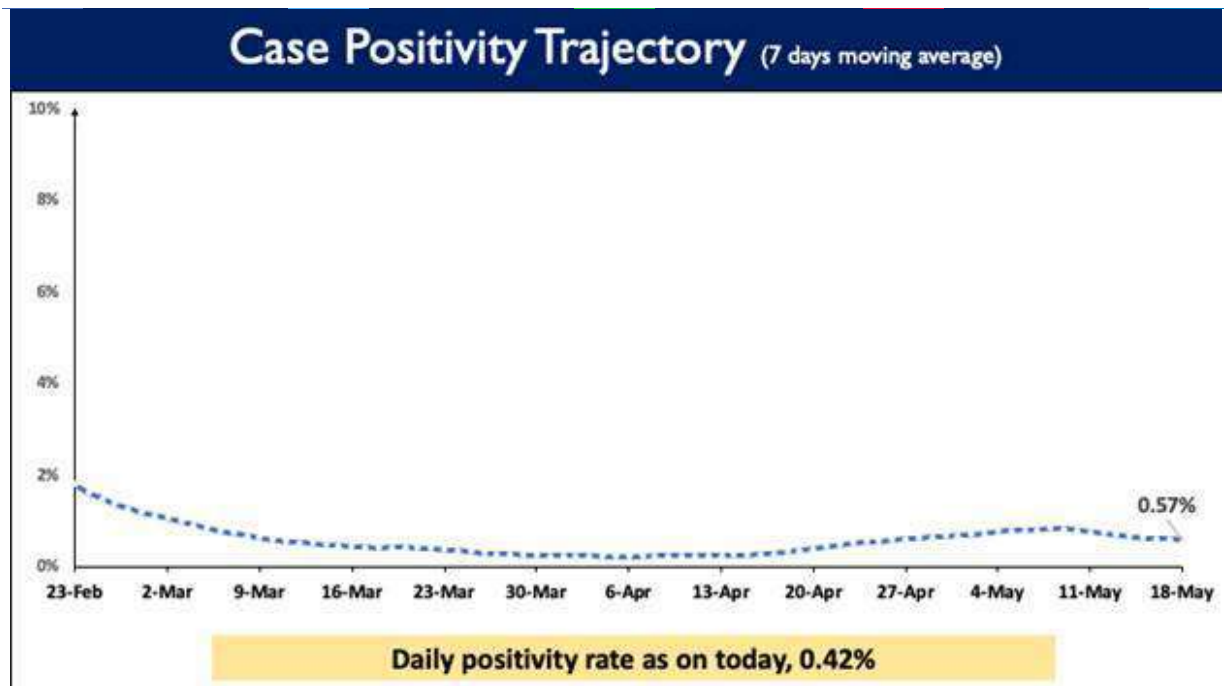

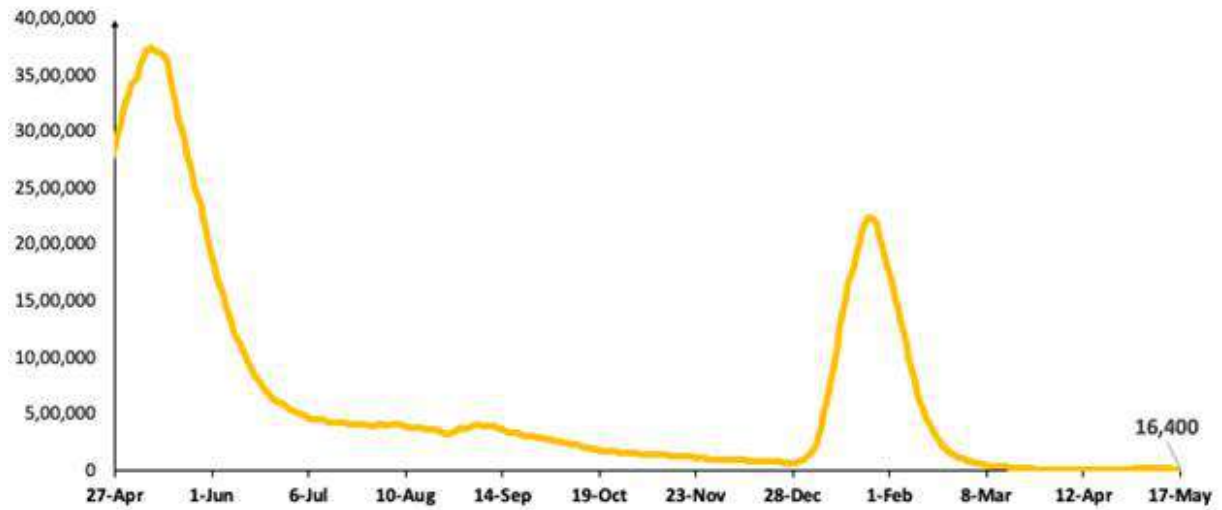

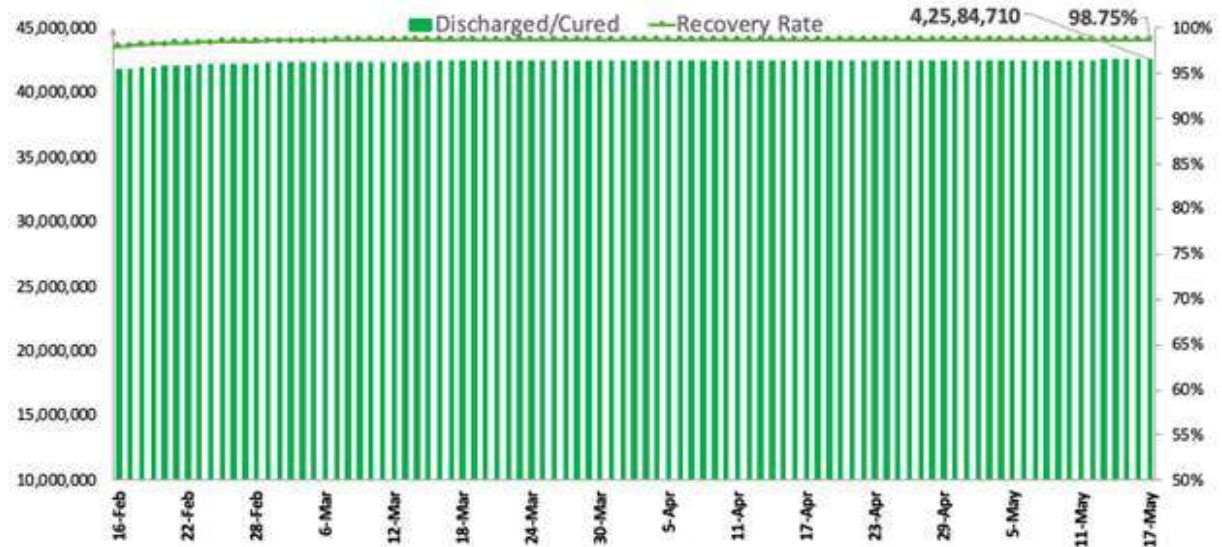


India's Active Cases Trajectory

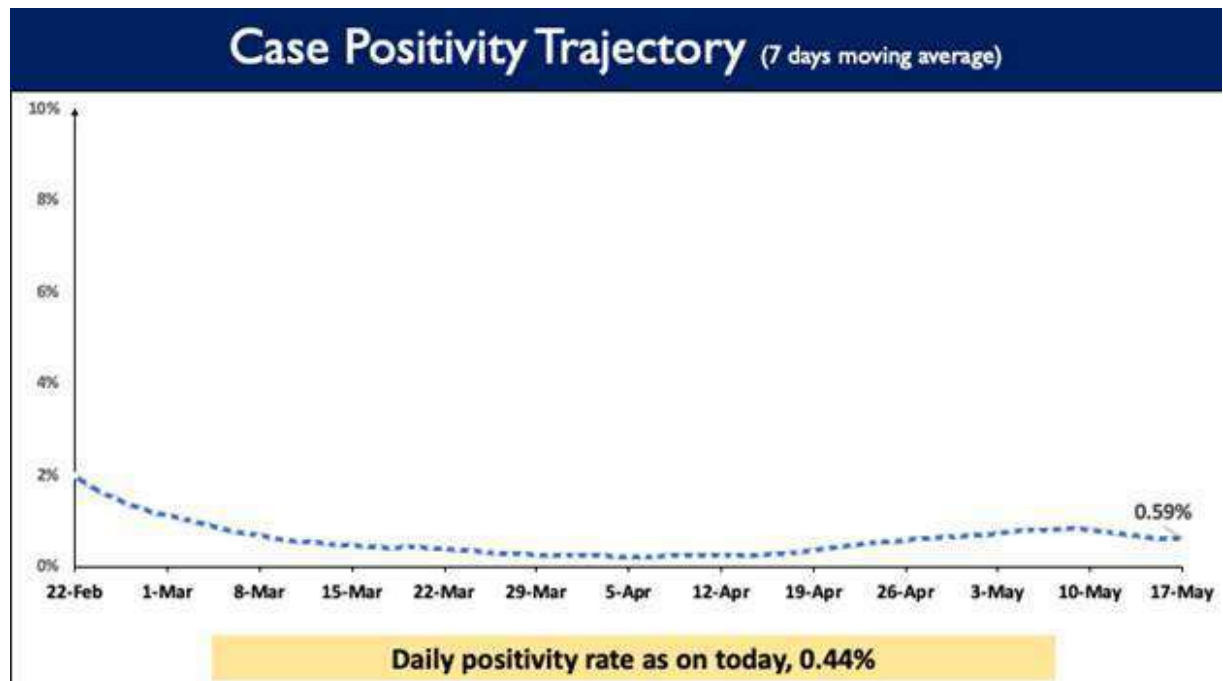

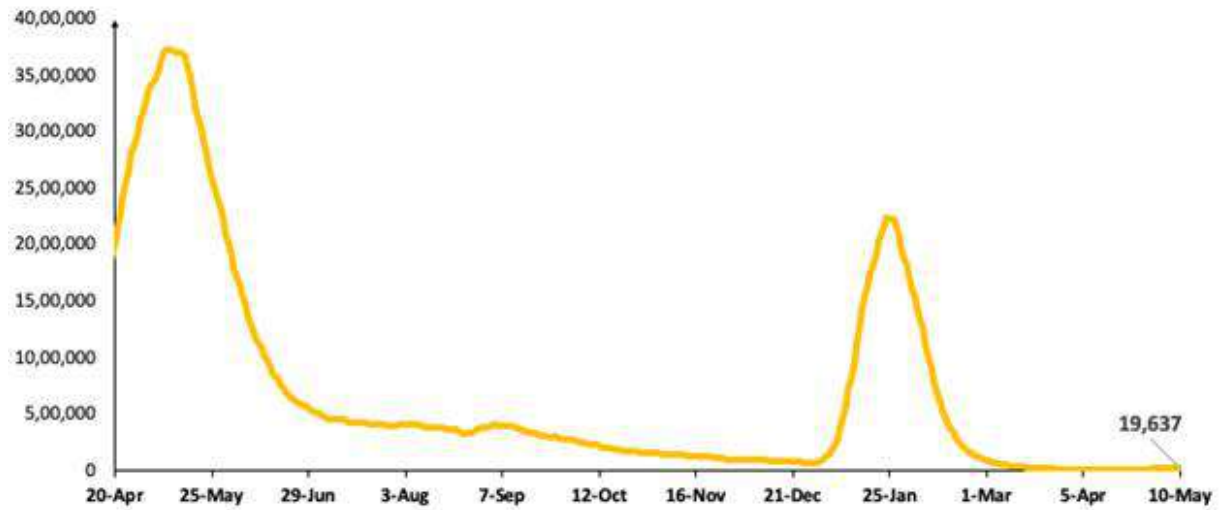

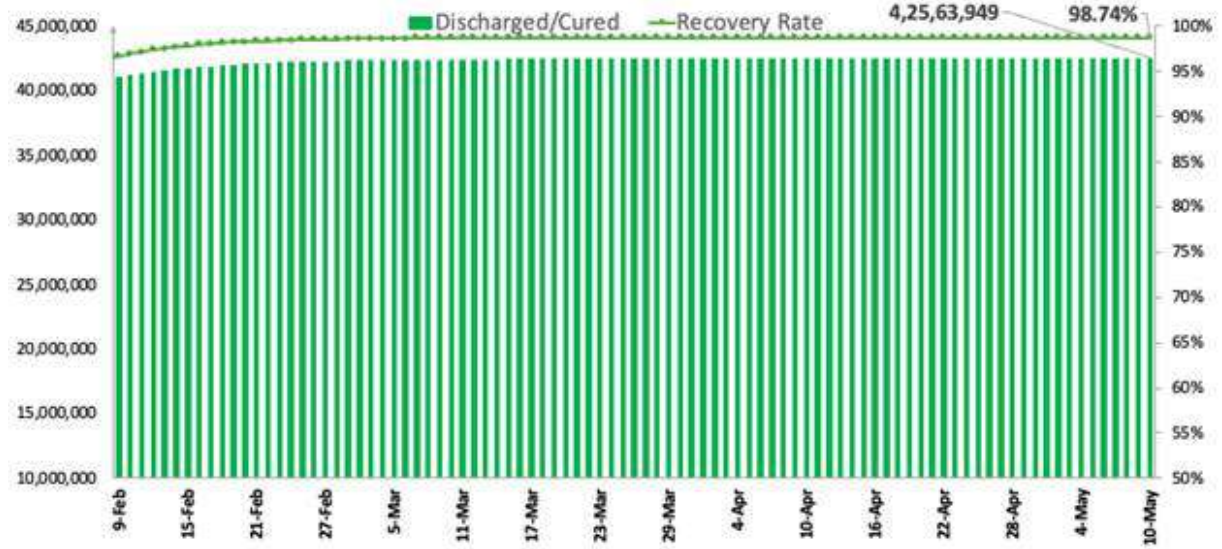


India's Active Cases Trajectory

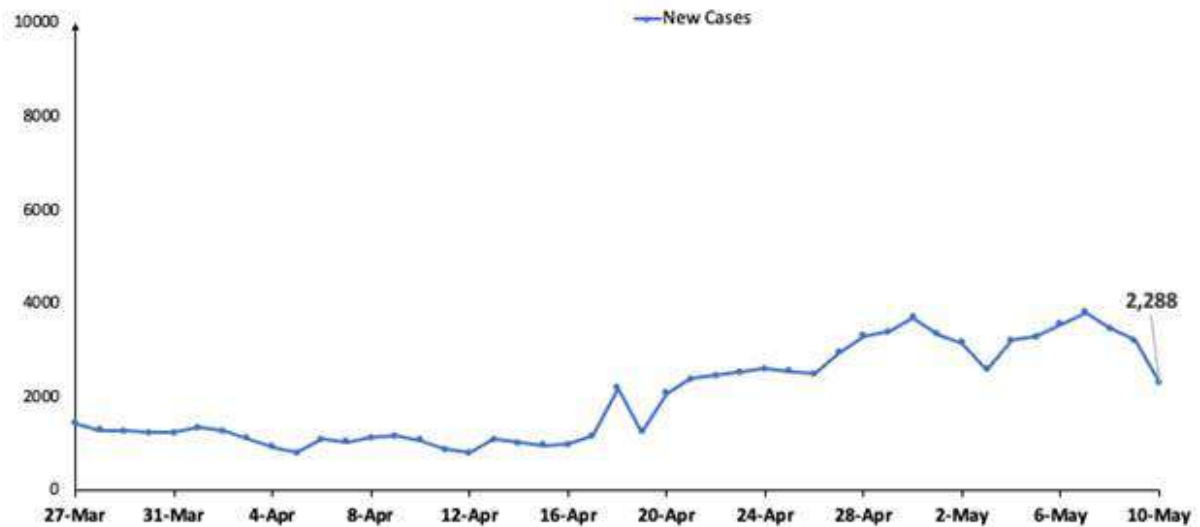
Recovered cases over 4.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%

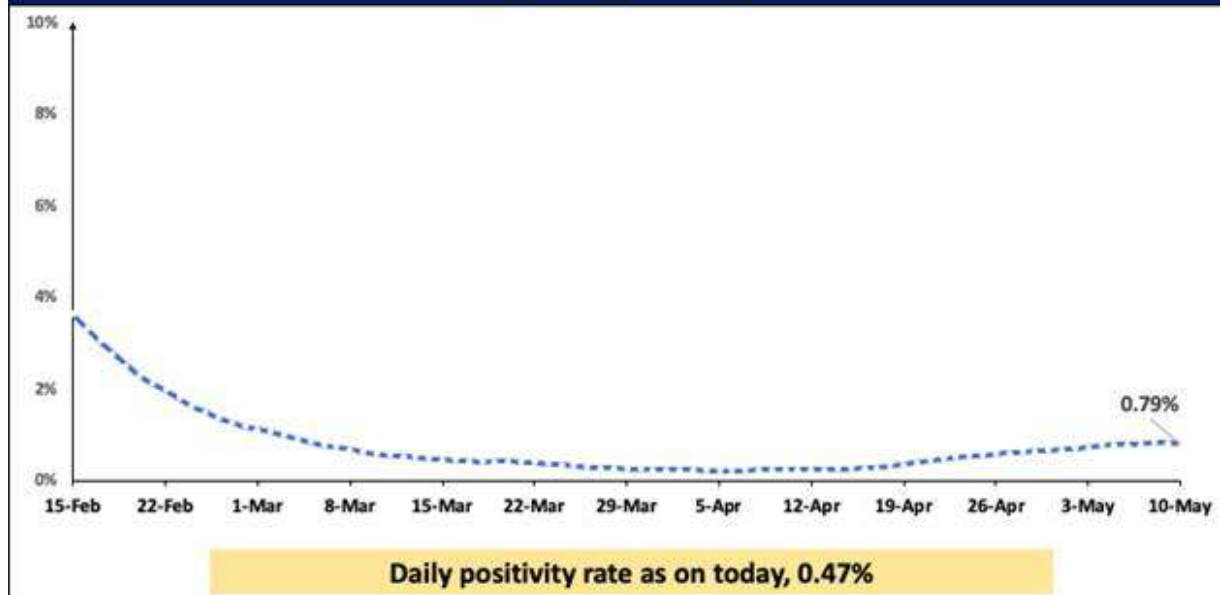

An individual only needs to provide their mobile number for registration, along with minimal inputs in name, age (Year of Birth) and gender for scheduling an appointment for vaccination or availing a vaccine at walk-in. As a proof of identity, an option to choose from 9 photo identity proofs has been accorded.

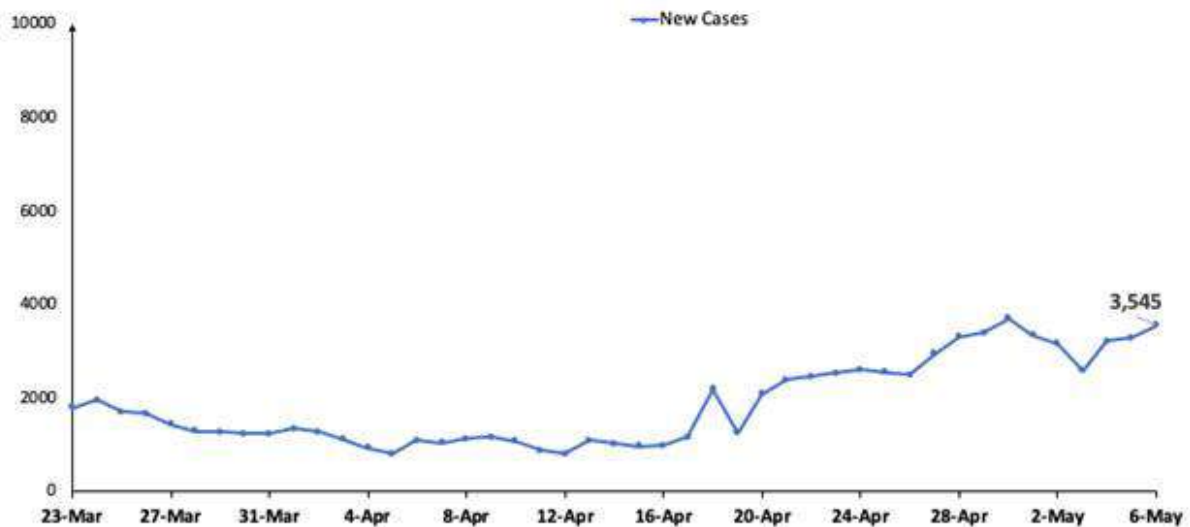


Recovered cases over 4.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%

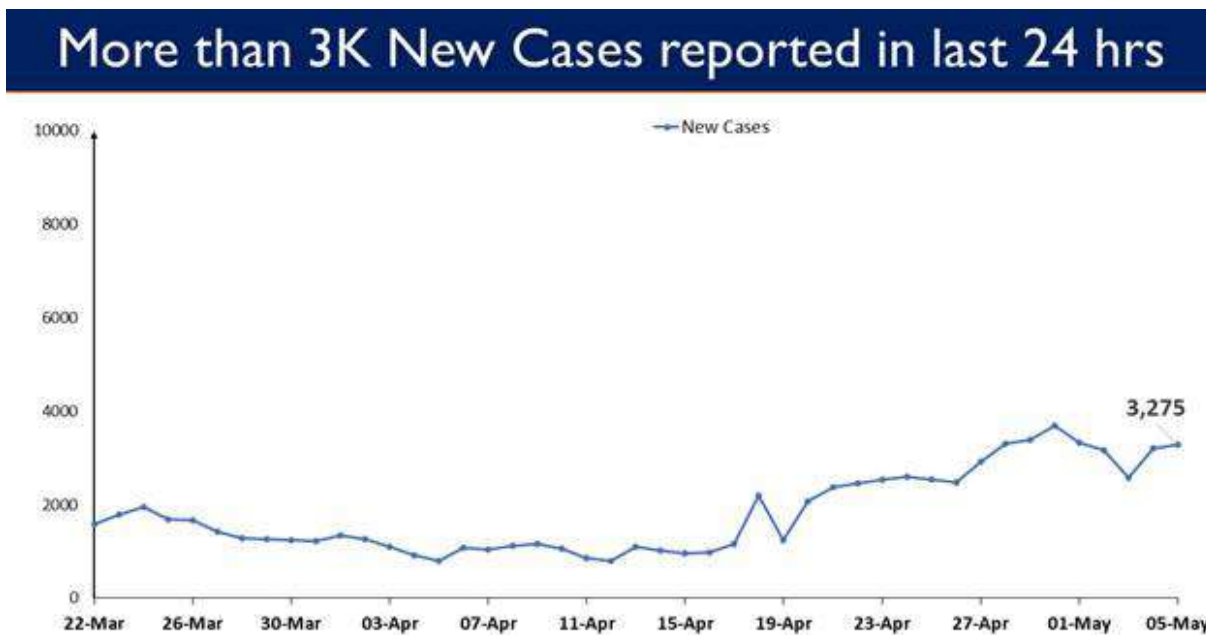
India's Active Cases Trajectory

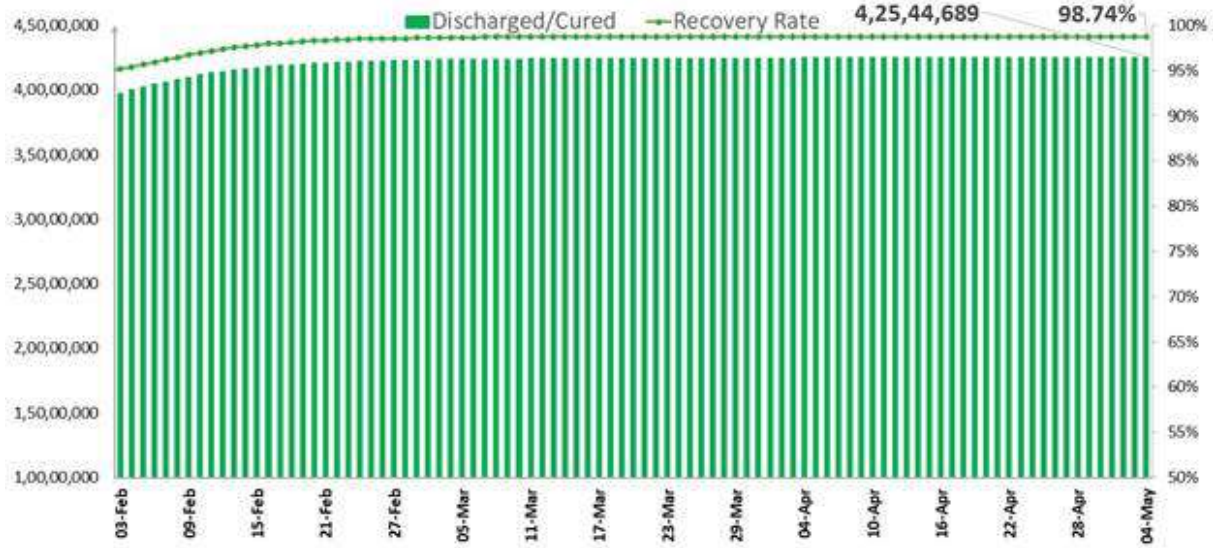


India's Active Cases Trajectory

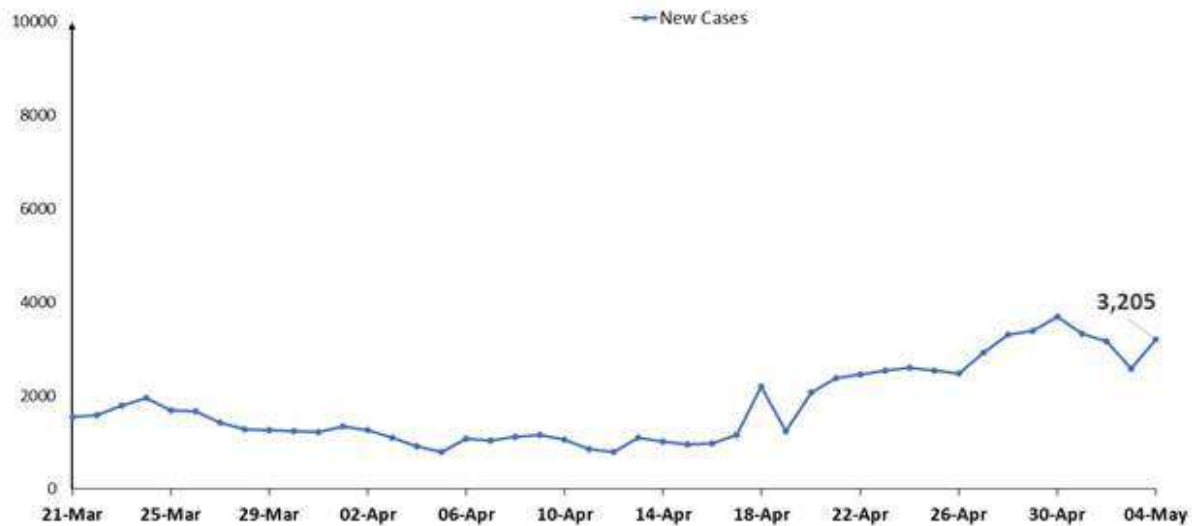
Recovered cases over 4.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%

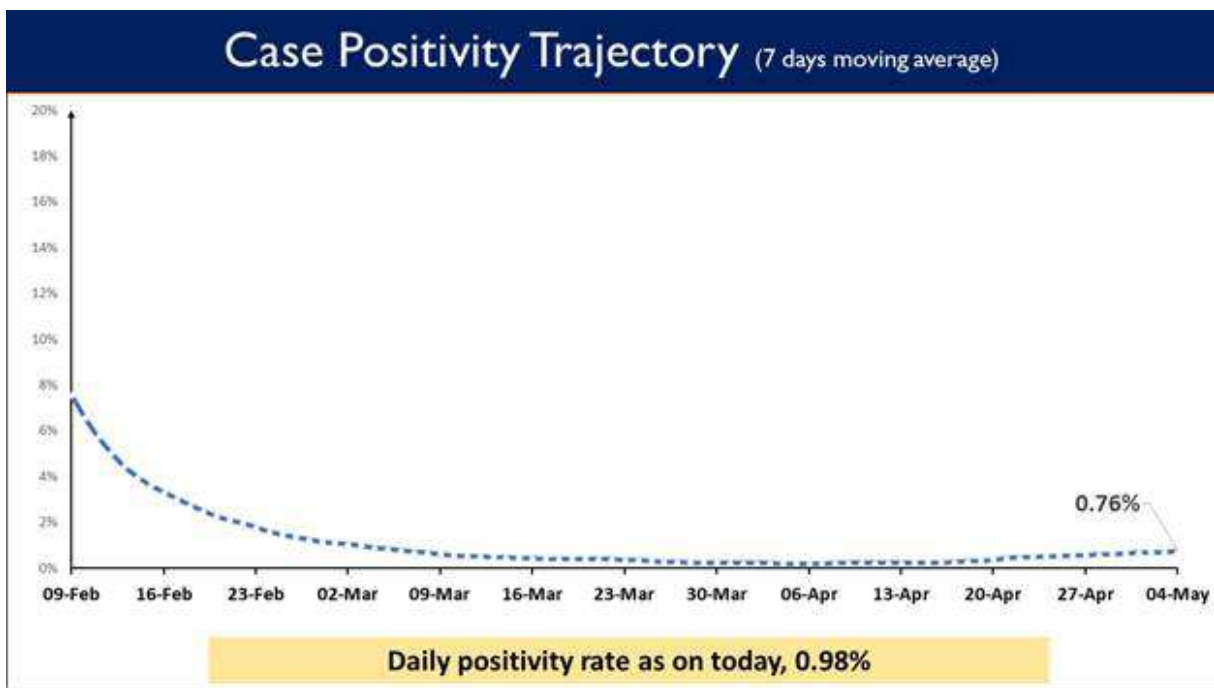


Less than 3K New Cases reported in last 24 hrs

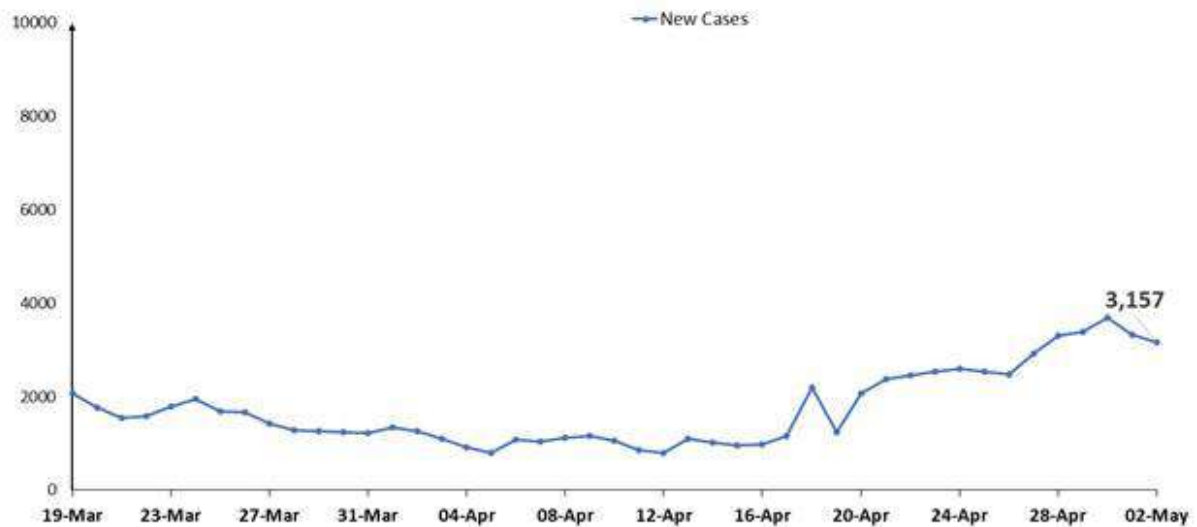

Recovered cases over 4.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%



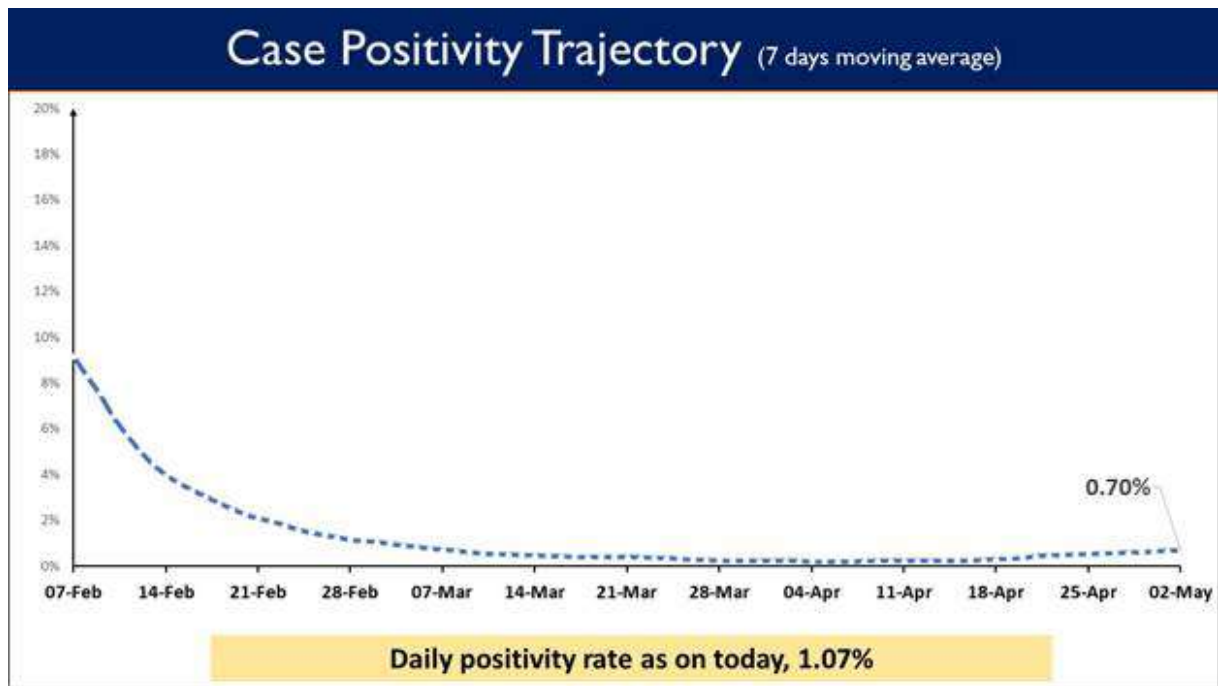
