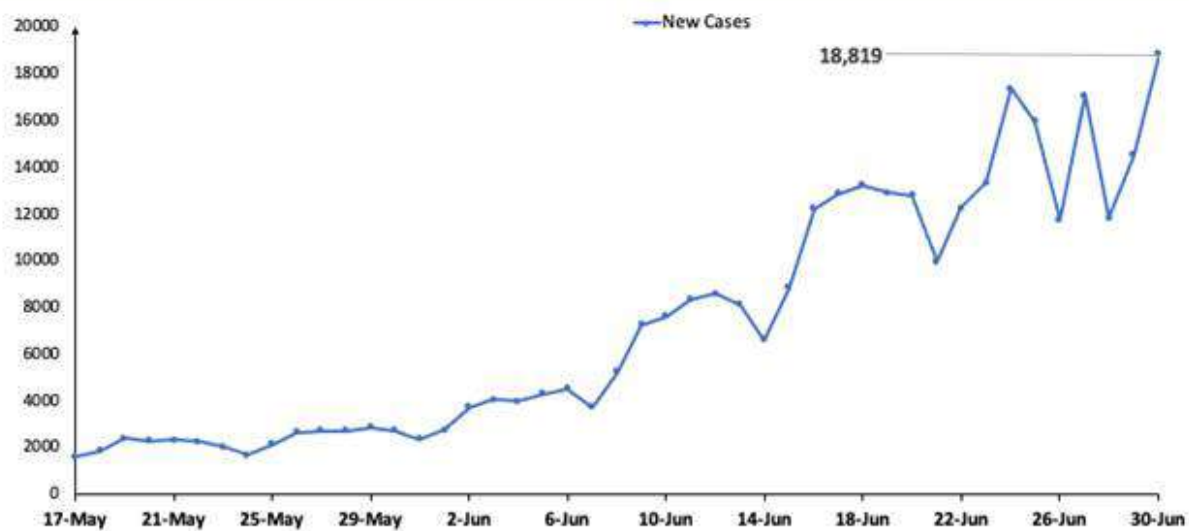


Recovered cases over 4.28 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.55%

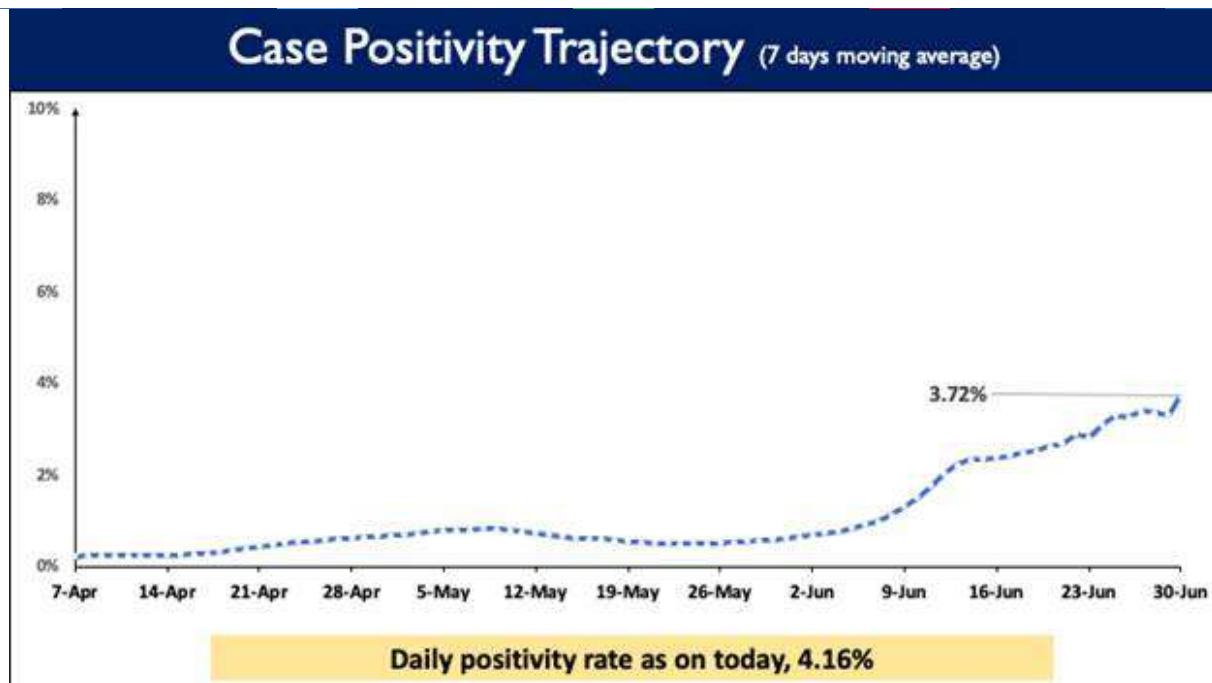

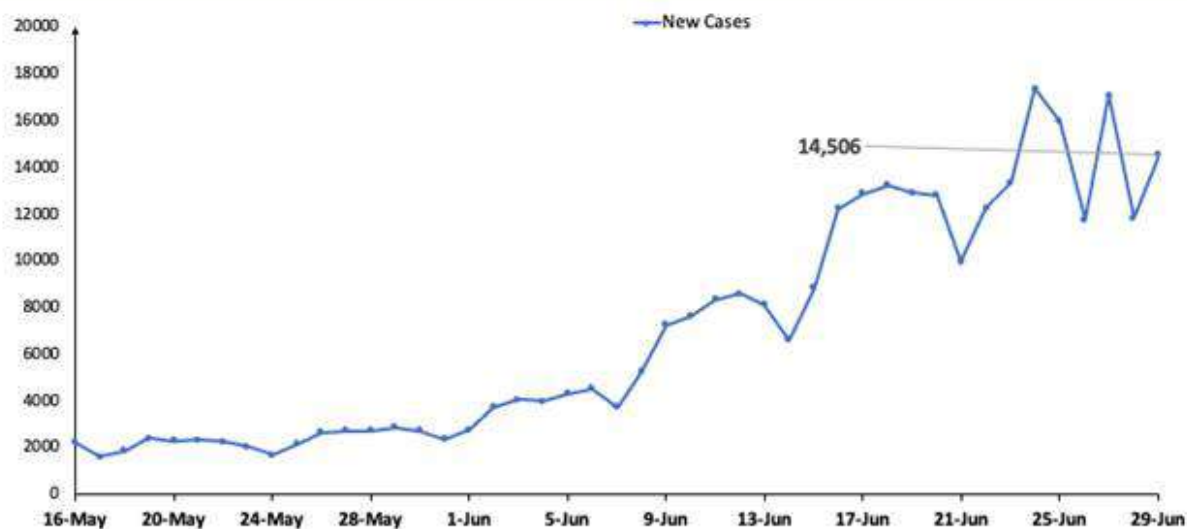


Recovered cases over 4.28 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.56%



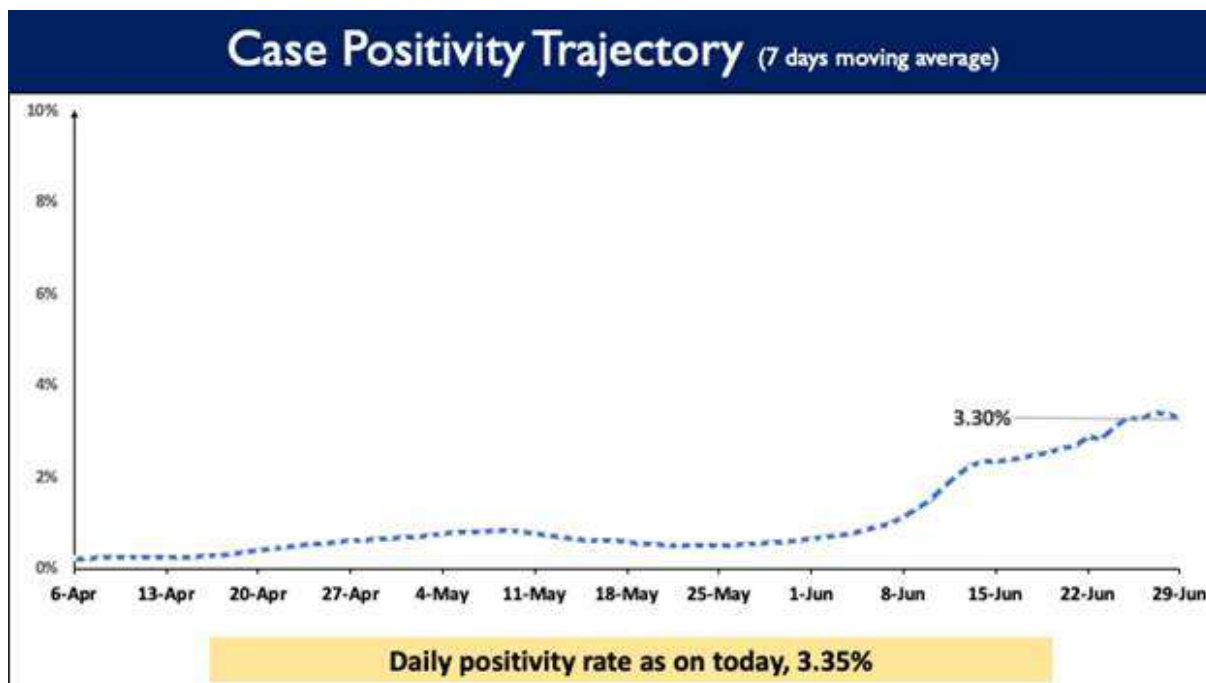

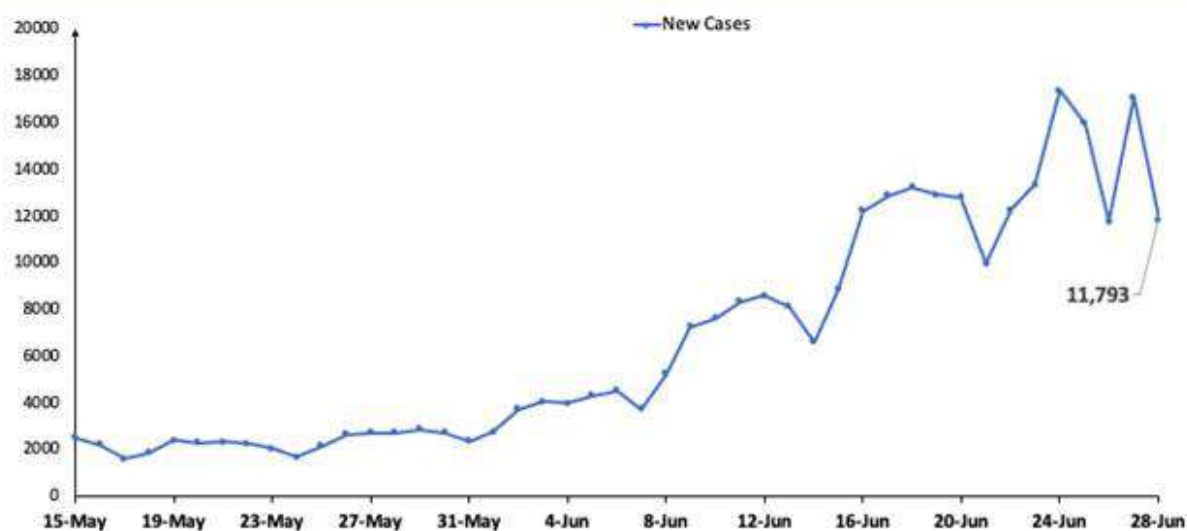


Recovered cases over 4.27 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.57%

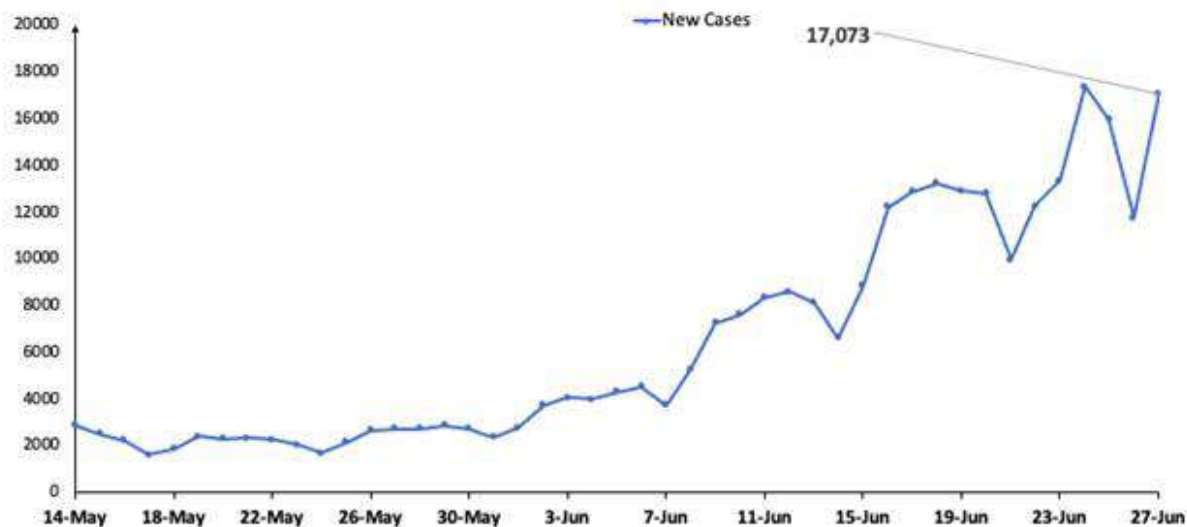


Recovered cases over 4.27 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.57%



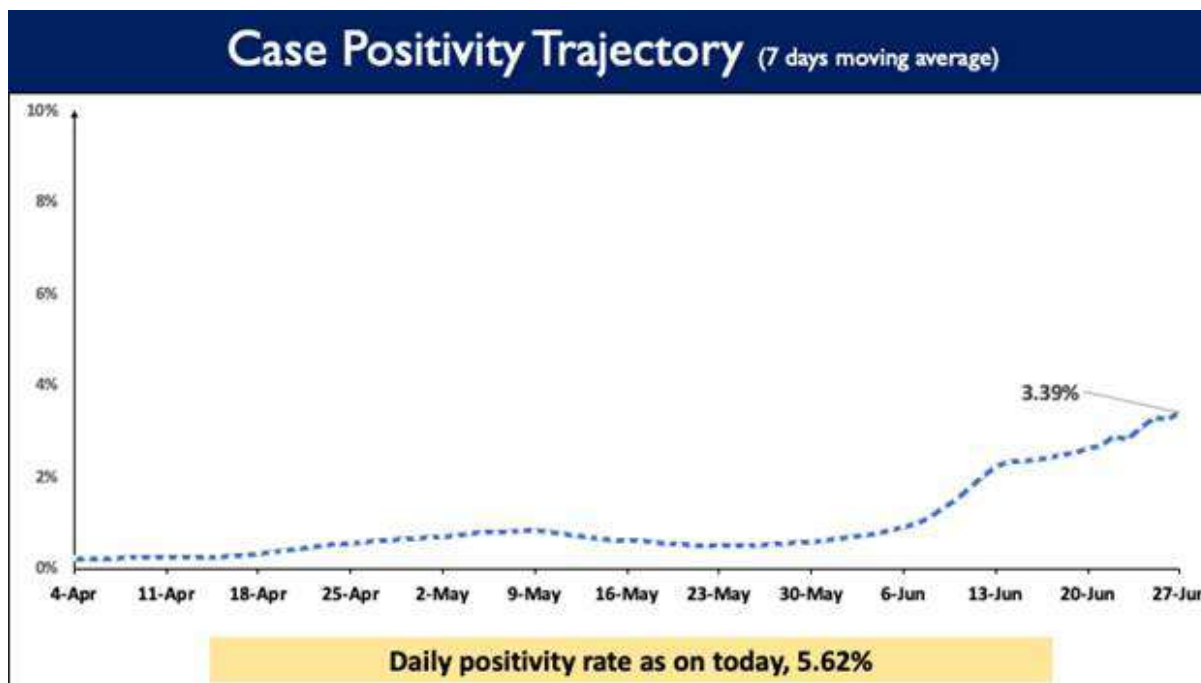

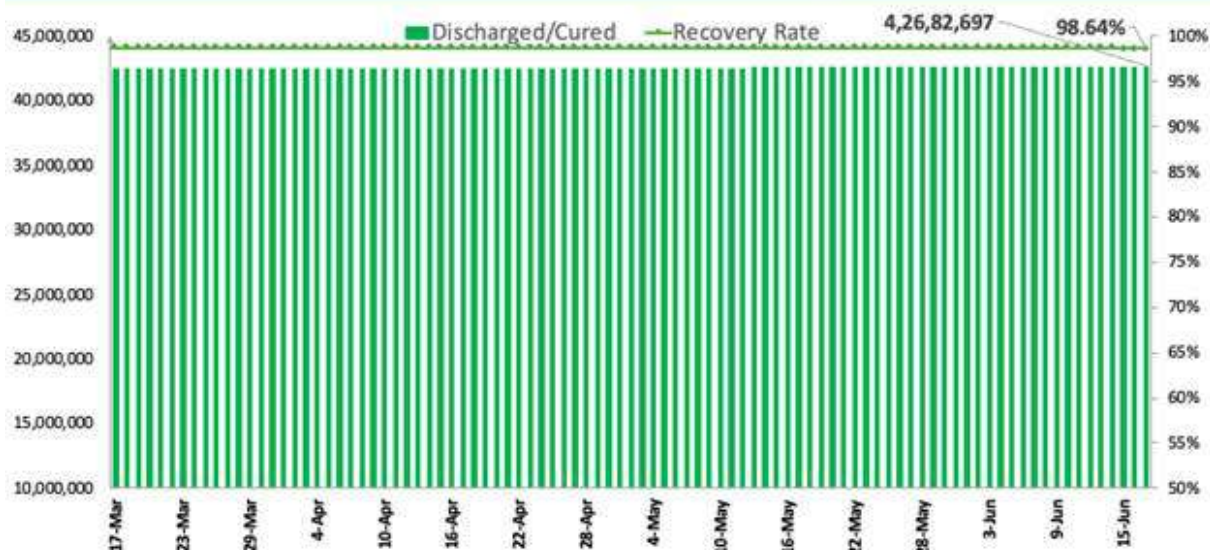


India's Active Cases Trajectory

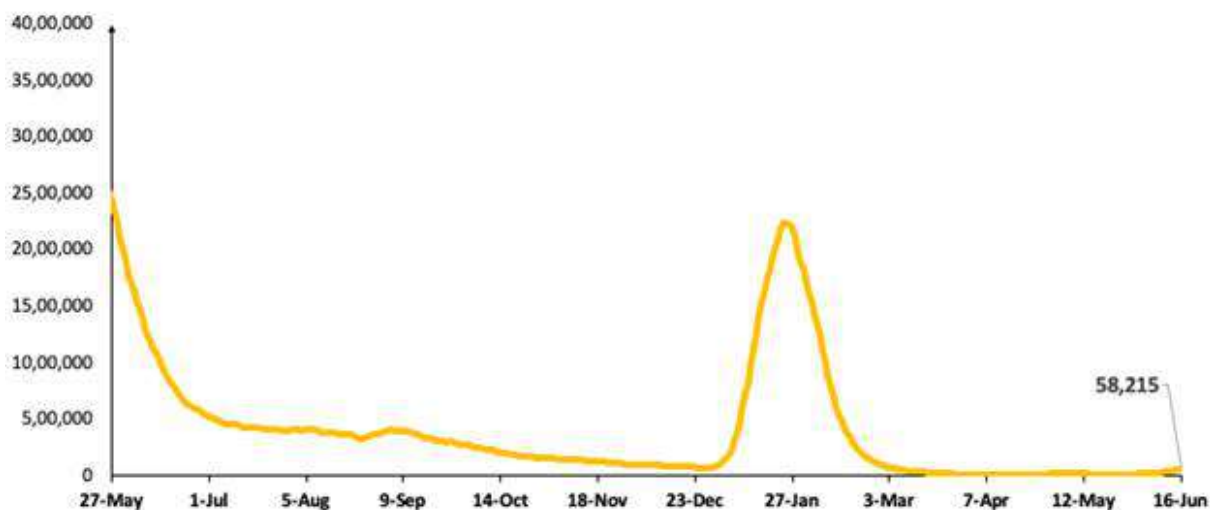

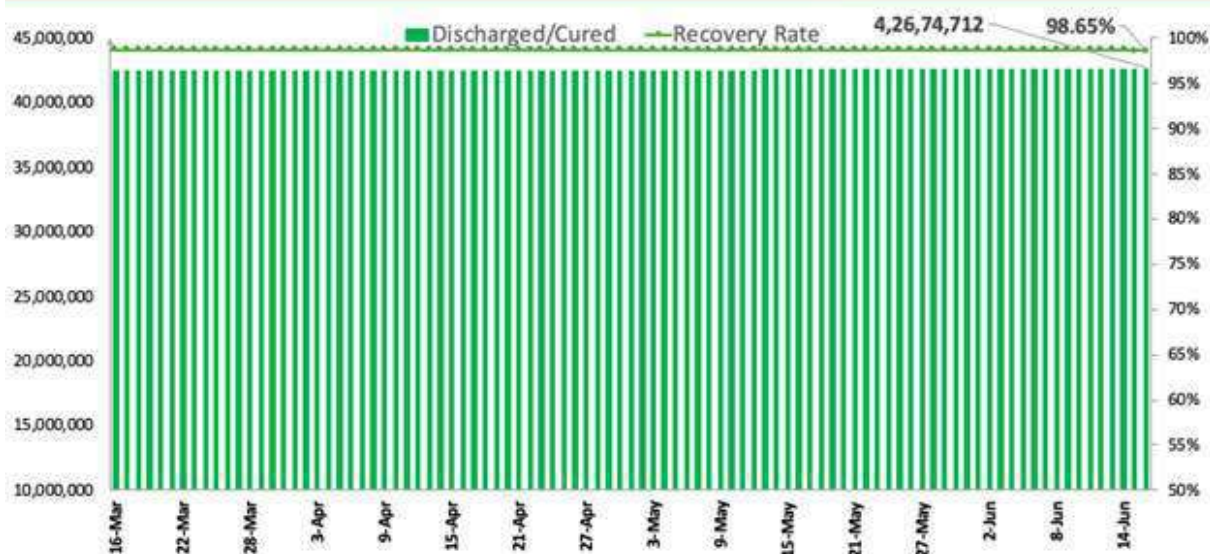


India's Active Cases Trajectory

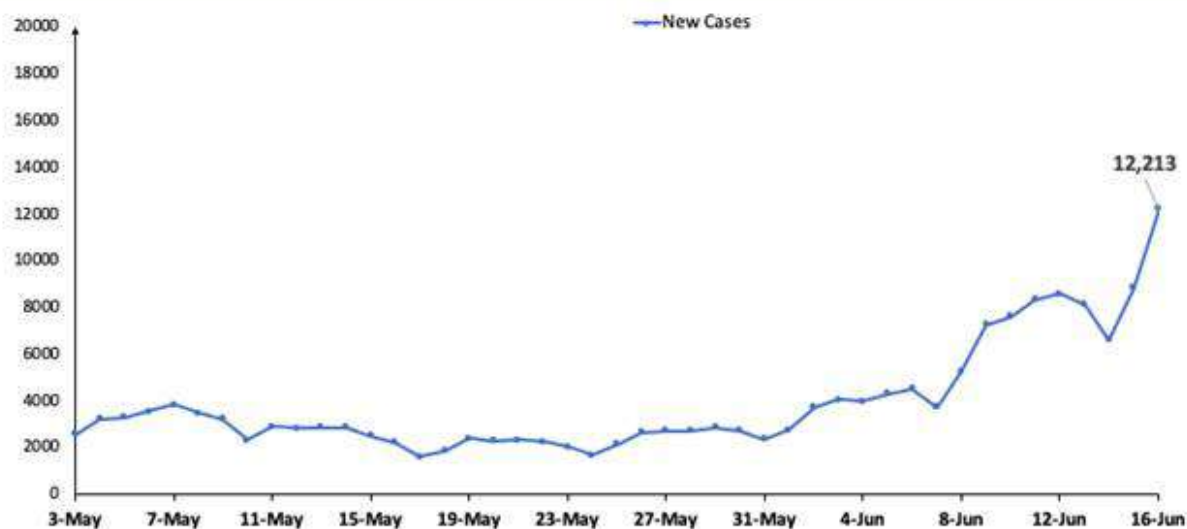

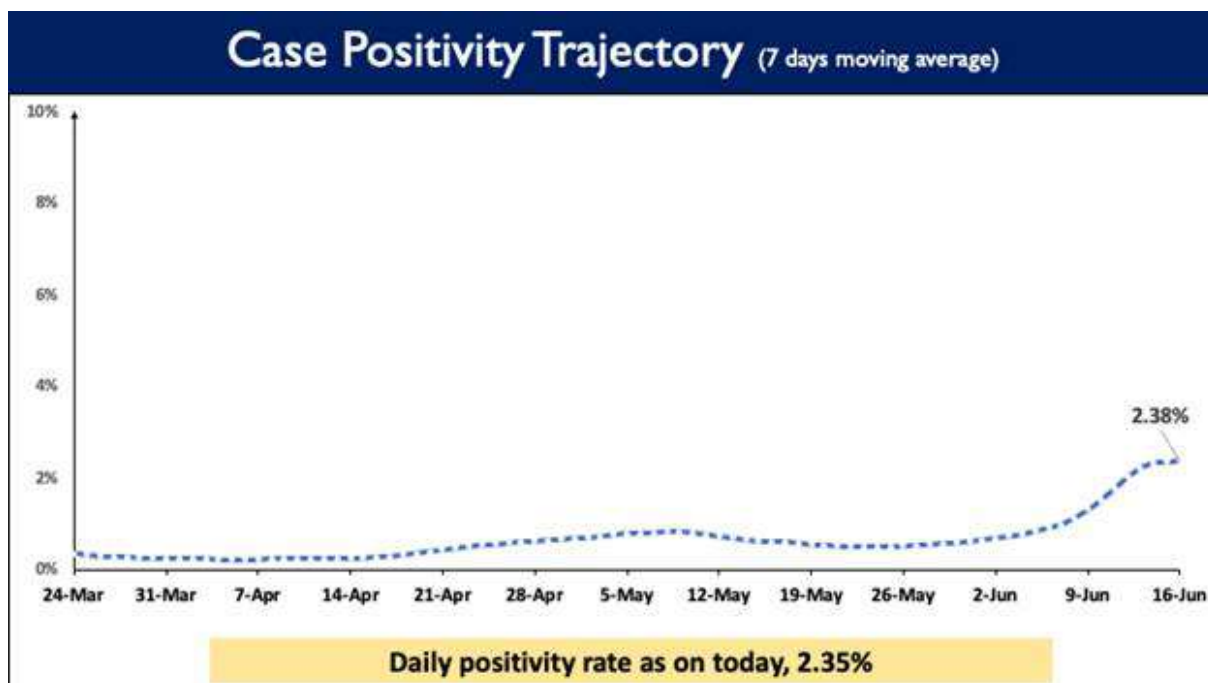

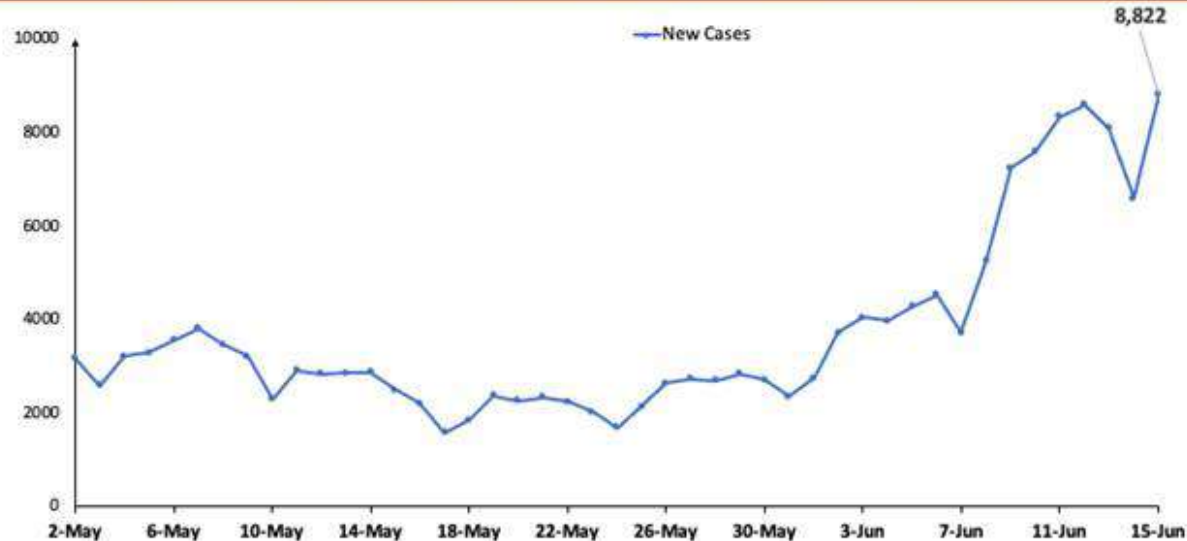


Recovered cases over 4.26 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.66%

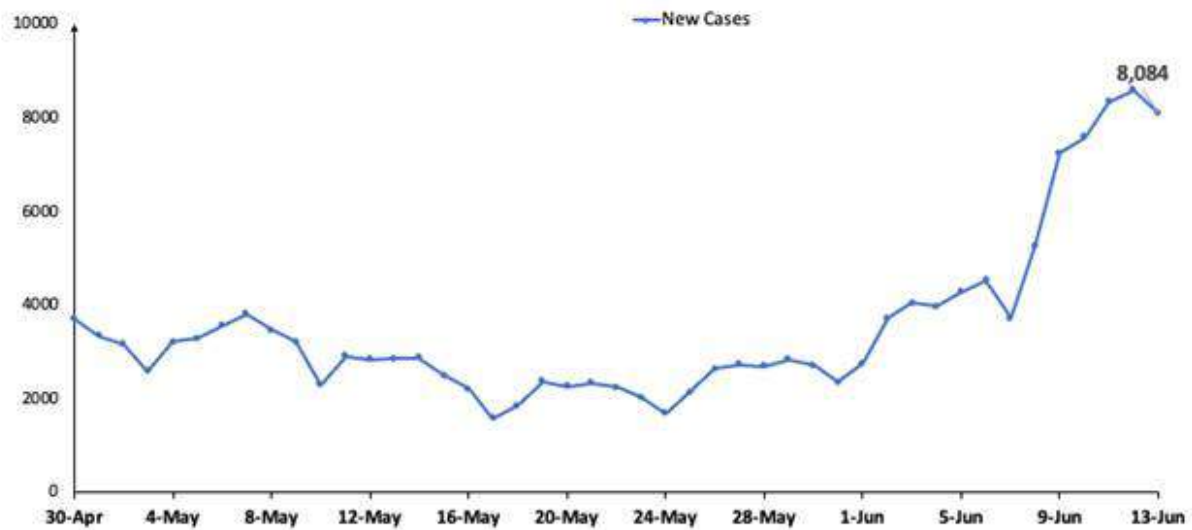

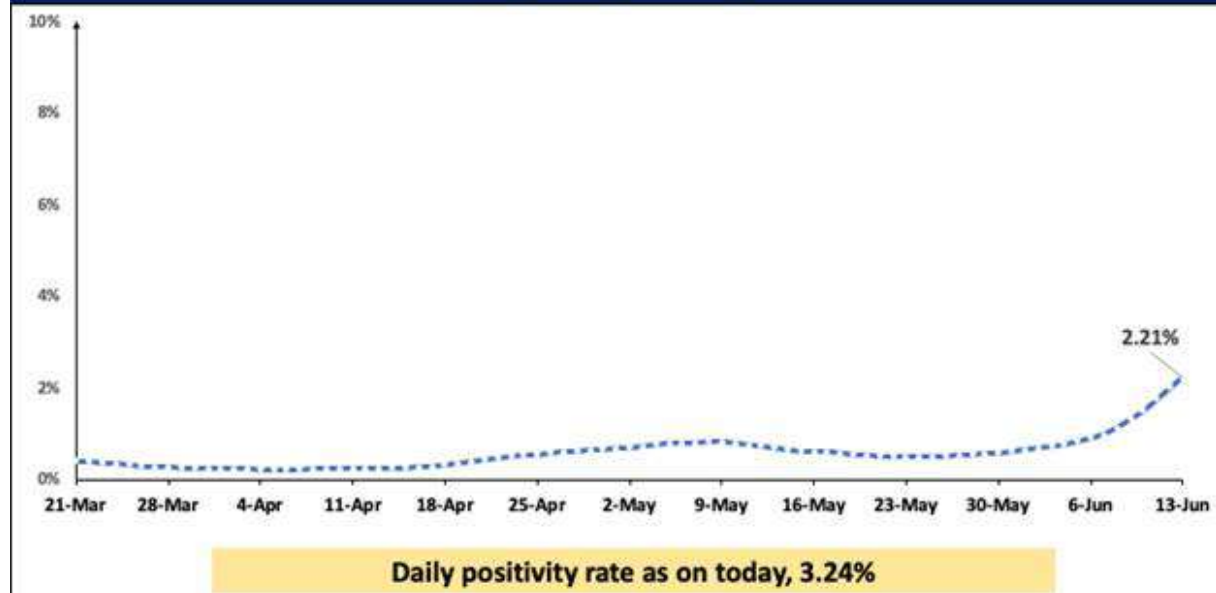

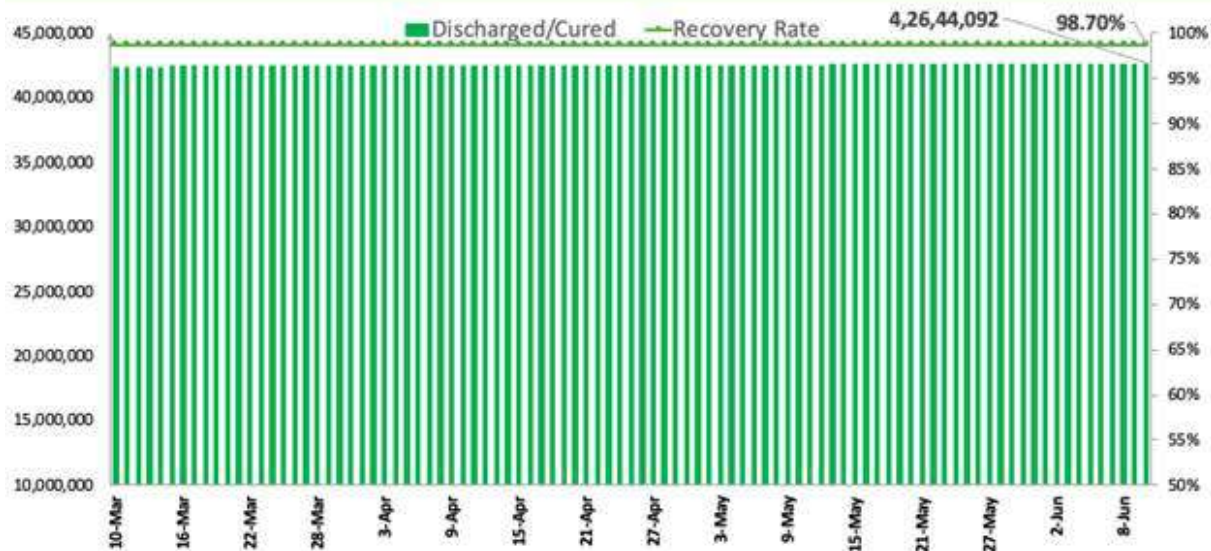
India's Active Cases Trajectory

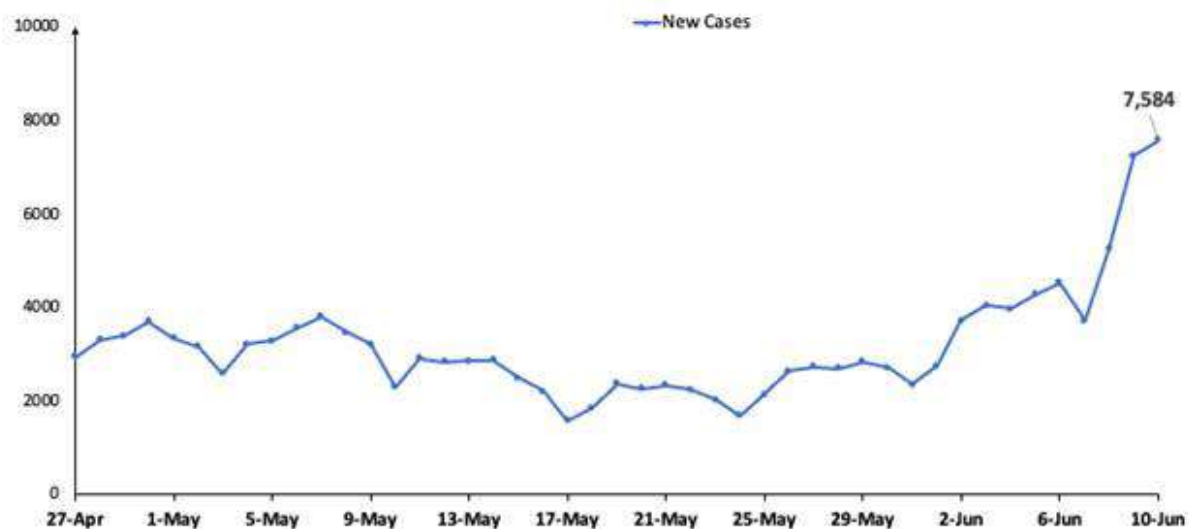

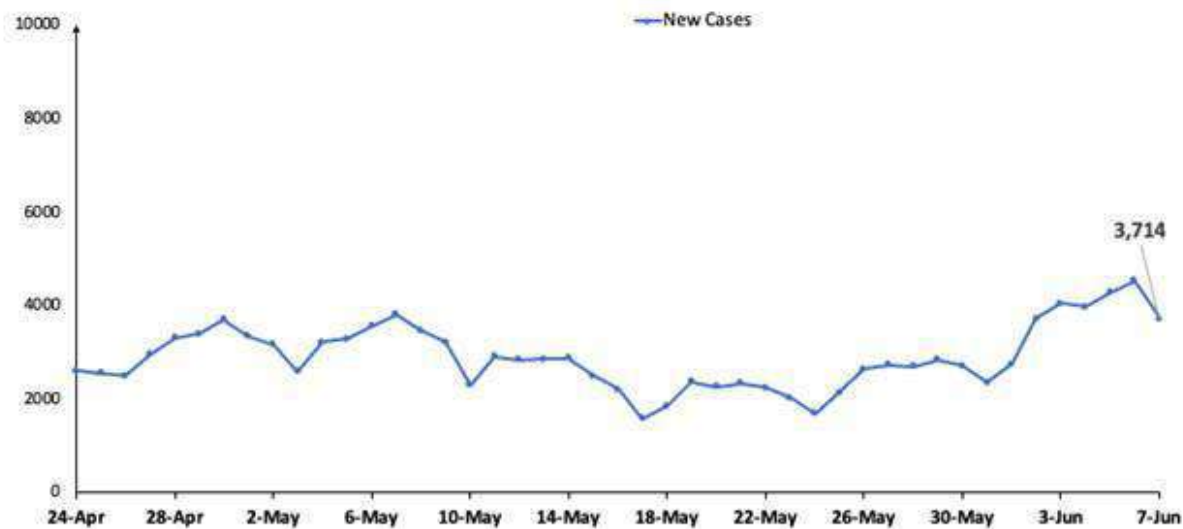


Recovered cases over 4.26 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.72%

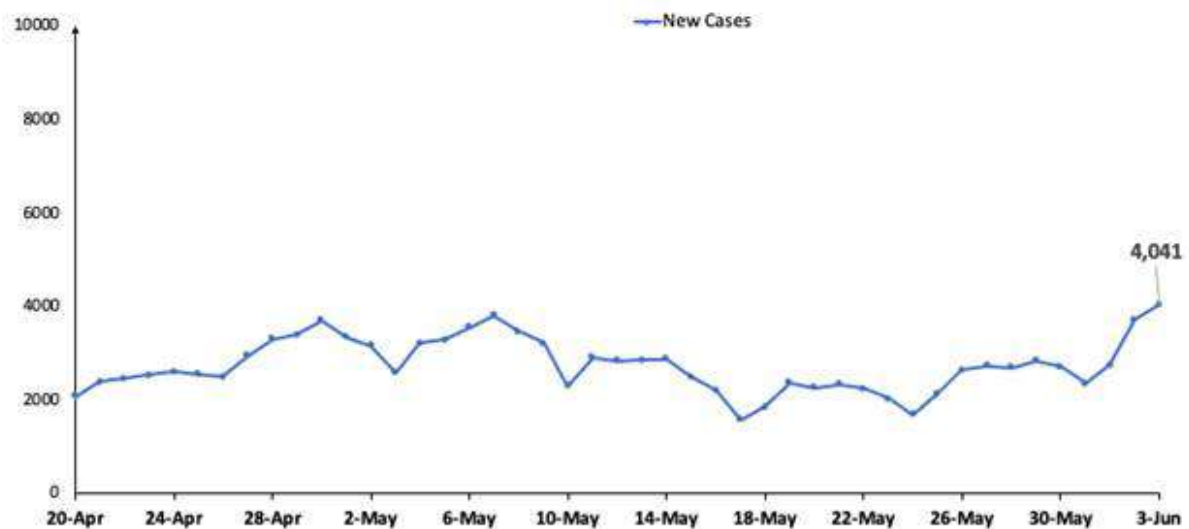


Recovered cases over 4.26 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.74%



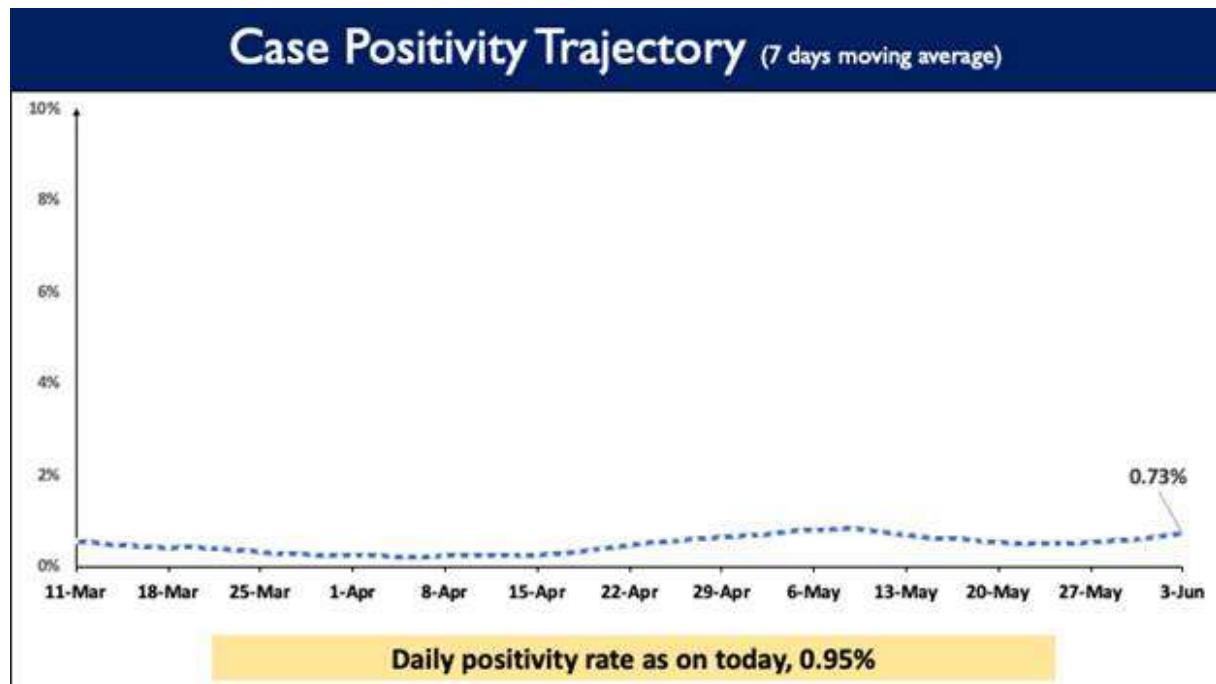
